Judge Hyden made the motion to reschedule the December 26th regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court to Thursday, December 22 at 8:30 A.M.. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item 2-RFP 911 - Final Action

Mr. Bob Russell, chairman of the 911 Advisory Committee, met with the Court to submit a letter from the 911 Advisory Committee with a recommendation for the mapping and rural addressing of Sabine County for 911. Only one RFP was received. It was submitted by Address Information Management Services of Austin, Tx.. It is the recommendation of the 911 Advisory Committee that the County pursue and enter into a contract for services of Address Information Management Services.

Judge Hyden made a motion that the report be received from the advisory committee and that the County enter into said contract. Commissioner Cox seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

The estimated total project cost as given to the 911 Advisory Committee was \$64,975.63. There are adjustments being made so this is not going to be a true figure. Between 47 and 48 thousand should be somewhere around the total project cost.

Commissioner Smith made the motion to appoint Commissioner Clark to sign any and all contracts relating to this project. Commissioner Cox seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #1

Minutes of the November 28, 1994 regular Court meeting were approved as read.

Judge Hyden made the motion that the report from JP #2 Pl. 1 be accepted and approved.

Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Judge Hyden advised the Court that the audit for the fiscal year 1993-94 is in progress. Commissioner Smith is the representative for the Court.

The report for the U.S. Forest Service check, monies that are dedicated to R&B, approximately 75% of the estimated total payment divided among R&B is \$205,041.00 for the year. This is going to be about \$51,000.00 short of what was budgeted for the year.

Agenda item #13-Courthouse - ISTEA - Grant, Goodwin-Lasiter, Inc. Approval Engineering/ Architectural Contract

Judge Hyden made a motion to drop agenda item #13. Commissioner Ellison seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #5-Connie felts-Stray Dogs

Mrs Felts ask the Court if a lease law could be implimented in the Lowe's Creek area. There is a problem with stray dogs. The Judge told Mrs. Felts that the Court has the authority by which to impose a leash law and it would have to be for the entire County. But the cost of doing this is more than the County has funds to do. At this point, Judge Hyden made a motion that a lease law be implimated by the Court. Commissioner Clark seconded. There were no votes in favor of. All members voted against. Motion failed. Mrs. Felts also ask about 4-Wheelers that are being ridden on the roads in the neighborhood. These are mostly children that are not living here permanently.

The Court told Mrs. Felts that it is illegal to ride a 4-wheeler on a County road unless

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the 4-wheeler is duly licensed for a highway. Signs would probably not stop the people from riding on the roads. If the sheriff's department could catch them and issue a ticket or two, that might help. If they are fiding on private property, then it is up to the landowner to file a complaint.

Agenda item #7- TNRCC-County Rep.

Commissioner Cox informed the Court that there are only 2 people working for this entire district, approximately 30 counties, to police, inspect, register and do perk test for septic systems. This is a problem for people installing septic systems. The County can appoint someone to do this and have the same authority that the people from TNRCC has. Judge Hyden made a motion that this discussion on this item be tabled and placed on the December 22 agenda. Commissioner Ellison seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #8-Move Storage Tanks

Commissioner Cox informed the Court that he has 3 storage tanks in his pct. for recycled oil. Two has to be moved. There has to be a 2 week notice given to Austin where they are registered before they can be moved.

Judge Hyden made a motion that Commissioner Cox be allowed to proceed with moving the tanks. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

At this time, Judge Hyden informed the Court that all correspondence he has gotten back on the pits has been positive and he wants to commend the Commissioners.

Court recessed at 9:50 A.M.

Court reconvened at 10:05 A.M.

Agenda item #6- Consider Accepting Thamar Dickerson Road as County Road Commissioner Smith told the Court that he is in agreement to take this road as a County road with 2 stipulations: 1-contingent upon working out the agreement with the Forest Service and 2-some culverts will be required and the property owners are to bare the cost of the culverts. This road is located south of Six Mile Creek, east of Highway 87. It turns to the North of of what is known as the Shawnee Shores road right at the entrance of Shawnee Shores Subdivision by the mailboxes. It goes approximately one/half mile into several tracts of land. This road is on Forest Service land and is under permit to the individuals, property owners, for many years. The County will have a special permit use and will not hold title to the road.

