Commissioner Lynn Smith served as Judge Pro-Tem for the court in the absence of County Judge John Larry Hyden.


Commissioner Lynn Smith asked to be filled in on anything that might have happened after he left Mondays meeting.


Discussions started on each of the Insurance Companies with each agent having a chance to speak.


Commissioner Clark made a motion to except the bid on Texas Association of Counties Insurance. Commissioner Will Smith Sr. seconded the motion. All voted for.


