
Bill Vrooman, our Guardian agent, explained the proposed reduced rate for our Health Insurance. This will be an agenda item at our meeting Sept. 28.



To whom it may concern:

During my 8 years as county commissioner, ending Dec 31, 1982, I worked the Jimi School road from the Reeves Road to the Henry Bragg Place (now owned by Roy Bragg), and several about two branching roads as well. The work done on this road included occasional blading and, time to time, a load or two of gravel. I did very little maintenance since no one lived in them, but since it was an old public road (it served Jimi School from at least three directions) and several people owned property joining it, I felt it should be maintained.

After Mr. Hall began to ~~p~~ build on his place I did a little more work and even put in a large culvert in Cedar Creek with the help of St. Regis paper Co.

The last work I did was shortly before I left office -
 the fall of 1982. Chute Coy was Commissioner -
 elect and I only had a month or two left.
 Roy Bragg and Rosa Reese told me that some
 gravel was needed past the school house place.
 My loader was not running, so I sent two
 trucks to either Commissioners Election Commission
 Smith's loader for gravel. I think only one
 load was used on the road though, on a red clay
 place about 200 or 300 yds. past the school
 house well. I don't think we did any blading
 on the road at this time other than spreading
 the gravel.

That TEMPLE-EASTEX INCORPORATED, a corporation with offices in Diboll, Angelina County, Texas hereinafter called "GRANTOR", for and in consideration of TEN AND NO/100 (\$10.00) DOLLARS, and other good and valuable consideration to it in hand paid by Neil Beall and Carl Beall of P. O. Drawer S, Hemphill, Sabine County, Texas 75948, herein called "GRANTEES", has GRANTED, SOLD AND CONVEYED, and by these presents does GRANT, SELL and CONVEY unto GRANTEES, subject to the reservations herein contained, a non-exclusive easement and right-of-way for travel by foot, vehicular, and animal traffic situated in Sabine County, Texas described as follows:

SEE EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF FOR ANY AND ALL PURPOSES.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described Easement, together with all and singular, the rights and appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging unto the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns forever; and GRANTOR does hereby bind itself, its successors and assigns, to WARRANT AND FOREVER DEFEND all and singular the said premises unto the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof, by through or under it, but not otherwise, and subject to the other reservations herein contained.

GRANTOR hereby specifically reserves to itself, its successors and assigns, the full, free and perpetual right and privilege, in common with GRANTEES, to use said easement by foot, vehicular and animal traffic and for any other purpose desired by GRANTOR, so long as such use by GRANTOR does not prevent nor unreasonably interfere with the use of said easement by GRANTEES. Provided, however, it is understood that GRANTOR may, without incurring any liability to GRANTEES for the restoration of the surface or otherwise, use said right-of-way for purposes of transporting logs and logging equipment and other types of equipment by any type of vehicles.

It is expressly understood and agreed that GRANTEES shall not pave or otherwise improve the easement area without the written permission of GRANTOR, and any such paving or improving shall be made solely at the expense and risk of GRANTEES and upon the express understanding that GRANTOR shall have the right to use said easement for any purposes above mentioned without incurring any obligation to restore the surface of the easement area.

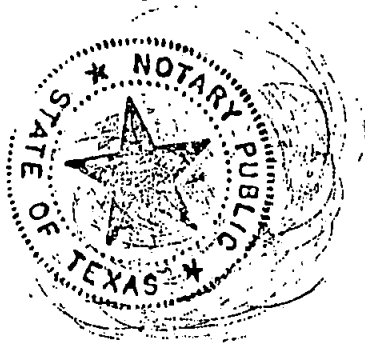
