Monday, October 26, 1998, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in regular session. The following members were present:

Judge Leath called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.and Bro. Clarence Howell led the Court in prayer.

Agenda item #1-General Business

Commissioner Clark moved to approve the minutes as written for the October 12 regular and October 14 emergency sessions of Court. Commissioner Will Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. PUBLIC HEARING ON "STERLE ROAD"

Commissioner Will Smith said we are discussing the Herman King/Maxey road, now known as "Sterle Road". In the Commissioner Court minutes for August 13, 1973, the Court voted for the road to go to the boundary line between R. J. Maxey and Herman King property. That is where we are stuck. Commissioner Will Smith said that he sent a surveyor out to find the boundary. It is not where the gate is hung and we are waiting for the surveyor to bring us something in writing.

Judge Leath read the section of the minutes from 8-13-73 concerning the road in question. He said that according to the surveyor that Commissioner Will Smith employed, the boundary between R. J. Maxey and Herman King's property is considerably passed where the present gate is. Judge Leath said we are going to let everyone who filled out a public participation form get their chance to speak.

Philip Sterle said he has been looking into this ever since the gate was put up. He was told years ago that the road continued past Palo Gaucho. He said that he doesn't know that he can add anything more than what the minutes from 1973 states.

Mary King said Michael put the gate up at the same location where it was approximately 45 years ago. The same post and hardware is still there. The gate has been there for 45 years except a short time when Billy Barlow was leasing our pasture. It was moved for a short period of time to the pasture. That same post was the corner boundary of R. J. Maxey's pasture. She believes that was the boundary referred to in the minutes. She said that Uncle R. J. asked for County maintenance to have maintenance to his home. Her cousin Patty told her that usually the maintenance came to their driveway because there was a turn around place. Mrs. King said it is her conviction that the minutes



from 1973 are just a technicality of wording. Where the fence post is located, where the gate is now, is where R. J. was asking for the County maintenance. Mrs. King said that she and her cousin Patty Longron, R. J. Maxey's daughter, are the only property owners past the gate. Both do not want the road opened. The road has been abandoned for 25 years. Mrs. King said the house is in need of repairs and if someone went on her property and got hurt, she may be held liable. She said that they just recently had 32 loads of rock put on the road at their own expense.

Mrs. King said that when Billy Barlow was leasing the pasture land, he requested County maintenance past where the gate is located now. He was told by Chester Cox that the road on past where the gate was located was not a County road.

Judge Leath read a letter from Patricia Longron. She is against extending "County Road" past the gate.

Mr. Sterle said that he has property directly across from Ms. Longron. This is past where the gate is located. He said that Jimmy Vickers told him that he had maintained the road when he was the Commissioner of that precinct.

Mike Garrett said there is no dispute over the boundary. surveyor, Mark Birdwell, found the boundary. The gate has been there since his earliest memories except a short period of time in 1985 when his Mother and his little sister lived there. The school requested the County to blade the road so the school bus could get Right after that, they moved into town. down the road. Garrett said he came back to the states in 1990 and has requested maintenance on the road ever since he has been in this area. said Chester Cox, the Commissioner at that time, told him that the road was not a County road past the gate. It has been the same with Commissioner Will Smith. He said that he cannot dispute what is in writing, he can only agree with his Mother. Instead of saying the County road went up to the gate, it said to the boundary. He believes they meant to the gate in the minutes in 1973. By closing the gate, we are by no means blocking Mr. Sterle access to his property. The County road comes to the front of his property and to the gate in question.

Julie Van Winkle said that she agrees with her family, Mrs. King. The County has not maintained the road except the one time. She was riding the school bus at the one time it was bladed.

Mrs. King said she does not consider having a blade on the road one time as maintenance. Maintenance is over a period of time, on going.

King Davidson said that before the gate was put up, there was a wire gap. After the wire gap, there was a wooden gate and no later than 1960 a metal gate was put there. He said that he does not remember what year it was, but it is a sure thing with him that R. J. Maxey requested that the County not maintain the road anymore, he would do it himself. Mr. Maxey was only interested in

the road being bladed to his house and the turn around. Hickory Hill School was on the North side of the road now called "Davidson Road" that turns off highway 87.

Mr. Sterle said that he needs access to the back portion of his property in case he ever decides to sell it.

