

Monday, February 22, 1993, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting called to order by Judge Larry Hyden. Commissioner Lynn Smith led opening prayer.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Judge Hyden presented his certificates for 16 hours continuing education from The National Judicial College in Lubbock. Commissioner Keith Clark made motion to accept this as a matter of record. Commissioner Kenneth White seconded, and motion carried.

Judge Hyden asked the Commissioners to submit an inventory of County vehicles for insurance purposes.

Treasurer's Quarterly reports for July, August, and September and October, November, and December, 1992, were presented and approved.

#2 - Agreement With Corp of Engineers:

No action taken.

#3 - Mr and Mrs. Werner had questions concerning the County Line Road; Commissioner White stated he will grade the entire road when he grades any. Both Sonat and the County will be responsible for the upkeep of road. Also part of the road is in San Augustine County.

#4 - Solid Waste:

Commissioner Cox stated there is a meeting in Jasper tomorrow, February 23 at 10:00 - Also there is a seminar in Nacogdoches March 1st. He asked all who could to make the meeting. Judge Hyden suggested an interlocal agreement with cities on Solid Waste. (Sabine County, Hemphill and Pineland) Commissioner Cox said he is unhappy because he receives information the day before the meetings.

#5 - Bid opening for County Barn:

Motion was made by Commissioner Clark to table project to a later date. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried.

#7 - Rita Haney presented her letter and a plat of Piney Point in Precinct 4 showing Road "A", which is the road in question. She asked that this road "A" be accepted and maintained as a County road. Commissioner Chester Cox stated this was never a road, and big trees have been growing there a long time. Commissioner Clark stated before the county can take the road, a road would have to be built. All roads in Subdivision were accepted at same time, and Commissioner Cox has not failed by not maintaining road because there is nothing to maintain. Judge Hyden asked if this was a County Road or a public road? Commissioner Cox answered it is definitely not a County road. Commissioner Smith's belief is the property belongs to the County, and was dedicated and accepted as a public road on the plat.

Motion was made by Commissioner Cox to abandon road; then he withdrew his motion. At this time he plans to do nothing.

Court recessed 10 minutes: Re-convened at 10:40.

#8 - Corp. of Engineers - U. S. Forest service:

The Corp. of Engineers and U. S. Forest Service is wanting to contract Law Enforcement Patrols at Mill Creek Park, Indian Mounds, Willow Oaks, and Red Hill Lake. An additional deputy is required to fullfill contract - Corps of Engineers to pay \$9,780.00 and Forest Service will pay \$6,000.00 for period 4/1/1993 through 9/30/1993. Motion made by Judge Larry Hyden to hire deputy upon receipt of contract and continuation of same- Contract ends, employment ends. Commissioner Lynn Smith seconded and motion carried.

9 - El Camino Subdivision - No action at this time.

#10 - Rock Creek Bridge - Prct. 3 : Commissioner White informed Court bridge is falling in in middle. No action until next meeting.

11 - Bridge on Easley Creek-Bridge has fallen in twice. New bridge needs to be at least 70 feet long to span the creek on each end. No action at this time.

12 - Motion made by Judge Hyden to go out for bids for new patrol unit. Commissioner Clark seconded, and motion carried, with all voting for. This unit is funded by the Performance Reward Program from the Criminal Justice Department.

#13 - Motion made by Commissioner Kenneth White to go out for bids for a 70 horsepower tractor and bush hog for Prct. 3. Anticipated cost not to exceed \$23,000.00; \$5,000.00 to be paid from current funds with balance financed with time warrant coming due October 30, 1993. Commissioner Clark seconded, with all voting for. Bid opening March 2'2th.

Tammy Reeves, Tax Assessor/Collector, asked for additional telephone line and two telephones for her office. The cost of this will be \$189.90, plus labor of \$85.00 per hour. Motion was made by Commissioner White that Tax Office be approved for second line. Commissioner Clark seconded, and motion carried.

Commissioner Chester Cox made motion to approve line item transfers presented for Tax Office. Commissioner Lynn Smith seconded, and motion carried. "See Exhibit."

Motion made by Commissioner Smith to approve consolidation of voting precincts to one for each commissioner precinct for run-off election and any other special elections for this year. Commissioner Clark seconded, and all voted for.

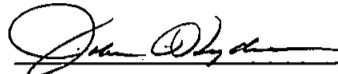

Motion made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Cox to pay bills. Motion carried.

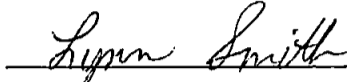

COMMISSIONER, PRCT. # 1



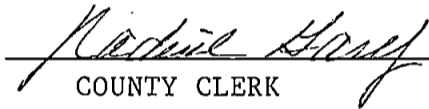
COMMISSIONER, PRCT. # 2

We, Donald F. and M. Rita Haney, being property owners and taxpayers in Sabine County present the following contentions and request to the Commissioners Court of Sabine County to wit:

1. The Piney Point Subdivision was developed by Joe P. Smith and Doris Smith Gratehouse and did dedicate to the public all roads and easements so reflected in the plat, a copy of which is attached as exhibit "A".
2. The Commissioners Court accepted and approved such dedication on the 9th day of December, 1968. Such acceptance is reflected by the County Judge's and Commissioners' signature appearing on the plat.
3. No exclusions were noted on the plat or the Court records.
4. The road would serve a public purpose to at least four (4) adjacent landowners.

Therefore; we contend all roads in the Subdivision were accepted as public/county roads. We further contend that all roads with the exception of "A" road has been continually maintained and improved by the county since date of acceptance.

Further, we contend no exception to maintenance should be made and the County has failed to meet its responsibility in maintaining the road marked and identified on the plat, (for reference only), "A" road.

We respectfully request the Commissioners Court and the Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, (Chester Cox), immediately begin and continue to maintain, in an appropriate way and manner, the road identified as "A" road.

In an offer of good faith, we would agree to "deed" the County fifteen (15) feet of our land lying next and adjacent to the current platted road to effect a total width of forty (40) feet. The County will be responsible for all surveying and associated costs.

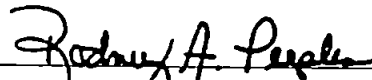

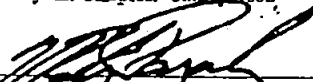

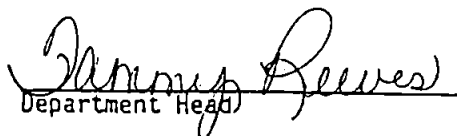
