

March 28, 1994, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in a regular meeting. The following members were present:

Judge Hyden called the meeting to order.

Bro. Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Minutes of the March 14, 1994 Commissioners' Court regular meeting were approved as read with the correction of the word conversation to conservation.

Agenda item #2 Reports

Reports were given from Tammy Reeves, Tax Assessor/Collector; Thomas Hamilton, JP #1 Pl. 1; Daniel Featherston, JP #2 Pl. 1; Jimmy Clark, JP #1 Pl. 2; Sheriff Bradberry and Janice McDaniel, County Clerk. Commissioner Clark made a motion to accept reports as given. Commissioner White seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #3 Speed Limit Toledo Beach

Commissioner Smith made a motion to set the speed limit at 20 mph in the Toledo Beach Subdivision. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. Commissioner Smith informed the Court that there is 5 1/2 miles of roads in this subdivision.

Agenda items 5 & 6 Rosevine Ballot Box and Establish Pineland Ballot Box

In the March 14, 1994 regular Commissioners' Court meeting, the motion made by Commissioner White and seconded by Judge Hyden as stated "Request permission from the Justice Department to re-establish the voting box in Rosevine and establish a voting box in Pineland for Commissioner Pct. #3 only, changing no Pct. lines, simply as a convenience to the public" was brought back before the Court. The motion had ended in a tie vote in the March 14th meeting due to the fact that only 3 Commissioners and Judge Hyden were present at that meeting.

Judge Hyden presented the same motion back to the Court. Commissioner White seconded. Court recessed at this time (9:30 A.M.) without a vote on the motion and second.

Court reconvened at 9:55 A.M.

Judge Hyden made a motion to table the motion and second until the last agenda item today. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Buckshot Walker met with the Court to give an update on the community service workers. From March 1 through March 19th, they had put in approximately 480 hours. They have been picking up trash on the highways. The plan is to start working on county roads in about a week, clearing roadsides and cleaning ditches, etc.

Agenda item #7 Continuing Education

Judge Hyden made a motion to accept and recognize the certificates for hours of continuing education for Commissioner Lynn Smith. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

Agenda item #8 Treatment of Termites

Commissioner Clark made a motion to get Steve Conn to spray for termites.

Commissioner White seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #9 County Hospitalization Insurance Request for Proposals

Commissioner Clark made a motion to go out for request for proposals for health insurance. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached exhibit. Commissioner Smith made a motion to accept proposals from April 12 until April 25, 1994, with final decision to be made on April 25. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. All proposals are to go to the County Clerks office. The proposals are to be reviewed by Commissioner Smith, Commissioner Clark and Janice McDaniel, County Clerk and to bring recommendations to the Court.

Agenda item #10 Pay Accounts and Salaries

Commissioner Clark made a motion to pay accounts and salaries. Commissioner Cox seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #4 911

Judge Hyden made a motion to extend the time for the public hearing on those roads previously submitted by the 911 committee until April 25. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Judge Hyden brought the meeting back to the discussion on the voting boxes. At 10:45 A.M. Judge Hyden turned the Court over to Commissioner Chester Cox, Sr., Judge Pro Tem. Commissioner Cox recessed Court for 15 minutes.

Court reconvened at 11:08 A.M. with Judge Hyden back in Court.

Commissioner Cox commended Commissioner White on her preparation and presentation of the re-establishing of the Rosevine voting box and establishing a voting box in Pineland. The vote was brought back before the Court in re-establishing the Rosevine voting box per lines agreed upon and opening a box in the Pineland area for Commissioner Pct. #3. Judge Hyden, Commissioner White and Commissioner Smith voted for. Commissioner Clark and Commissioner Cox voted against. Motion carried. This is to ask the Justice Department for permission. See attached exhibits. Judge Hyden made a motion to identify Bethal Chapel Fellowship Hall, pending approval from the Church, as the location for the new voting box in Pineland for Commissioner Pct. #3. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. Judge Hyden made a motion to identify the Rosevine Volunteer Fire Department building, pending approval, as the location for the Rosevine voting box. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Under General business, Judge Hyden proposed to the Court that County Clerk, Janice McDaniel, Commissioner Smith and the Democratic Chairman, Tracy Lane be appointed by the Court to check into other voting systems.

Commissioner Cox made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Clark seconded. Meeting adjourned.

Cost, stability of insurer, services offered, degree of self-insurance required, deductibles, maximum and minimum levels of coverage afforded with cost being the most important relative criteria.

Discussion will be conducted with responsible offerors who submit proposals determined to be reasonably susceptible of being selected for award. Offerors will be accorded fair and equal treatment with respect to any opportunity for discussion and revision of proposals, and revisions will be permitted after submission and before award for the purpose of obtaining best and final offers.

Offerors will be provided information as to current coverage, census, etc. This information may be obtained from the office of County Clerk, County Judge, Sabine County.

The Commissioners Court will hear the proposals beginning April 12, 1994 with a final award being made April 25, 1994.





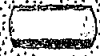
