#1 - Department of Transportation FM 2343 Exit:

Motion made by Commissioner Lynn Smith to approve the agreement with Texas Highway Department on the extension of FM 2343. Commissioner Chester Cox seconded, and motion carried.

#2 - Line Item Transfers: R&B #1 - Motion made by Judge Hyden to accept and approve as presented. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried.

Line item transfers presented by Commissioner, Prct. 2. Judge Hyden made motion to accept and approve. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried.

Prct. 3 & 4 - Judge Hyden made motion to approve line item transfers presented by Commissioners 3 & 4. Commissioner Clark seconded, and motion carried.

Judge Hyden made motion, seconded by Commissioner Cox to approve line item transfers presented by Sheriff Bradberry. Motion carried.

# 3 - Courthouse and Courthouse Annex:

Judge Hyden stated we can build courthouse annex from current funds, but feels he should call a bond election and put it before the people and let the people decide. The earliest date we can hold a special election is in January, 1994.


Judge Thomas Hamilton stated we do need more space in the courthouse. He does not feel we should hold an election for annex, just build it.

Motion made by Commissioner Clark to pay bills. Commissioner Smith seconded, and all voted for.


Commissioner Clark made motion to adjourn. Meeting adjourned.
