1 - Time warrant - Gradall

Judge Hyden stated payment of \$25,000.00 plus interest of \$4,058.88 was made on gradall. This leaves a balance of \$25,200.00 due April 28, 1994. Instead of a time warrant for each precinct, it has been combined into one warrant.


Motion made by Judge Hyden, Court enter into time warrant; there is remaining a note at First State Bank, Hemphill, amount of \$25,200.00, and that time warrant be issued in that amount, bearing an interest rate of prime, floating, for one year - principal and interest coming due on April 28, 1994, and that further this court binds all future courts, and particularly the next fiscal year to levy and assess taxes sufficient to pay the principal and establish a sinking fund minimum of 2% to pay the interest. Motion and order to be signed by County Judge and all commissioners. Commissioner Keith Clark seconded, and all voted for.


2 - Resolution for Grant - Texas Forest Service:


Motion made by Judge Hyden that Judge be authorized on behalf of the County to pursue any and all grant funding which may be available for such purpose, including, but not limited to the Texas Forest Service. Commissioner Smith seconded, and all voted for.

WHEREAS, Sabine County is in need of funds to purchase materials and supplies for the installation of Dry Fire Hydrants; and


WHEREAS, Grant funding from the Texas Forest Service may be available; and



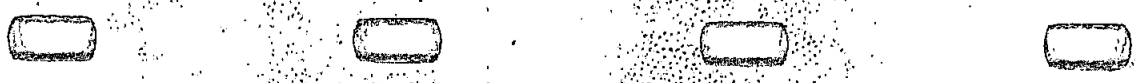

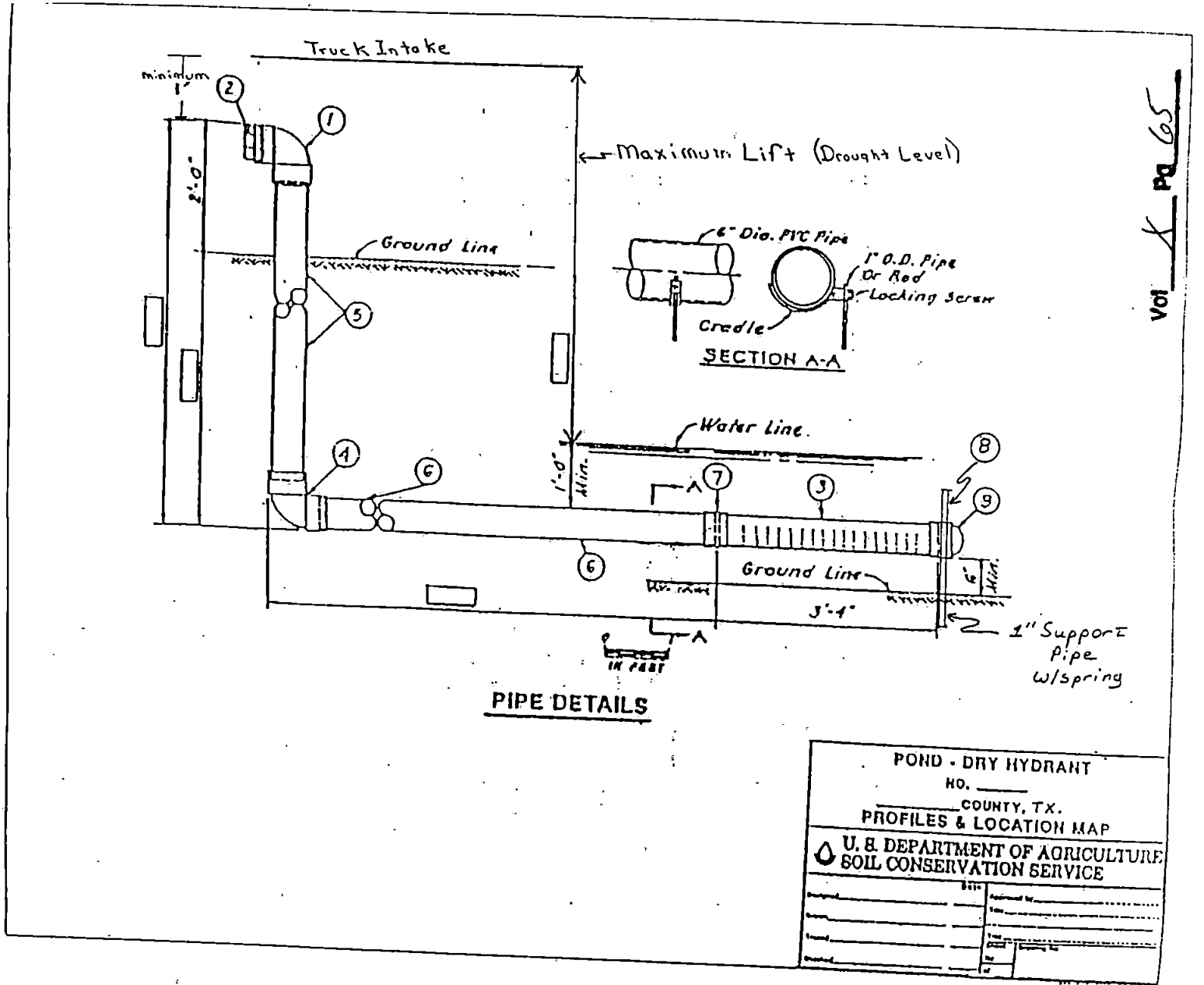

**RESTRICTIONS OF TIMBERLANE ESTATES SUBDIVISION
OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS**

THE STATE OF TEXAS)
COUNTY OF SABINE)

WHEREAS, an instrument approved by a majority of the membership of the TIMBERLANE PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. hereinafter called THE ASSOCIATION, whose membership is composed of all lot owners of the TIMBERLANE ESTATES SUBDIVISION, which has been recorded in Plat File No. 1, Page 171, on the 24th day of October 1972, plus one lot of 0.829 acres, located to the south of the association boat ramp, filed in Deed Record Volume 253, page 640 of Sabine County, Texas on the 10th day of April 1972, to which documents and record references is hereby made for all purposes: and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable and advisable for the benefit of the public in general and persons purchasing lots in said Subdivision to place restrictions and conditions thereon designating and describing the manner and for what purposes property in said Subdivision may be used, and the type and size of structures to be erected in said Subdivision, which purposes are to be effectuated by these Restrictions.

NOW THEREFOR, THE ASSOCIATION hereby replaces the deed restrictions established by M. M. and K. Enterprises, effective until the 24th day of October 1972, with the following reservations, conditions, and restrictions of the TIMBERLANE ESTATES SUBDIVISION, to be covenants running with the land, and to inure to the use and benefit of their heirs, successors, and assigns, and each and every person purchasing or owning land in said Subdivision.

LAND USE AND BUILDING TYPES

No lot shall be used except for residential purposes with the exception of the designated boat ramp and water well sites. The aforementioned exceptions shall be the exclusive properties in this subdivision on which other than residential activities will be permitted. No building shall be erected, altered, placed, or permitted to remain on any lot other than one detached single family dwelling having a livable area of at least six hundred (600) square feet along with appropriate accessory buildings, or one approved late model manufactured type of mobile home of minimum square footage of five hundred (500) square feet. Every building constructed or placed on any lot shall be of new construction, to the exclusion of old houses being

