May 15, 1995, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in a special called meeting. The following members were present:

Judge Hyden called the meeting to order at 8:32 A.M.

Commissioner Will Smith led the Court in prayer.

Agenda item #1-Solicit Bids Rock Handling Equipment

commissioner Lynn Smith told the Court that a Rock Separator has been rented for one month for the pit.

When this agenda was set, Commissioner Lynn Smith did not realize that the Court had enough time to wait until the next regular Court meeting, May 22nd for the specifications to go out for bids on the separator and stacker. He feels like a decision needs to be made on the loader as soon as possible.

Commissioner Lynn Smith moved to solicit bids for a rubber tired front end loader. Bids shall be accepted until 9:00 A.M. June 12, 1995 and opened during the regular session of the Commissioners' Court. Commissioner Will Smith seconded. In discussion, Commissioner Clark stated that he is not in favor of purchasing another loader.

Commissioner Lynn Smith stated that they are having a difficult time keeping the old equipment repaired and if usable equipment is not purchased, then in essence, they are shutting down the rock pit.

Commissioners Will Smith and Lynn Smith and Judge Hyden voted for. Commissioners Clark and Ellison voted against. Motion carried.

Commissioner Clark wants the minutes to reflect that not all the Commissioners are in favor of renting the equipment. He stated that he still feels like they can purchase the rock as cheap or cheaper than they can manufacture it.

Court recessed at 8:55 A.M.

Court reconvened at 9:00 A.M.

Commissioner Will Smith stated that he is voting on soliciting the equipment because he beleives in it to work and that he is not influenced by anyone elses vote.

Judge Hyden told the Court that the average cost of rock per yard is \$6.29 from the Countys rock pit. The price from induvidual contractors is from \$5.75 to \$6.00 per yard. This is not taking into consideration the assets of the inventory such as the oversize rock that is stock piled at the pit. It also needs to be considered that they have gone through the winter months and you can to compare the winter months with the summer months. Approximately 45% of the total anticipated volume expected to be hauled has been hauled in the first 7 months of the year.

Judge Hyden also stated that the R&B is going to have less money to do the same with in the next budget year. You should remain in control of your own destiny as much as you can and don't be dependent upon on someone else or left at the will of someone else to set prices. As long as the County can produce it at a cost equal to or less than what it can be bought somewhere else, then that is what the County needs to do.
