

Monday, April 27, 1992, the Sabine county Commissioners court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting called to order by Judge Richard Smith; Brother Clarence Howell led opening prayer.

Minutes of the last meeting were approved as read.

Monthly reports were presented for inspection.

Judge Richard Smith presented a Proclamation in Observation of May 7, 1992 as a Day of Prayer. He also informed the Court the Sabine County Chamber of Commerce is declaring November 29, 1992 as Blaine Greer Day. "See Exhibit"

#3 - Gradall Time Warrant: Motion was made by Commissioner Lynn Smith to make four separate time warrants of \$12,550.00 to pay for gradall. This will total the \$50,200.00 which was previously approved, and will be paid out of the four precincts. These time warrants will be due on or before one year from date. Commissioner Carlin McDaniel seconded, and motion carried, with all voting for.

#4 - Motion was made by Commissioner Lynn Smith, seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Conn, to amend the budget to allow \$1,750.00 for part time help in the Treasurer's office. Motion carried. Mrs. Sparks had previously had no help.

Commissioner Jimmy Conn made the motion to move Prct. 3 voting place in Pineland from the City Hall to the new Fire Hall, which is directly across the street. Commissioner Lynn Smith seconded, and motion carried.

Bosco Lemoine, a Brookeland resident, was present. He asked the Court to close a road which dead ends at Sam Rayburn Lake. His is the last private property before the road reaches Corps of Engineers' property. The road is used for dumping and other activities. Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel to close the road, and allow a fence to be put across it. Commissioner Conn seconded, and motion carried. Mr. Lemoine owns property on both sides of the road.

#7 - Accept Road in Lowes Creek Subdivision:

Motion was made by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel to accept roads in Lowes Creek # 1, 2, and 3 as County roads. Commissioner Chester Cox seconded, and motion carried. The plat shows a 50' right of way on these roads. "See attached petition and plat."

8 - Request for Proposal-County Jail: Commissioner Smith put this on the agenda - it concerns leaks on roof ~~on roof~~ in County Jail. No action taken.

#2 - Only one bid was received on Sheriff Department vehicle. Hemphill Motor Company presented a bid of \$18,939.00 for a 1992 Ford Explorer, 4 door. Deputy Tom Philips was present for the discussion. Motion was made by Commissioner Lynn Smith to buy

the Explorer from Hemphill Motor Company for \$18,939.00. Commissioner Jimmy Conn seconded, and motion carried.

Commissioner Chester Cox made the motion to approve payment of bills. Commissioner Conn seconded, and motion carried.