moved into the subdivision. All exterior walls of all such buildings and improvements shall be of wood or masonry. The use of particle board, tar paper, plastics, galvanized tin, rolled brick siding or similar materials as exterior walls is not permitted. Complete skirting around mobile homes is required within one hundred eighty days (180) after parking in subdivision. The skirting can be slatted or solid and must be installed in a neat workman like manner. The exterior of any structure must be painted within six (6) months, with the exception of exterior cedar siding which may not require paint or stain. In addition, no contrived structures or trailers such as old school bus bodies shall be permitted. No more than one dwelling of any nature whatsoever shall be permitted to remain on any lot in this subdivision.

TEMPORARY STRUCTURES

No structure of a temporary character, tent, shack, barn, or other outbuilding shall be used on any lot as a residence, except that a lot owner is permitted to camp on his lot for a period not to exceed fourteen days continuous occupancy. This shall not exclude the erection of temporary quarters such as a camper, motor home, or travel trailer not in continuous use during the construction of a permanent dwelling, provided such temporary structure is not permitted to remain more than six (6) months in such use, and provided that the use of such structure is not in violation of sanitation and health regulations applicable thereto, and further provided such temporary quarters will be removed upon the completion of the construction or placement of permanent dwelling on said lot. If more than six (6) months is required an exception must be obtained from the Board of Directors.

BUILDING LOCATION

No building or structure shall be located on any lot nearer to the front or side lot line than twenty (20) feet. Under certain unique circumstances, where hardship can be demonstrated, the Board of Directors may grant a variance to the twenty foot side lot requirement, as specified under variances below. No building shall be located nearer than five (5) feet to an interior lot line, except that a three (3) foot side yard shall be required for a garage or other permitted accessory building located twenty (20) feet or more from the front property lot line. Where rear property lines abut each other, no residence shall be located nearer than ten (10) feet from the property line, and no accessory building shall be permitted nearer than three (3) feet from the property line. Building on lots abutting the Sabine River Authority or the National Forest must abide by regulations of these respective agencies.



SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS

No privies or outside toilet facilities shall be constructed or maintained on any lot, and any sewage disposal systems shall be of a type approved or recommended by the state and local departments of health, and shall be maintained by the owner at all times in a proper sanitary condition and in accordance with applicable state and county sanitary laws. All septic tanks and soil absorption fields located on all lots shall comply with the sewage waste disposal provisions of the Sabine River Authority of Texas Policy Manual.

