Commissioner Clark informed the court Mr. Jim Campbell has resigned as litter control and road permitting deputy. Judge Hyden asked court to re-affirm hiring someone the sherrif recommends and court approves to enforce garbage control and road permits. Commissioner Clark made this motion and Commissioner Cox seconded. Motion carried, with three voting for. Commissioner Lynn Smith abstained.