Commissioner Smith made a motion to accept this road as a County road with these 2 stipulations 1-contingent upon working out the agreement with the Forest Service and 2-some culverts will be required and the property owners are to bare the cost of the culverts. Commissioner Clark seconded. Judge Hyden made a motion to amend the motion by adding the following words: the County accepts responsibility for the maintenance of this road realizing that the property is woned by the U.S. Forest Service and will be so maintained under a special use permit which has existed for a number of years and with the understanding that there shall be no conveyance to he County nor acceptance by the County of the property and therefore it should not be considered as a County road or as a public road, but operated under the special use permit by the U.S. Forest Service. Commissioner Smith seconded. Commissioner Smith withdrew his motion. Commissioner Clark withdrew his second. Judge Hyden withdrew his amendment. Commissioner Smith withdrew his second to the amendment. Commissioner Smith made the motion to accept this road in question known by the Forest Service as 5051-01 Yellowpine road and also known as the Thamar Dickerson road, as a public road and agree for County maintenance of this road extending about one/half mile to the north from what is known as the Shawnee Shore road. This road lies adjacent to the west line of the Shawnee Shores Subdivision and is 40 feet in width. Judge Hyden seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

Agenda item #11-Margie Williams

Mrs. Williams declined her appearance before the Court at this time.

Agenda item #12-Old Hwy. 96-Brookeland-Corp of Engineers-Appropreiate Action Judge Hyden received a letter dated November 28, 1994, signed by Aubrey J. Drey, Çor

Judge Hyden made a motion that the letter be accepted and recognized and the Court moves that there be no further action until such time as the Court has something legal upon which to act which can only be granted by the Corp of Engineers in the relinguishing of that property for further consideration. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. Commissioner Ellison made a motin that the Court reject the Corp of Engineers recommendation that the County request and receive a maintenance easement on that portion of old 96 above the closure and the spur road off of old 96 providing access to Brookeland Cementary. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. Commissioner Smith amended the motion by adding: also request that the Corp of Engineers upgrade and maintain this road that is now old 96. Commissioner Ellison seconded. All voted for the amendment. All voted for the motion as amended. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

Court recessed at 10:25 A.M. to move to the District Courtroom for agenda item #3-Holiday Forest Boat Stalls

Court reconvened in the District Courtroom at 10:35 A.M.

Agenda item #3-Holiday Forest Boat Stalls

Judge Hyden swore in the following people that may be giving testimony: Jack Hays, Keith Brandon, Danny Aaron, Carol Arron and David Clark. Public participation forms are completed for each one.

Commissioner Smith gave a brief statement on the location of the property in question. It is in the Six Mile Creek agea where the Holiday Forest Subdivision is located off of highway 87 approximately 11 miles south of Hemphill. Also that he feels that it is a dangerous situation. The boat stalls, Mr. Hays built very close to the public road are obstructing the view on the road. The road within the Subdivision is a County road.

Mr. Jack Hays age his opening statement. Mr. Richard Tillery built the boat stalls for Mr. Hays but there was no signed contract. Mr. Hays told the Court that he was given legal advise verbally that if he did not het within 5 or 6 feet fo the road, that the road was not tied down by metes and bounds, that everything would be okay. Based upon the requirements of the General Information section of the RFP, the proposed vendor has met or exceeded the minimum criteria established for evaluation purposes.

In reviewing the Proposal the Advisory Board had questions and concerns regarding the usability of information previously gathered as a result of the ongoing E911 addressing effort, the need for aerial photography when actual structure verification would be conducted from the ground, and additional training requirements to provide for ongoing maintenance of the database. These issues have been discussed and responded to by the proposed vendor.

Based upon the written representations contained in the Proposal and the written response to issues received from the proposed vendor, it is the recommendation of this Advisory Board that the County pursue and enter into a contract for the services of Address Information Management Services to fulfill the requirements of an expandable addressing system for Sabine County and facilitate implementation of the Enhanced 911 system for its citizens.

I am sending you a copy of the current i/E program and document sheet. It will go out in today's mail.

Responses:

 I feel that the aerial photography is very important. The photos are presently the best means of correcting the location many of the features included in the current base maps. Also, they will be used to spot houses that are behind lock gates and/or might be otherwise unseen from the assessable public roads.