EASEMENTS

Easements for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved for a distance of ten (10) feet from the front lot line and three (3) feet from the rear lot line where a lot abuts another lot and for a distance of three (3) feet inside each and every side lot line, with the exception of the rear lot line on water front lots or where a lot abuts the National Forest, where no reservation is made.

SUBDIVISION WATER SYSTEM AND STREET LIGHTING

A central water system and service line to each lot will be provided by THE ASSOCIATION and shall be operated in accordance with the State of Texas Directives. No individual water wells for potable water will be permitted. Street lighting will be provided from the Association fees, which are approved by a majority of the Association's membership.

NUISANCES

No noxious or offensive trade of activity shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall any activity be conducted thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the residents of the subdivision. No manufacturing or commercial enterprise, or enterprise of any kind for profit shall be maintained upon, in front of, or in connection with the lots in the subdivision, nor shall said lots in any way be used for other than strictly residential purposes. All recreational vehicles must be operated in accordance with appropriate Federal, State, County and Sabine River Authority restrictions and in such manner as not to be a nuisance.

GARBAGE AND REFUGE DISPOSAL

No lot shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubbish. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept except in sanitary containers. Each lot owner shall be responsible for disposing of all of his trash, garbage, and rubbish in a sanitary manner and in an approved location.

LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY

No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on any lot, except that dogs, cats, or other household pets may be kept provided that they are not kept, bred, or maintained for any commercial purpose. Household pets cannot be kept in such manner or numbers that they become a public nuisance. Aggressive or Vicious Animals will be kept on a leash or within a fence at all times.

FIREARMS

Firearms shall not be used or displayed in any irresponsible or dangerous manner, nor shall firearms be discharged within the subdivision. Firearms use is subject to Federal, State and Sabine River Authority regulations. Pellet and B.B. guns are specifically included as firearms.

OIL AND MINING OPERATIONS

No oil drilling, oil development operations, oil refining, quarrying or mining operations of any kind shall be permitted upon or in any lot, nor shall oil wells, tanks, tunnels, mineral excavations or shafts be permitted upon or in any lot. No derrick or other structures designed for use in boring for oil, or natural gas shall be erected, maintained or permitted on any lot.

MISCELLANEOUS

Butane tanks must be placed or landscaped so that they are not visible to the general public or other residents. Unsightly outside storage of junk, non-functioning vehicles, lumber, building materials, etc., after completion of construction will not be permitted.

TERM OF RESTRICTIONS

These covenants are to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them for a period of twenty



(20) years from the date these covenants are recorded, after which said covenants shall be automatically extended for successive periods of ten (10) years unless an instrument approved by a majority of the then owners of lots has been recorded, agreeing to change said covenants in whole or in part.

ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement of these covenants and restrictions may be by proceeding of law or in equity against any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any covenant or restriction, either to restrain such violation or proposed violation, or to recover damages. Such enforcement may be by the owner of any lot in said subdivision and/or the BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

VARIANCES

Where these Restrictions of Timberlane Estates do not adequately cover a situation, or unique unforeseen problems arise, the Board of Directors shall clarify or grant an exception or variance. However, request for variances must be made prior to construction. The Board of Directors may grant a variance only if they are of the opinion that the intent of the Restrictions of Timberlane Estates are adhered to.

INVALIDATION OF PROVISION

Invalidation of any one or more of these covenants or restrictions by a judgment of any court shall in no wise affect any of the other covenants, restrictions and provisions herein contained, which shall remain in full force and effect.

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FIREARMS AND OFF-ROAD VEHICLES

Officers of the TEPOA have been asked questions concerning the use of firearms and the use of Off-Road Vehicles (ORVS) or All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVS) within Timberlane Estates. The following laws of the State of Texas, or Regulations of the Forest Service are provided as information.

A. Firearms:

1. It is a violation of State Law to:
 - (A) Discharge firearms within 500 feet of a dwelling or a road.
 - (B) Discharge a firearm across a road.
2. It is a violation of Forest Service Regulations to discharge a weapon over Toledo Bend Lake Waters. (Duck hunting, ect, have specific regulations).
3. Pellet guns and B.B. guns are considered to be firearms. (In accordance with Sabine National Forest Regulations).

*B. OFF-ROAD Vehicles (ORVS) or All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVS):

1. Off-Road or All-Terrain vehicles are permitted on National Forest Lands, with certain exceptions. Information on areas open or closed to these vehicles may be obtained from the Forest Service.
2. Public roads are closed to ORVS or ATVS (as per State Law).
3. All operators of ORVS or ATVS must have a state drivers license or state identification card in his/her possession.
4. A person younger than fourteen (14) years of age operating an ATV must be accompanied by and under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian, or an adult so authorized by the parent or guardian of the ATV operator.

*Reference: USDA Forest Service, Sabine National Forest off-road and ATV vehicle regulations.
