Monday, January 27, 1997, the Sabine County Commissioners
Court met in regular session. The following members were present:

Judge Leath called the meeting to order and Bro. Howell led the Court in prayer.

Agenda item #1-General Business

Commissioner Clark moved to approve the minutes as written for the January 21st. regular Court meeting. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #2-Reports

Commissioner Lynn Smith moved to approve the reports from the Tax Assessor and the County Treasurer. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copies.

Agenda item #3-George Hanks

Mr. Hanks told the Court that he doesn't have much to say except that they have the letter of the law that says that they will open a road somewhere another. He said that it did not make a difference to him which way they went just so he can get in to his place. Mr. Hanks said that he was going to check the mileage from his place to FM #1 on January 12th and the lock had been changed again. This makes the third time in less than a year that he has been denied entrance to his place. State law says that Commissioners' Court will open a road and he understands that they have a year to do it.

Judge Leath said that the Court will get the State Transportation code and that it has been ordered. After it is received, the County Attorney will have to be consulted. There will have to be research done on the different aspects of the law and what the responsibility of the County is. This is a new law and we are not that well acquainted with it. He said that he would invite any other person here that has an interest in this to address the Court.

Doyle Tatom ask if that when this comes before the Court again, will the other land owners involved be notified? Will they be properly notified by letter?

Judge Leath told Mr. Tatom that the answer is yes.

Doyle Tatom ask if Commissioners' Court has the right of imminent domain across private property. A man buys land locked property, knowing that it is land locked at the time he buys it.



Mr. Hanks said that according to his deed the land was not land locked.

Mr. Doyle Tatom said that he does not know what Mr. Hanks deed says, but it was general knowledge that the land was land locked.

Sheriff Philips said that Mr. Hanks listed people that he wants to be able to cross the Temple property to get to his property. Temple has a hunting lease on this property. According to a report that one of his deputies made, some people were caught hunting on the Temple hunting lease. This included Mr. Hanks according to the report. The Game Wardens were involved in this also. That is the reason for the combination being changed on the gate. Temple wants to corporate with Mr. Hanks and allow him to use their road to get to his property. However, they do not want him or any of the people on his list to be hunting on the Temple land. Mr. Hanks is going to have to corporate too.

Mr. Doyle Tatom ask if he can have a copy of this law when it is received by the Court and that he will have someone to interpret it for him. He gave his address and phone number to the Court. It is as follows: Doyle L. Tatom, 1211 West Harp, Pasadena, Tx. 77506. Phone number 713-473-0632. Mr. Tatom said that when this comes before the Court, if it effects his property and a binding decision is going to be made, he wants to be represented by an Attorney and to have him here.

Mr. Eugene Tatom said that this may effect his property and ask for the same consideration. He would like a copy of the law and to be notified of any meeting concerning this land. His address is P. O. Box 823, Hemphill, Tx. 75948, phone number is 586-4030

Mr. Doyle Tatom requested the same consideration for his sister, Delores Wilson, whose address is Rt. 2 Box 24, Bronson, Tx. 75930. He said that if it effected his property, then it will effect hers.

Commissioner Lynn Smith ask Mr. Hanks what law he is referring to when he said that the Court is obligated to take care of this.

Mr. Hanks said that it is the one that he gave the Judge.

Judge Leath said it is the one about the Neighborhood Road.

Commissioner Lynn Smith ask Mr. Hanks if anything had come about on trading land between Temple and Mr. Hanks.

Mr. Hanks said that Temple wanted to trade him fifty acres to his one hundred and five acres.

Commissioner Dickerson ask Eugene Tatom how long the Smith road has been closed.

Eugene Tatom said that it has been closed since 1949.

Judge Leath said that Commissioners' Court wants people to have access to their land, but does not want to have to take somebody else land to give them access. This is something that the Court is going to have to research this and will do what they have to do. We are not prepared to act on this today.

