He had his own money and he took care of his constituents. Commissioner W. Smith said he got directly chewed out and he does not think that was proper. He said he is an elected official and has the same voice that anyone on this Court has and he wants to be respected for that, one man, one vote. If anyone has a disagreement with what is on the agenda, then they have a right to vote against it. personal opinions, he cannot live with that. There are some things that are not proper for them, as Commissioners, to be saying in the If someone is really concerned about what he is doing, they should come to him personally and voice their concern. He said they are going to have to learn how to deal with each other on this Court. They have been doing good so far, but they are just going to have to learn how to treat each other. He said that he is for a purchase order system. He does not have anything to hide. It was said that we went through this last year. He said that there were line item transfers, but he could not find it anywhere that the budget was amended. Commissioner Will Smith said he just wants the minutes to reflect that some things said at the last Court date were just not up to par.

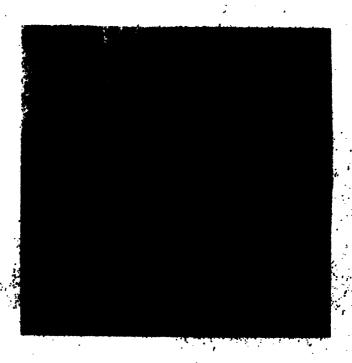

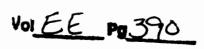
