




Judge Leath told the Court that it needs to be decided whether the County will be the applicant or present the proposal for the Youth Council Facility to the State as opposed to the Economic Renewal Committee. It would be better for the County to do it because of getting grants.

Gary Ulman said that after the public hearing last night, we should put the biggest horse power, being the County, behind it. This would prove unity as a whole.


Judge Leath said that the County may eventually have to expend a few dollars on maybe some road work. After the meeting last night and after conversations today, he feels we are going to be all right money wise. We have a letter on file from the City of Pineland committing to the sewage and water. We will have a letter on file shortly from Temple-Inland to commit to sell the land.
