Judge Hyden brought the meeting to order at 8:32 A.M. Bro. Clarence Howell led the Court in prayer.

General Business - Minutes of the May 16th, May 23rd., May 24th., May 25th. and May 31st. Commissioners' Court meetings were approved as read.

John Toner, County Extension Agent, presented certificates of continuing education to Judge Hyden, Commissioners Clark, Smith and White. These hours were incurred during the County Judges and Commissioners Conference January 3-5, 1994, V. G. Young Institute of County Government. Each one received 16 hours continuing education. See attached exhibits.

Rosie Hamilton ask the Court if she may speak even though she is not on the agenda. Judge Hyden told her that she could speak to the Court, but that no action could be taken.

Mrs. Hamilton told the Court that she would like for her Commissioner to maintain the road to her house. Commissioner Clark told her that his men had checked the road and it is in pretty good shape. Agenda item #4-911

The funds have been expended at present, But Judge Hyden has authorized them to continue through this month. There <sup>are</sup> more funds to be released supposedly July 6. Any money spent to pay employees will be reimbursed. No action taken.

Agenda item #5-Resolution Authorizing Reimbursement to General Fund from Anticipation Notes

Judge Hyden made the motion to approve the Resolution in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$150,000.00. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

Agenda item #6-Consider Tax Abatement/Easement Policy - Sabine County

Judge Hyden made a motion that the tax abatement/easement policy as submitted be approved. Commissioner Smith seconded. Commissioner Smith amended the policy to read jobs created from 6-24 to 1-24. Judge Hyden made the motion to appoint retired Judge Roy Fillyaw of Newton County to fill in for Judge Hyden in his absence on any judicial matters. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #9-Solid Waste

To be on June 27, 1994 Commissioners' Court regular meeting.

Agenda item #10-Petition Requesting Hearing-- Gravel Hill Road - Setting of Hearing by Court for 9:00 A.M., July 12, 1994. See attached exhibit. No action taken at this time.

Agenda item #11-Sabine County Courthouse Texas Historical Society/Action on Summit Engineering Bid

Judge Hyden made a motion that based on comments made by the Historical Commission that we rescind any action previously taken awarding the contract of the roof to Summit Engineering and that we refund his \$2500.00 bid bond. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Judge Hyden made the motion to proceed with the application for the grant to Texas Department of Transportation for funding under ICE TEA. That we engage the services of an architect with suggestion that it be Goodwin-Lassiter to assist in preparing the necessary drawing for submission of that grant. Commissioner Cox seconded. Commissioner Smith made a motion to go out for bids for Computer and Computer Software for the Tax Office with bids to be received until 4:00 P.M. June 24th and to be opened at the regular June 27th Court meeting. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

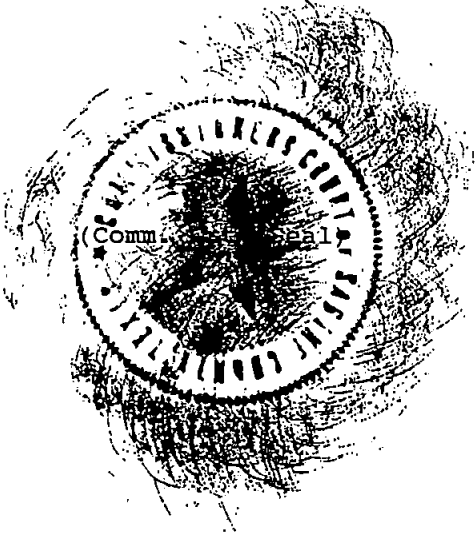

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DECLARATION OF  
OFFICIAL INTENT OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT  
OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS RELATING TO THE  
FINANCING OF RENOVATION OF THE COUNTY COURTHOUSE  
AND THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN EXPENDITURES**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court ("Commissioners Court") of Sabine County, Texas ("County") has the authority to expend County funds for the purpose of financing the construction of renovations to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has been made aware that the expenditure of funds for these purposes should begin in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has previously passed a declaration of official intent relating reimbursement for the expenditure of \$25,000 for the construction of new rest rooms in the courthouse, and now finds that these additional items need to be paid for prior to the time that the County's tax exempt financing can be completed; and

WHEREAS, the cost associated with the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex is estimated to be approximately \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court intends to include the cost associated with the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex with other items as may be designated by the Commissioners Court in its Order authorizing the financing; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Commissioners Court to pay part of the cost of improving the courthouse by the construction of renovations to the courthouse, the acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex in the amount not to exceed \$150,000 with moneys legally available therefor in the County's General Fund, and to reimburse the General Fund with tax-exempt debt in an amount equal to such expenditure from the proceeds of a future tax-exempt County bond issue, or any other legal means of tax-exempt financing for the costs associated with the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Commissioners Court to finance costs associated with the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex through the issuance of bonds, certificates of obligation or other tax exempt debt, and the Commissioners Court reasonably expects the maximum principal amount of the bonds, notes or other tax-exempt debt to be issued for the and such other matters designated in the Order authorizing issuance of the bonds, certificates or other tax-exempt debt will be approximately \$430,000 to \$450,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

1. The Commissioners Court hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for the payment for the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex being paid from moneys legally available therefor in the County's General Fund.