There may be an alternate/less expensive source or method that can be used if/when we enter into a contract.

- 2) Yes. The training is included in the Administrative Cost. I estimated and included 30 hours for basic and advanced training of not only the Atlas*GIS software, but also the methods and concepts behind address assignment.
- The information that the County has captured is definitely usable. In my proposal I took this into account as best as possible. Basically your cost of capture per address is \$1.50 less than other current contracts/proposals. That would translate into a consideration of about \$8200 or 15% of the \$55,000 services part of the contract. Also I have a concern is that some of that information is slightly dated and will require review etc. prior to transferring Into the new scheme of things.

AIMS will agree to process locations in excess of 6030 (10% of base 5481) at the rate of \$ 4.15. This is approximately a 50% discount on the original proposal rate of \$ 8.33. It should be noted that these addresses must be captured in the original pass or the correction/verification phase of the project and not a some future date after an area has been completed. This will require the County to decide what location types need to be captured in addition to residences and businesses at the beginning of the project. In other words, answer the question: Does the County want to capture other locations such as agricultural barns, sheds, workshops etc.

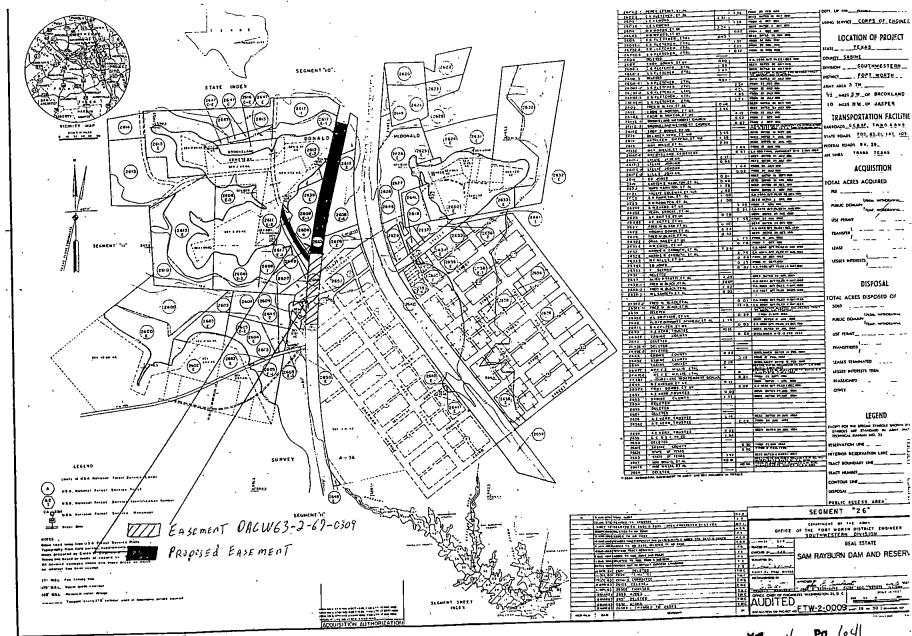

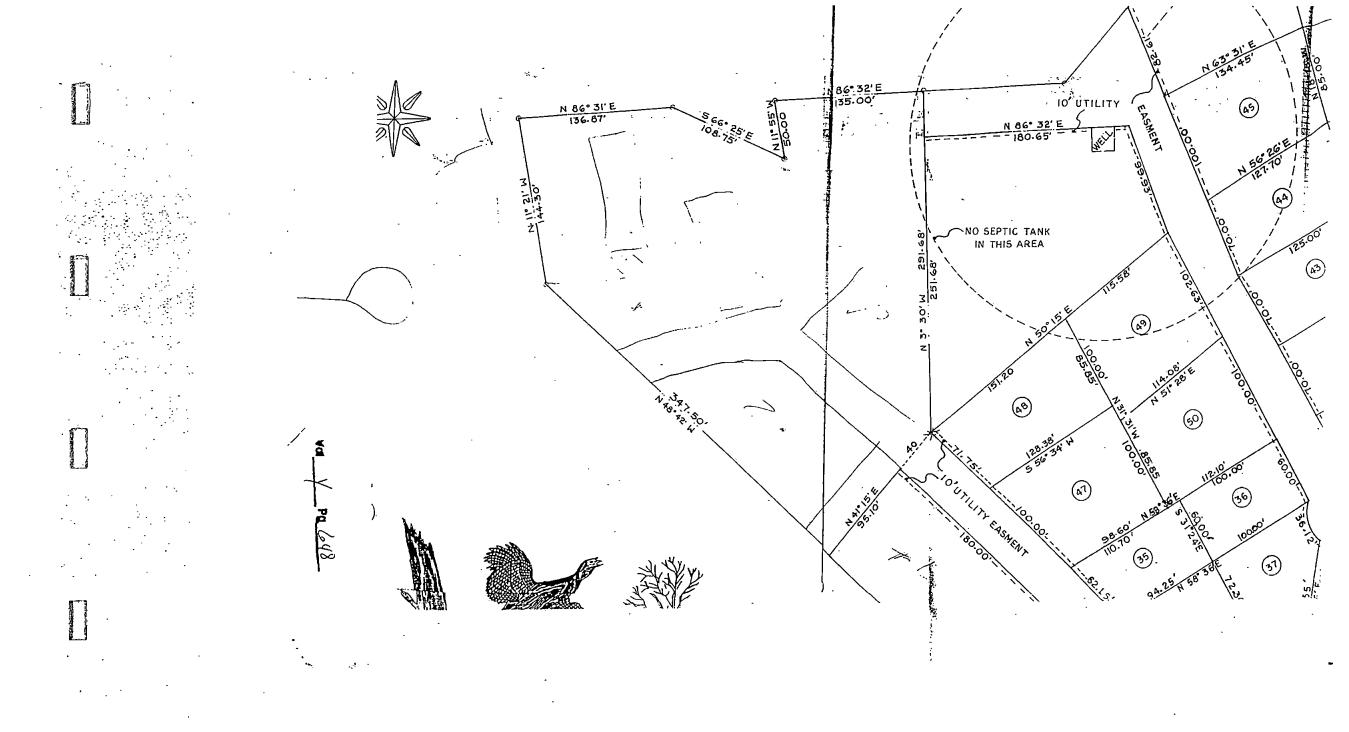

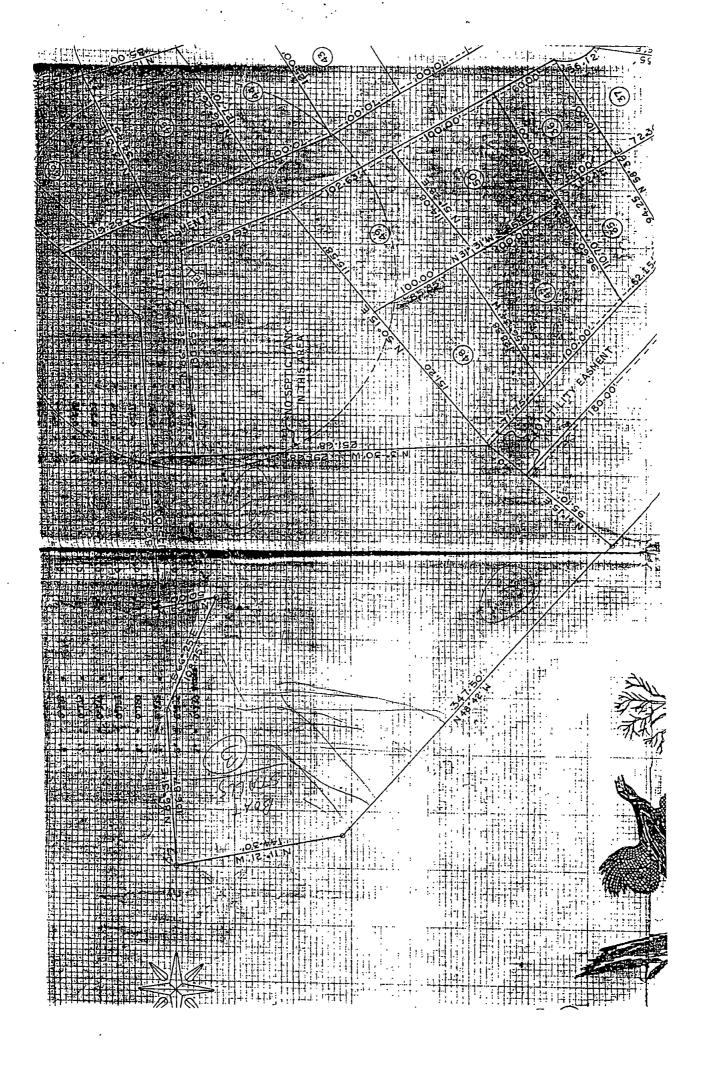

CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

FOR BRIDGE REPLACEMENT OR REHABILITATION

OFF THE STATE SYSTEM

THIS AGREEMENT, made on the date shown hereinafter, by and between the Texas Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the "Department", and Sabine County, a local government, or governmental agency or entity, hereinafter called the "Governmental Agency" acting by and through its Commissioners Court and by virtue of the authority shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Governmental Agency is owner of a bridge located on a public road or street within its jurisdiction at Boregas Creek on CR 221: and

