Agenda item #4-Consider and Take Record Vote RE: Battlesfield Road as a Public Road There was an original petition filed by Willard Burl Ivy and Barbara Francis Ivy. An order setting a hearing date of October 17, 1994 at 9:30 A.M. was set by the Court. A list of the induviduals giving testimony can be found in the minutes of the Court for October 17, 1994.

Proper notice was given to all land owners and adjacent land owners.

After testimony was given on the October 17th meeting, the Court advised the petitioner and the other people present that the matter would be taken into consideration and would render a decision at a later date. At this time that appropreiate action will be taken.

Judge Hyden informed the Court of two letters he has received. One is from Mr. Ed Hamilton and one is from John Sutton. Both are adjacent land owners. Both letters are to be made a part of the minutes. Also a copy of the petition, a copy of the order, a copy of the public notice and 2 copies of aerial photos. See attached exhibits.

Commissioner Clark made a motion for this road, known as the Battlesfield road, be a public

road up to the back side of the old Battles place. Commissioner White seconded. Judge Hyden amended the motion as follows: road which proceeds from Hwy. 3121 near the Dick Hogen place and commonly known as the Battlesfield road be affirmed to be a public road and extending in a westerly, then northerly, then westerly direction to the point that it joins the same road currently maintained by the County which proceeds or continues in a southwesterly direction to Hwy. 87 with the exact distance of same to be determined by the appropreiate Commissioner and entered as a matter of record at the next regular Court meeting or as soon therafter as practiable. Commissioner Cox seconded the motion as amended. All woted for: Motion carried. Judge Hyden made the motion to amend the amendment by adding the words: this road be considered as a class C road. Commissioner Clark seconded the amendment to the amendment. All voted for. Motion carried. All voted for the amendment as amended.

All voted For the motion as Amended. Motion carried. The road shall be deemed a public road in the manner as so desbribed. All voted for. Decision of the Court is unaminous. It is therfore ordered by this Court, that the Battlesfield road is a public road and has been classified as a class "C" road within this County.

Commissioner Smith made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Clark seconded.


