

Monday, January 18, 1993, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in a called session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting called to order by Judge Larry Hyden; Judge Hyden also led opening prayer.

Minutes of the meeting of December 28, 1992 were approved as read.

#1 - County Barn, Precinct 1 & 4:

Judge Hyden made motion to remove from table. Commissioner Clark seconded, and motion carried.

Commissioner Clark presented revised plans for renovation of County Barn. He recommended construction of a metal building covering 48' X 150' of the existing slab.

Motion made by Commissioner Keith Clark that proposed bid be financed not to exceed \$28,000.00. Estimated cost not to exceed \$35,000.00; pay \$7,000.00 from current funds; \$28,000.00 to be financed through issuance of time warrants over period of 3 years. Submit this for bids and post notice thereof.

Commissioner Chester Cox stated he is in support, but thinks mistake is made by not covering entire slab, because of way roof is to be constructed.

Amend time warrant to not exceed \$30,000.00. Bid opening February 8, 1993.

Commissioner Keith Clark withdrew all motions made.

Motion made by Commissioner Chester Cox to go out for bids for County barn building 48' x 150'. Publish notice to receive bids for construction of metal building to be used as precinct 1 and precinct 4 maintenance facility; dimension of building 48' x 150'; payment to be as follows: \$7,000.00 out of current funds from precinct 1 & 4; balance to be from time warrant not to exceed \$30,000.00. Three time warrants issued of equal amounts, with one time warrant payable annually from said precincts until such principal and interest thereon has been retired entirely. Commissioner Clark seconded, and all voted for.

Judge Larry Hyden made motion court orders and binds by resolution herewith adopted, future courts to establish a tax rate sufficient to cover the interest and establish a minimum 2% sinking fund in support of the above mentioned obligation. Commissioner Cox seconded, and all voted for.

#2 - Solid Waste:

Judge Hyden attended a meeting and reported the board will have to stay with the Engineering Firm to speed them up. Commissioner Chester Cox is going to a meeting this week. Time frame on construction is running way behind. Tipping fees were discussed to help in financing. Judge encouraged entire court to attend next meeting.

#4 Judge Hyden asked for temporary work for approximately 30 days to do "fine research" and start card system to keep up with what is due on fines. This temporary help will be paid out of non-departmental - miscellaneous funds. He stated the money is there, and he would like approval of the court. Court had no problem with this.


#3 - Room for record storage:


This was being discussed in order to clean out the storage room on the third floor in the courthouse. It is needed for office space. Commissioner Lynn Smith suggested three alternatives: repair attic for space in courthouse; prepare space in county barn, Precinct 1, or prepare space at Precinct 2 barn in Yellowpine. This will be for storage of permanent county records, so must be secure. Approximate cost of repair is \$500.00 to \$600.00, and will come out of non departmental funds. No action taken at this time. Agenda item February 8.