2. It is the intent of the Commissioners Court to reimburse the General Fund of the County in an amount equal to the actual expenditure, not to exceed \$150,000 from the proceeds of a future tax-exempt bond, certificates of obligation or other issue.

3. The reimbursement to the General Fund shall take place no later than three years after (a) the date the moneys are expended, or (b) the date the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex are put in service or abandoned.

4. The funds authorized to be expended herein are to be used solely for capital expenditures to acquire, construct or rehabilitate property having a reasonably expected economic life of at least one year and preliminary start up expenditures.

5. This Declaration is a declaration to meet the requirements of Federal law to establish its official intent to reimburse itself for expenditures made after the date of this Declaration. It is also made to evidence its intent to make such reimbursements under article 717k-6, § 7(b), TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. ANN.

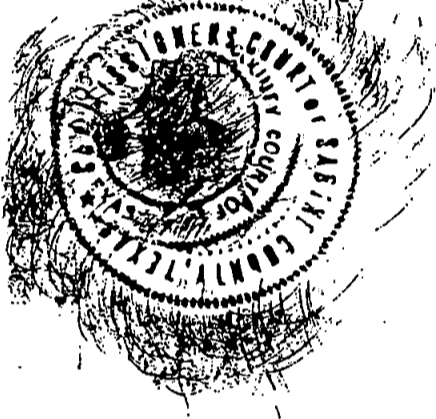

SABINE COUNTY BUSINESS INCENTIVE; TAX EASEMENT POLICY

1. Proposed Incentives;

Sabine County proposes the offering of tax easement to qualified businesses within the Sabine County Reinvestment Zone.

11. Description of Incentive;

Sabine County has agreed to abate the increased valuation of property taxes on property developed, improved to qualified businesses in the reinvestment zone. The amount of tax abated on any increment in value added to ad valorem value of the property will be determined by the following criteria

A. Economic Development Policy

1. Abatements will be granted for 100% of value during construction. The period of construction may not extend beyond 2 years from the execution of the Abatement Contract. The total period of abatement may not exceed 10 years inclusive of the construction period in any case.

\*In accordance with Tax Code 312, no abatement period shall extend beyond 10 years. If a qualified project takes a full 24 months to complete its building phase, the period of abatement eligibility following construction would therefore be reduced to 8 years.

111. General Purpose and Objectives:

Sabine County is committed to the promotion of high quality development and to an ongoing improvement in the quality of life for its citizens. Insofar as these objectives are generally served by the enhancement and expansion of the local economy, the County Commissioner's Court finds that said consideration will be provided in accordance with the procedures and criteria outlined in this document. Nothing herein shall imply or suggest that Sabine County is under any obligation to provide tax abatement to any applicant. All applicants shall be considered on a case-by case basis.

1V. Definitions

A. "Abatement" means the full or partial exemption from ad valorem taxes of the increase in value of certain real and personal property in a reinvestment zone designated by Sabine County for economic development purposes.

B. "Agreement" means a contractual agreement between a property owner and Sabine County for the purposes of tax abatement.

C. "Base year value" means the assessed value of eligible property of January 1 preceding the execution of the agreement.

D. "Deferred maintenance" means improvements necessary for continued operations which do not improve productivity or alter the process technology.

E. "Expansion" means the addition of buildings, structures, or fixed machinery or equipment for purposes of increasing production capacity.

F. "Facility" means property improvements completed or in the process of construction which together comprise an integral whole.

G. "Manufacturing Facility" means buildings and structures, including fixed machinery and equipment, the primary purpose of which is or will be the manufacture of tangible goods or materials or the processing of such goods or materials by physical or chemical change.

H. "Modernization" means a complete or partial demolition of facilities and the complete or partial reconstruction or installation of similar or expanded production capacity. Modernization may result from the construction, alteration, or installation of buildings, structures, and fixed machinery and equipment, or both.

I. "New facility" means a property previously undeveloped which is placed into service by means other than or in conjunction with expansion or modernization.

J. "Existing facility" means a facility or business that has been in operation for more than five years.

#### V. Abatement Authorized

A. All types of Facilities/Projects will be eligible for abatement if they meet the criteria set forth in this policy.

B. Creation of New Value Abatement may only be granted for the additional value resulting from improvements to eligible property made subsequent to and specified in an abatement agreement between Sabine County and the property owner, subject to such limitation as the County may require.

C. New and Existing Facilities Abatement may be granted for new facilities and improvements to existing facilities for purposes of modernization or expansion.

D. Eligible Real Property. An abatement may be extended to the value of the buildings, structures, fixed machinery and equipment and site improvements plus that office space necessary to the operation and administration of the facility.


E. Eligible Personal Property. The following types of property shall also be eligible for abatement; land, inventories, supplies, tools, furnishings and other forms of moveable personal

property, vehicles, vessels, aircraft, housing, hotel accommodation, deferred maintenance investments, property which has a useful life of less than 15 years.


