Monday, April 13, 1998, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in regular session. The following members were present:

Judge Leath called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and Bro. Clarence Howell led the Court in prayer.

Agenda item #1-General Business

Commissioner Clark moved to approve the minutes as written for the March 19 and March 30 Special meetings and the March 23 regular session of Court. Commissioner Lynn Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #2-Consider Closing Part of Winsboro Road, Pct. #4 Next Agenda.

Agenda item #4-Take Action on Surplus Equipment, Pct. #2 No bids were received.

Agenda item #5-Take Action on Trauma Funds

Judge Leath said that he thinks this is the fee collected on the 911 portions of our telephone bills. He said that our portion is \$1,810.00. The only agency certified to receive this money is the Ambulance service. He said that the contract for this is about 25 pages long and very complicated. Judge Leath said that he would like permission to sign the contract after he can find out how the money would pass from the County to the AMS. He said that he will bring this back before the Court at the next meeting.

Commissioner Lynn Smith said that he has a problem with not being able to use the money for 911 and the County is going to have to supplement the 911 projects.

Judge Leath said that this was a legislative thing and there is not anything we can do about it.

Agenda item #6-Take Action on Texas Department of Transportation Request for Radio Tower Use

TXDOT is requesting permission to place a communication antenna on the existing radio tower. They will bare all cost on installation.

Commissioner Clark said that it is the tower behind the Sheriff's department.

Commissioner Lynn Smith moved to give Court approval for TXDOT to place an antenna on the radio tower located behind the jail. Commissioner Will Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copy.

Agenda item #7-Take Action on Resolution for Environmental Protection Agency's Storm Water Regulation.

Judge Leath said that the EPA has evidently come up with a new proposal to regulate storm water and the Texas Association of Counties is against this. They are asking us to pass a Resolution against this.

Judge Leath moved to adopt the Resolution opposing this. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copy of Resolution.

Agenda item #8-Take Action on Model Subdivision Rules / Texas Water Development Board.

Judge Leath said that it looks like the Texas Water Development Board is looking for any reason it can to not fund any water and sewer systems in the economically distressed program areas unless you comply with a lot of rules. This one has to do with the Model Subdivision Rules adopted by the State.

Judge Leath said that we approve subdivisions on a fairly regular basis. Under the Model Subdivision Rules, prior to the approval by the County of the final plat, the developer is required to construct a water and sewer connections or provide a financial guarantee to insure constructions of these facilities. This is for subdivisions created after 1989.

No action taken.

Agenda item #9-Request Survey Study from TXDOT on Hwy. 96 Intersection.

Judge Leath said that after the accident weekend before last that killed two people and kept the highway shut down for nine hours because of a truck carrying hazardous material being involved in the accident, he went to San Augustine and talked with Clark Slacum, TXDOT, about a study being done to install a red light at this intersection. Mr. Slacum said that the County would need to make a request in writing to TXDOT.

Commissioner Will Smith asked that the intersection of FM 3121 and highway 21 be added to this request.

Commissioner Dickerson moved to request the survey be done by TXDOT. Commissioner Will Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copy.

Agenda item #10-Reports

Commissioner Clark moved to approve the reports from JP #2, Veterans Service Office, and Charlotte Gorman, County Agent. Commissioner Lynn Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #3-Forest Service -- Larry Potts

Judge Leath said that he has received information in the form of a letter that said that there are several proposals as far as payment in lieu of taxes paid to the Counties where National Forest or grasslands are concerned. The Forest Service recommends a proposal that said the Counties would be reimbursed based on the 1997 sale of timber.

Mr. Potts said this is to stabilize the payments to the Counties based on the revenue sharing with the Counties from the

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1908 law that says 25 percent of all revenues generated from National Forest lands are shared with the Counties. The proposal is to take the higher of two figures. One figure is 76 percent of the 1986 to 1995 year average that as he figured was \$322,947.00. The other is the 1997 payment to Sabine County that was \$381,191.00. The reason is so the Counties can know what they will be receiving in revenue.

Judge Leath said that this is just a legislative proposal.

Mr. Potts said the only thing this will affect will be the revenues coming from the 25 percent law. It will not affect royalties from mineral leases, oil and gas and that kind of things. That comes under a different law.

Judge Leath said that no action needs to be taken at this time except to encourage our legislators to vote for or against this.

Agenda item #11-Pay Accounts and Salaries

Commissioner Lynn Smith moved to pay accounts and salaries with the understanding that the bills from the Sheriff's department for the gun and boots be reimbursed to the general fund. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Commissioner Will Smith moved to adjourn. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. Meeting adjourned.

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has proposed Phase II Stormwater Discharge Regulations and the proposed regulations have been published in the Federal Register, and

WHEREAS, the public comment period will last until April 9, 1998, and

WHEREAS, the proposed regulations, if promulgated in current form, will have enormous economic consequences for many counties and require local governments to conduct the proposed regulatory program, and

WHEREAS, under the proposed regulations certain counties would be required to adopt ordinances and regulatory programs to prevent "illicit discharges" into the storm sewer system, and

WHEREAS, under the proposed regulations certain counties would be required to adopt ordinances to regulate stormwater discharges from construction sites on one acre or more, and

WHEREAS, public education and involvement in the process is mandated without the provision of additional funds to pay for this new federal mandate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the present intention of the <u>Sahine</u> County Commissioners Court to oppose the adoption and implementation of the EPA's Phase II Stormwater Discharge Regulations as proposed.
