Meeting called to order by Judge Larry Hyden; Brother Clarence Howell led opening prayer.

Minutes of the last two meetings were read and approved.

Monthly reports were presented for approval.

Motion was made by Judge Larry Hyden to allow the Hemphill Lions Club to continue with Mayfest on the square same as Channel 4 C B Club has done. Commissioner Keith Clark seconded, and motion carried. The C B Club has disbanded.

#4 - Solid Waste:

Judge Hyden gave report on Solid Waste; he explained county landfills will be closed by July 31. Residents should contact local contract haulers before this date. No action taken.

Commissioner Chester Cox informed the court he has used bridge material he no longer needs. John Toner, County Extension Agent, can use this material for his work on the park behind the jail. Motion made by Judge Hyden to donate used bridge materials to Mr. Toner for use at park on County property behind jail. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried.

Purchase of used Rex Mixer for Precincts was discussed. Judge Hyden will check price of one in Louisiana and have answer in writing next meeting.


Motion made by Commissioner Cox to pay accounts and salaries. Commissioner Clark seconded, and motion carried.

Commissioner Cox asked Judge Hyden to see if we can legally use excess Forest Service money to buy gravel for upkeep of roads. During budget workshop we did not have to buy gravel; now this supply has run out.


Motion made by Commissioner Chester Cox, seconded by Commissioner Lynn Smith, meeting adjourn. Motion carried.






COMMISSIONER, PRCT. # 1
