Agenda item #1 - Solicit Bids for Rock Grinding Equipment -

Commissioner Lynn Smith made the motion to advertise for bids on a new tract excacator equipped with a grinding head suitable for harvesting of glauconite rock for road base. Excavator shall have air conditioning, a minimum of 207 HP diesel engine at 2200 RPM's, a minimum weight of 68,000 pounds and a minimum boom reach of 20 feet at ground level. Hydraulic oil must be plumb to grinding head with a minimum of 80 gallons per minute. Total hydraulic oil reservior shall be at least 160 gallon capacity and oil pressure shall be set at 3500 PSI. Excavator with grinding attachment installed and ready to work shall be delivered to Sabine County within 30 days after awarding of contract. Bids shall be accepted until 1:00 P.M., June 15, 1994 with opening of bids at 1:30 P.M.. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.