F. Owned/Leased Facilities. In order for a facility to qualify for abatement, the land and eligible property must be owned by the same individual or company or leased to a facility operator whose lease commitment is at least 15 years.


G. Expansion of Existing Facility/Business. A facility or business that has been in operation for 5 years or more and meets the other requirements as set forth in this policy will be eligible as set forth in Section 11.



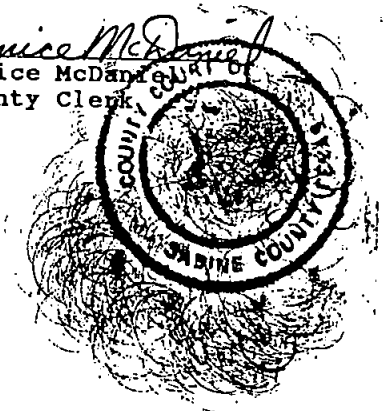

ORDER SETTING HEARING

ON THIS DATE came on for consideration the petition filed in this Court by HARVEY P. BOUDREAUX, requesting that the Court, pursuant to the County Road and Bridge Act, TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. Art. 6702-1, and following notice and hearing, order the opening of the Gravel Hill Road, alleged to be a public road located in Sabine County, Texas, as more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference, and further declaring it a public or county road, across the lands more particularly described in Exhibit B attached hereto and incorporated by reference, and having considered same;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that said petition be, and the same is hereby set for hearing at a special term of this Court to be held on the 19th day of July, 1994, beginning at 9:00 o'clock a.m., before this Court in the Sabine County Courthouse in Hemphill, Texas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice of said hearing and special term of Court shall be posted by the Sabine County Clerk in accordance with the requirements of law, and that all parties in interest in this matter shall be served with a true copy of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for Harvey P. Boudreaux and Jesse Marshall and wife, Nelwyn Melton Marshall,

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parties in interest, shall prepare, exchange and approve, prior to said hearing, summaries of the testimony of the witnesses who testified at the trial beginning May 30, 1989, in cause number 9623, in the District Court of Sabine County, Texas, styled "Harvey P. Boudreaux vs. Jesse Marshall, et ux", and that said approved summaries shall be admitted before this Court as evidence at said hearing, along with all exhibits admitted into evidence by the District Court in the course of said trial.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each side shall be limited to a maximum of six live witnesses at said hearing, and that the total time for direct questions or testimony of each side's witnesses shall not exceed 90 minutes, which may be divided up among the witnesses actually called by each side as desired.



PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF SAID COURT:

COMES NOW HARVEY P. BOUDREAU, PETITIONER, and requests that this honorable Court, following notice and hearing, order the opening of the Gravel Hill Road, a public road located in Sabine County, Texas, declaring it a public or county road, and with respect would show unto the Court as follows:

I.

Petitioner is the owner of an interest in a 46 acre tract of land located in Sabine County, Texas, more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference, which he purchased in 1969 through the Veterans Land Board.

II.

Petitioner's access to his property is from F. M. 1592 along a portion of a public road known as the Gravel Hill Road, which was declared to be a public county road by action of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County on October 26, 1971.

III.

The Gravel Hill Road is located on and along the east boundary line of a 50 acre tract of land fronting on F. M. 1592 owned by Jesse Marshall and wife, Nelwyn Melton Marshall, more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit B attached

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hereto. The Marshalls have attempted to close said public road by obstructing it and preventing its use by the public, including Petitioner. The portion of the Gravel Hill Road at issue is more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit C attached hereto.

IV.

On September 28, 1987, Petitioner filed suit against the Marshalls in the District Court of Sabine County, Texas, to prevent the obstruction of the road, in cause number 9623, styled "Harvey P. Boudreaux vs. Jesse Marshall, et ux". That case proceeded to trial before a jury on May 30, 1989, which resulted in entry of Judgment on June 9, 1989, declaring the roadway a public road, and enjoining the Marshalls from obstructing it. On June 30, 1992, the Twelfth District Court of Appeals in Tyler reversed the District Court's judgment for insufficient evidence, and remanded the case for a new trial in the District Court. On May 27, 1994, the District Court entered an order abating said lawsuit for a period not to exceed 60 days, and granting leave to petition this honorable Court to determine in an open hearing whether the roadway in question is a public or county road. A true copy of the District Court's order is attached as Exhibit D.

V.

Petitioner accordingly prays that the Commissioners Court of Sabine County exercise its authority under the County Road and Bridge Act, TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. Art. 6702-1, and order that the roadway in question is a public road, and that it be re-opened.

VI.


Petitioner further prays that this Court call a special term setting a date for hearing on this petition, and issue the appropriate notice and citation to all interested parties, and further that the Court, following conference with counsel for the parties, enter appropriate orders for the conduct of the hearing, including allowance for the use of evidence from the District Court's records in this matter, and reasonable limitations on the time of the hearing and number of witnesses, if appropriate.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Petitioner Harvey P. Boudreaux prays that, following notice and hearing, this Court order the relief requested herein, and for such other and further relief, at law or in equity, as to which Petitioner may show himself justly entitled.