WHEREAS, under Title 23. United States Code as amended by the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 and subsequent Federal legislation, a program entitled 1993-1995 Off-State System Federal-Aid Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program has been approved by the Texas Transportation Commission and said bridge is included in this program; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the Department to assure accomplishment of this work.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE. in consideration of the premises and of mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto to be by them respectively kept and performed, as hereinafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

- 1. The Governmental Agency hereby authorizes the Department or its contracted consultant and Department's contractor to enter on the site of said bridge and adjacent right of way or relocation right of way to perform surveys, inspection, construction and other purposes necessary to replace or rehabilitate said bridge and approaches.
- 2. The Governmental Agency agrees to provide, at its expense, the necessary adjustment of any and all utilities and services, whether publicly or privately

owned, as may be necessary to permit the work authorized herein. Existing utilities will be adjusted in respect to location and type of installation in accordance with requirements of the Department.

3. The Governmental Agency agrees to provide 20% of the actual construction cost of the bridge replacement or rehabilitation project including preliminary engineering and construction engineering, or that portion of the cost of the project not reimbursable by the Federal Highway Administration. This amount also includes compensation to the State for work performed under this agreement based upon direct labor, equipment, material and other direct expenditures; and indirect costs at the rates in effect for the fiscal years during which the work is accomplished. The indirect cost rate will be based on the Texas Department of Transportation's Indirect Cost Plan. The Governmental Agency further agrees to acquire, at no cost to the Department, any additional right of way, if required.

