

Monday, December 28, 1992, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A.M., with the following members present:

Commissioner Jimmy Conn was not present.

Judge Hyden called the meeting to order and Bro. Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved after correcting the minutes to read "Motion was made by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel to amend minutes of October 26, 1992 meeting to reflect motion was made by Commissioner Cox to rescind the waste water order. Also item #6, to read "Sabine county to be shown as additional insured on policy, with waiver of subrogation.

Under general business, Judge Hyden told the Court that the Texas Dept. of Protective Services found a copy of the original contract with the County. It was dated 1976 with an amendment in 1980. Judge Hyden presented an amendment to bring the County up to date. The Court is to look over the contract until the end of the meeting and to make a decision at that time.

Item #2: Commissioner Smith told the Court that it had been bugeted in Debt Service to pay off the time warrant for Pct. #2 on the white Mack truck in the amount of \$39,000.00 plus interest. He made the motion to pay this time warrant off. Commissioner Cox second. All voted for. Motion approved.

Item #3: Commissioner Cox stated that there is not ^{an} update at this time on the Solid Waste. Not action taken.

Item #4: Open bids on Roof for County Barn: Commissioner McDaniel made a motion to not open bids on the county barn roof because of a technicality in the notice of advertising for bids. Commissioner Cox second. After a discussion, Commissioner Cox rescinded his second to Commissioner McDaniel's motion. Commissioner McDaniel then made a motion to rescind the motion made on the previous meeting to accept bids on the county barn roof. Commissioner Cox second. All voted for. Commissioner McDaniel presented a 12 year study on how much rainfall the county receives. See attached copy. This study shows the effects the rainfall has on rain out days for R&B employees and wages paid. The county barn would give the employees a dry place to work on equipment.

Item #6: Randy Garner with Sonat Exploration met with the Court. He stated that he did not have any new information at this time. This was tabled for a later date.

Item #7: Steam Cleaner: Commissioner McDaniel made a motion that this be tabled until the January 4, 1993 meeting. Commissioner Cox second. All voted for.

At this time, Judge Hyden ask the Court if they had looked at the amendment to the contract for Protective Services. Commissioner Cox made a motion to accept the amendment. Commissioner Smith second. All voted for. See attached exhibit.

Commissioner Smith ask the Court to recognize his continuing hours of education. See attached exhibit. The Court recognized Commissioner Smith's hours.

The Court was asked to approve the 4 year bond for Tax Assessor/Collector, Tammy Reeves. Commissioner McDaniel made the motion to approve the bond. Commissioner Cox second. All voted for.

Court recessed at this time and to reconvene at 9:45 A.M.

Judge Hyden called the meeting back to order.

County Treasurer, Ollie Faye Sparks, met with the Court to ask if the break down on bills was suitable with the Court. The Court told Mrs. Sparks that they appreciated the efforts of her office.

Commissioner Smith made the motion to pay salaries and accounts except for a bill




10:30 A.M. agenda item: El Camino Subdivision: County vs Jim Flowers.



Commissioner McDaniel would like for the Court to ask the County Attorney to research the Vernon's Civil Statutes to determine the County's legal action to be taken according to Article 6702-1, Section 2.1035 of the Vernon's Civil Statutes. Commissioner Cox second. All voted for. The County Attorney is to draft the notice and mail by certified mail to Jim Flowers notifying him of the action taken by the Court and if not corrected within 20 days after the notice is sent, not recieved, the County would take appropriate action.


Commissioner Cox made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Smith second. Court adjourned.

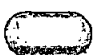

Whereas the Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services, formerly named Texas Department of Human Services renews the contract dated _____ with the following addition:

VII.

County agrees to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-352), Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Public Law 93-112), The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-336), and all amendments to each, and all requirements imposed by the regulations issued pursuant to these acts. In addition, the Provider agrees to comply with Title 40, Chapter 73, of the Texas Administrative Code. These provide in part that no persons in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, political beliefs or religion be excluded from participation in, or denied, any aid, care, service or other benefits provided by federal and/or state funding, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination.

County agrees to comply with the Health and Safety Code Section 85.113 (relating to workplace and confidentiality guidelines regarding AIDS and HIV).

FISCAL ADMINISTRATION

- . Eliminate "DEBT SERVICE TAXATION" in three, (3), years except for voter approved bonds.
- . Establish a CAPITAL RESERVE account equal to 5% of County's annual budget in 5 yrs. and 10% in 8 yrs.
- . Develop FIVE YEAR CAPITAL BUDGET to be updated annually.
- . Bring County purchasing activities, including Time Warrants and Bonds, in line with the Texas Constitution and various statutes governing same.
- . Establish a system to track and monitor fines assessed and paid on a current basis. A similar system to monitor Bond forfeitures.
- . Determine effect on Sabine County with regard to cost of proposed State Legislation establishing a 4TH DEGREE FELONY. This level of felony has not existed previously. This legislation, if passed by the Legislature, will require mandatory County jail time as opposed to mandatory State prison time and abolish the Board of Pardons and Parole as we know it.

Determine action required, timing and cost--Budget same.

- . Establish firm timetable for Federally Mandated actions/improvements to County Buildings to meet requirements of the "ACT FOR DISABLED AMERICANS", (ADA).

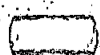
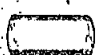
Determine action required, timing and cost--Budget same.

- . Establish firm timetable for Federally Mandated purchase by County of Computer and program which will directly connect Sabine County with NATION CRIME INFORMATION CENTER in Washington.

Determine timing and cost--Budget same.

- . Evaluate other options for acquisition of County Insurance and propose to Court by 7-31-93.

OPERATIONAL/ADMINISTRATIVE

- . Make final determination of viability of "UNIT ROAD SYSTEM" by 8-31-93 and put on ballot prior to 12-31-93.
- . Finalize SOLID WASTE issue by implementing program deemed most economically feasible by the Commissioners Court and best serves the citizens of Sabine County no later than 7-31-93.
- . Institute a "COUNTY WIDE BONDING SYSTEM"/"PRE-TRIAL RELEASE PROGRAM". The County would become the Bonding Agent for certain offenses and would receive the income.
- . Justify the appointment of a COUNTY AUDITOR by the District Judges by 7-30-93. Include in 1994 budget.
- . Re-establish voting box in Rosevine.
- . Establish a diversified and broad based Advisory Commission to the County Judge.
- . Establish a "PLACE ONE" and "PLACE TWO" for Justice Precincts One and Two. The Justice holding Place One in each Precinct will be the Official Recorder of Births and Deaths.
- . Prepare a complete inventory of County assets including description, acquisition date, cost and present value.
- . Complete 911 addressing and provide monitoring equipment at Sabine County Jail.

EDUCATION:

- . Encourage Adult Education on a continuing basis, particularly Illiteracy and Skills Training.
- . Hold Seminars at County High Schools and County Courthouse on the function, structure and administration of County Government.

TOURISM/ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:

- . Actively promote tourism and economic development from the County Court Level.
- . Work with Representative Johnson and Senator Haley to pass legislation enabling Sabine County to institute a HOTEL/MOTEL tax. Put on ballot in Sabine County in 1993.

CITIZEN AWARENESS:

- . Keep the public informed by articles in the Sabine County Reporter on current issues affecting the County.
- . Hold regular "TOWN HALL/COMMUNITY" meetings throughout the County. Post notice weekly in the Sabine County Reporter giving dates, location and time.
- . Encourage citizen attendance at County Court meetings.
