

Monday, August 9, 1993, the Sabine county Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A.M., with the following members present:

Judge Larry Hyden called meeting to order. Opening prayer was led by Brother Clarence Howell.

Minutes of the last two meetings were approved as read.

Judge Hyden stated he, Commissioners Clark, Smith and Cox plan to attend a meeting in Diboll August 24.

Tammy Reeves, Tax Assessor/Collector, was present and gave a report on effective tax rate and roll-back rate which will be published in this week's Reporter.

Motion was made by Commissioner Lynn Smith, seconded by Commissioner Keith Clark, to approve 11 holidays for fiscal year 1993-1994. Motion carried, with all voting for. "See attached list."

Commissioner Clark made motion, seconded by Commissioner White, to approve Treasurer's Quarterly report. Motion carried.

Judge Hyden asked from Court a record vote of understanding that at the end of first fiscal quarter of next year the budget may be revised in accordance with actual revenue received - versus projected revenue of budget. Judge Hyden then made this into a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Clark. Motion carried with all voting for.

John Toner, County Extension Agent, gave a report of his activities for last month and his plans for coming months.

#6 - Sheriff Bradberry informed the Court our county jail complies with requirements in Local Government Code, and Texas Minimum Jail Standards.

#3 - Rod's Road - Beechwood, Precinct 2 - Pam Morris, representing residents of this subdivision, presented a petition requesting this road be accepted as a county maintained road. Commissioner Smith made the motion to accept approximately 1/2 mile known as Rod's Road as county road. Judge Hyden seconded, and all voted for.

7 - Road to Tebo from 1592 - No action- agenda item 8/23.

9 - Road by Fairdale Church - 200 or 300 yards - Commissioner Lynn Smith made motion to close this road and let property divert back to church property. Commissioner Clark seconded and motion carried.

12 - Texas County & District Retirement System:
Judge Hyden recommends the county adopt ADCR plan at 7%, and 80% rate on COLA. No action taken at this time.

No changes made on Policy/Procedures Manual.

Commissioner Clark asked that speed limit - Harborlight Subdivision be an agenda item August 23.

#8 - Dump truck - Precinct 3- No action - agenda item 8/23.

#10 - Opening bids to^{buy}/oil storage tanks and vehicles:

Only one bid on OST; that from Polk Oil services in Lufkin:

275 gallon tanks - \$325.00 560 gallon tanks - \$525.00

Motion was made by Judge Hyden seconded by Commissioner Clark we accept this bid. Motion carried.

Only one bid was received on 1981 Oldsmobile - This from Patsy Helmer for \$325.00. Judge Hyden made motion to accept this bid. Commissioner Smith seconded, and motion carried.

#11 - Neches communications - Motion made by Commissioner Keith Clark to proceed with obtaining a two-way radio system from Neches Communications for the county's Road and Bridge Department. Judge Hyden seconded, and all voted for. This will be for a price of \$5,000.00 to \$6,000.00.

Motion made by Commissioner Clark, seconded by Commissioner Cox, to pay accounts and salaries. All voted for.

Commissioner Clark informed the court Mr. Jim Campbell has resigned as litter control and road permitting deputy. Judge Hyden asked court to re-affirm hiring someone the sheriff recommends and court approves to enforce garbage control and road permits. Commissioner Clark made this motion and Commissioner Cox seconded. Motion carried, with three voting for. Commissioner Lynn Smith abstained.




Before October 1 each Commissioner will pay as used, paying from temporary help, or line-item transfers. Anything in addition to more than four days per week will be paid for individually.


Commissioner Clark asked as a matter of record "since two commissioners did not want a secretary, they should not be allowed to use her."