Within 30 days following execution of this agreement the Governmental Agency agrees to pay to the Department by check made payable to the Texas Department of Transportation an amount equal to 20% of the estimated cost of the preliminary engineering for the project plus the estimated indirect costs to the Department for performance of that service. Forty-five days prior to the Department's scheduled date for the contract letting, the Governmental Agency agrees to pay to the Department an amount equal to the remainder of the Governmental Agency's obligatory 20% participation in the project including indirect costs on that remaining participation. If, at any time during plan development or construction of the project, it is found that the amount received is insufficient to pay the Governmental Agency's obligation, then the Department shall immediately notify the Governmental Agency which shall promptly transmit the required amount to the Department. After the project is completed, the actual cost will be determined by the Department, based on its standard accounting procedures, and any excess funds paid by the Governmental Agency shall be returned to the Governmental Agency.

- 4. If, after execution of the agreement, the Governmental Agency elects to terminate the project, the Governmental Agency shall be responsible for those eligible expenses incurred by the State which are attributable to the project.
- 5. As part of preliminary and construction engineering, the Department will prepare or provide for the construction plans, advertise for bids and let the construction contract, or otherwise provide for the construction and will supervise the construction or reconstruction as required by the plans. It is mutually agreed that as the project is developed to the construction stage, both parties shall approve the plans by signature approval thereon, and a copy of such plans will be attached hereto, marked "Exhibit B", and made a part hereof.
- 6. In the event the terms of this agreement are in conflict with the provisions of any other existing agreements and/or contracts between the Governmental Agency and the Department, this agreement shall take precedence over the other agreements and/or contracts.

- 7. Upon completion of the project, the Governmental Agency agrees to accept ownership and operate and maintain the facility authorized by this agreement for the benefit of the public without charge.
- 8. The Governmental Agency acknowledges that while not an agent, servant, or employee of the State, it is responsible for its own acts and deeds and for those of its agents or employees during the performance of the work authorized in this contract.
