

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DECLARATION OF OFFICIAL INTENT OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS RELATING TO THE FINANCING OF RENOVATION OF THE COUNTY COURTHOUSE AND THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN EXPENDITURES

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court ("Commissioners Court") of Sabine County, Texas ("County") has the authority to expend County funds for the purpose of financing the construction of renovations to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has been made aware that the expenditure of funds for these purposes should begin in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has previously passed a declaration of official intent relating reimbursement for the expenditure of \$25,000 for the construction of new rest rooms in the courthouse, and now finds that these additional items need to be paid for prior to the time that the County's tax exempt financing can be completed; and

WHEREAS, the cost associated with the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex is estimated to be approximately \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court intends to include the cost associated with the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex with other items as may be designated by the Commissioners Court in its Order authorizing the financing; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Commissioners Court to pay part of the cost of improving the courthouse by the construction of renovations to the courthouse, the acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex in the amount not to exceed \$150,000 with moneys legally available therefor in the County's General Fund, and to reimburse the General Fund with tax-exempt debt in an amount equal to such expenditure from the proceeds of a future tax-exempt County bond issue, or any other legal means of tax-exempt financing for the costs associated with the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex; and

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WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Commissioners Court to finance costs associated with the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex through the issuance of bonds, certificates of obligation or other tax exempt debt, and the Commissioners Court reasonably expects the maximum principal amount of the bonds, notes or other tax-exempt debt to be issued for the and such other matters designated in the Order authorizing issuance of the bonds, certificates or other tax-exempt debt will be approximately \$430,000 to \$450,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

- 1. The Commissioners Court hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for the payment for the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex being paid from moneys legally available therefor in the County's General Fund.
- 2. It is the intent of the Commissioners Court to reimburse the General Fund of the County in an amount equal to the actual expenditure, not to exceed \$150,000 from the proceeds of a future tax-exempt bond, certificates of obligation or other issue.
- 3. The reimbursement to the General Fund shall take place no later than three years after (a) the date the moneys are expended, or (b) the date the construction of improvements to the county courthouse, acquisition and renovation of a building to be used as a courthouse annex, and the equipping of the courthouse and courthouse annex are put in service or abandoned.
- 4. The funds authorized to be expended herein are to be used solely for capital expenditures to acquire, construct or rehabilitate property having a reasonably expected economic life of at least one year and preliminary start up expenditures.
- 5. This Declaration is a declaration to meet the requirements of Federal law to establish its official intent to reimburse itself for expenditures made after the date of this Declaration. It is also made to evidence its intent to make such reimbursements under article 717k-6, § 7(b), Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Ann.

Moderation may result from the construction, alteration, or installation of buildings, structures, and fixed machinery and equipment, or both.

I. "New facility" means a property previously undeveloped which is placed into service by means other than or in conjunction with expansion or modernization.

J. "Existing facility" means a facility or business that has been in operation for more than five years.

COMES NOW HARVEY P. BOUDREAUX, PETITIONER, and requests that this honorable Court, following notice and hearing, order the opening of the Gravel Hill Road, a public road located in Sabine County, Texas, declaring it a public or county road, and with respect would show unto the Court as follows:

Petitioner is the owner of an interest in a 46 acre tract of land located in Sabine County, Texas, more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference, which he purchased in 1969 through the Veterans Land Board.

II.

Petitioner's access to his property is from F. M. 1592 along a portion of a public road known as the Gravel Hill Road, which was declared to be a public county road by action of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County on October 26, 1971.

III.

The Gravel Hill Road is located on and along the east boundary line of a 50 acre tract of land fronting on F. M. 1592 owned by Jesse Marshall and wife, Nelwyn Melton Marshall, more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit B attached

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hereto. The Marshalls have attempted to close said public road by obstructing it and preventing its use by the public, including. Petitioner. The portion of the Gravel Hill Road at issue is more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit C attached hereto.

IV.

On September 28, 1987, Petitioner filed suit against the Marshalls in the District Court of Sabine County, Texas, to prevent the obstruction of the road, in cause number 9623, styled "Harvey P. Boudreaux vs. Jesse Marshall, et ux". That case proceeded to trial before a jury on May 30, 1989, which resulted in entry of Judgment on June 9, 1989, declaring the roadway a public road, and enjoining the Marshalls from obstructing it. On June 30, 1992, the Twelfth District Court of Appeals in Tyler reversed the District Court's judgment for insufficient evidence, and remanded the case for a new trial in the District Court. On May 27, 1994, the District Court entered an order abating said lawsuit for a period not to exceed 60 days, and granting leave to petition this honorable Court to determine in an open hearing whether the roadway in question is a public or county road. A true copy of the District Court's order is attached as Exhibit D.

v.

Petitioner accordingly prays that the Commissioners Court of Sabine County exercise its authority under the County Road and Bridge Act, TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. Art. 6702-1, and order that the roadway in question is a public road, and that it be re-opened.

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Petitioner further prays that this Court call a special term setting a date for hearing on this petition, and issue the appropriate notice and citation to all interested parties, and further that the Court, following conference with counsel for the parties, enter appropriate orders for the conduct of the hearing, including allowance for the use of evidence from the District Court's records in this matter, and reasonable limitations on the time of the hearing and number of witnesses, if appropriate.

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