Agenda item #4-911 - Resolutions -- (G-M Water, City of Hemphill, City of Pineland)

Judge Leath said that these resolutions say that they are going to furnish 911 with a list of their customers and that these list will be used for that purpose only.

Judge Leath moved to adopt these resolutions. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copies of resolutions.

Under general business, Judge Leath presented a resolution proclaiming February 3rd through February 7th Farm Bureau Membership week.

Judge Leath moved to adopt this resolution. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copy of resolution.

Agenda item@#6-Discuss Buying Vehicles for Precincts

Commissioner Will Smith said that he thinks it would be too expensive for the County to buy vehicles for the four Commissioners, but that the expense that is charged on the personal vehicles needs to be narrowed down. He said that the four hundred dollars for expense needs to be increased to seven hundred dollars and not charge anything to the County for the personal vehicles.

Commissioner Clark said that he thinks it needs to be left like it is, but set a limit on expense that is charged to the County per month.

Commissioner Dickerson said that he is in favor of leaving it like it is and have an agreement on what can be charged or limit what is charged.

Commissioner Lynn Smith said that he does not know what the best solution is. He agrees that they need to get a control on it. The best time to make a change will be during budget workshops to be carried out at the beginning of the next budget year.

Judge Leath agreed that this is something that needs to be done during the budget workshops. It is unclear about the expense charged to the County and they need to get a handle on this.

Commissioner Will Smith said that the Judge from Newton County is going to leave it to each Commissioner to decide whether they wanted the County to buy a car for their particular precinct or if they wanted to buy their own. He said that here he is told that he cannot do that.

Judge Leath said that he knows the Court wants the same thing that he wants, for the Commissioners and the County to be treated fairly. No changes can be made now. This will be discussed in the budget workshops.

Agenda item #8-Nomination for Historical Committee

Judge Leath moved to appoint the same members that are presently serving to the Historical Committee. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Court recessed at 9:25 a.m.

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Court reconvened at 9:40 a.m.

Agenda item #7-Executive Session and Agenda item #5-Sheriff - Personnel

The Court recessed into executive session at this time.

Court came back into regular session.

No action was taken on the executive session.

Agenda item #9-Pay Accounts and Salaries

Commissioner Clark moved to pay the accounts and salaries.

Commissioner Will Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Commissioner Will Smith moved to adjourn. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. Meeting adjourned.

Agenda item #1-AIS Vote Counting Machine

In discussion, the County Clerk told the Court that she would pay two thousand dollars out of her budget as a down payment on the machine. And, she would pay one thousand on the yearly payment.

Commissioner Dickerson said that he is flexible on the subject.

Commissioner Clark said that he has not changed his opinion. He understands that the Clerk needs it and wants it, but that we need to pay for what we have before we go back into debt for more.

Commissioner Lynn Smith said that he is flexible also. He agrees with both sides, and since the Judge is the chief financial officer, he is going to look mainly at his opinion.

Commissioner Will Smith is for purchasing a machine.

Judge Leath said that he would rather delay purchasing a machine until a full election year.

The Clerk stated that it would be very hard to have a big election and at the same time have to train on the vote counting machine. It is recommended by other Clerks that have a vote counting machine, to start with an amendment election. The company that the Clerk has been in contact with recommends starting with an amendment election.

Judge Leath asked the Clerk what she thinks would be the savings or cost compared to the cost of what a recently held election would be.

The Clerk said that considering the yearly payments at around five thousand dollars, that the extra cost may be only around one thousand dollars. This is an approximate figure.

Judge Leath said that if the cost is only going to be one thousand dollars, thereabouts, and will increase our speed and accuracy, he thinks we should do this.

Commissioner Lynn Smith moved to advertise for bids for the purchase of a "Centralized Optical Scan Ballot Tabulation System". Commissioner Will Smith seconded. Commissioners Will Smith and Lynn Smith voted for. Commissioners Clark and Dickerson voted against. Judge Leath broke the tie with a vote for. Motion