Mark Birdwell, surveyor, said the boundary line is located approximately 600 feet below where the gate is located. He presented a survey map done by Mr. Braswell in 1985. Mr. Braswell showed it as a County road.

Judge Leath said he doesn't think there is any disagreement that the County road runs to the boundary or where the boundary line is. The disagreement is what was meant by the boundary in the minutes in August 1973. He said that he cannot tell what they meant by the minutes for that meeting.

Commissioner Will Smith said that he cannot tell what was meant by the boundary. He hired a surveyor to find the boundary and is willing to go with the boundary the surveyor has stated.

Commissioner Dickerson said he does not have an opinion.

Commissioner Clark said all we have to go by is the minutes.

Commissioner Lynn Smith said that he is not familiar with that area, but no one disputes it being an old public road years ago. He said a public road is still a public road unless it has been abandoned by the Court or fenced denying public access for 20 years or more. He asked Mrs. King and her daughter what year they lived on the property.

They replied it was in late 1985.

Judge Leath said it does seem to be a dispute if it was ever a public road.

King Davidson said you would have to go back to the 1800's to find it as a public road.

Judge Leath said we need Mr. Vickers and Mr. Cox here to get first hand information to determine if the road was maintained or how long the gate was there and locked. He recommended that we table this item until we can get Mr. Vickers here in person or by deposition.

Commissioner Lynn Smith said that Mr. Vickers told him that he had maintained the road.

Commissioner Will Smith said that Mr. Vickers told him that he maintained the road up to the gate.

This item is tabled until the November 9, 1998 regular session of Court.

Agenda item #5-Accept Roads--Dogwood Forest Estates I

Commissioner Lynn Smith said that he has been asked by some residents of Dogwood Forest Estates I subdivision to accept the streets in the subdivision as public roads with County maintenance.

Mr. Garrison presented a petition to the Court to recognize the two roads within Dogwood Forest Estates I as public roads and to assume the maintenance of these roads. This would not include the boat ramp. The subdivision has 60 lots with 47 lot owners. All lot owners were contacted either in person or by mail. The ones contacted by mail were asked to send back a response. Thirty-three people responded. Fourteen people did not respond. No negative responses were received by mail or by person. One person said that he did not know if he supported it or not. This person was sent a copy of the petition and was asked to sign the petition in favor of or against and send it back. He did not mail back a response.

Commissioner Lynn Smith said that he and Mr. Garrison looked at the roads and agreed the subdivision would pay for the gravel to initially put on the roads to bring the roads up to a better standard.

Mr. Garrison said the officers of their association agreed with this and they have the money.

Commissioner Lynn Smith moved to accept these two roads in Dogwood Estates I as public roads with County maintenance after the roads are brought up to standard. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

Agenda item #3-Discuss Road Permits

Commissioner Dickerson asked to table this agenda item.

Agenda item #4-Debt Service Pct. #4 (\$11,079.00)

Commissioner Will Smith asked to move this agenda item to the next regular session of Court.

Agenda item #6-East Texas Regional Water Group Funding (Take Action)

Judge Leath said the County itself has no water systems, but it is incumbent upon us to see that the residents of the County are protected and made a part of this Regional Water Planning Process. That the needs of Sabine County are met before water is shipped out of here. To do that, we have to contribute \$1,554.00. Judge Leath said that he has not received a commitment from anyone else to help with the \$1.554.00, but he will keep trying. The money is due November 1, 1998, so we need to do this expenditure now.

Upon Judge Leath's recommendation, Commissioner Lynn Smith moved to approve this expenditure, but with the stipulation that the Judge will continue to seek help from any entity that he can. Commissioner Will Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

Agenda item #2-Reports

Commissioner Clark moved to accept the reports from the Tax Assessor, County Clerk, Treasurer and the quarterly report from the Treasurer's office. Commissioner Will Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING

Speed Limit Shawnee Shores

No one was present to voice an opinion for or against setting a speed limit of 15 MPH on the roads in Shawnee Shores subdivision.



Motion by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn; seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, and by unanimous vote, the Court declared the road which intersects Hwy. 87 about 5 miles north of Hemphill, in the Isaac Caradine Survey and which runs in an easterly direction in the B. D. Latham and M. D. White Surveys past the location of the Old Hickory Hill School and the residence of R. J. Maxey to the boundry line between R. J. Maxey and Herman King property, to be a County Road, and has been a County Road for many years.

Upon the recommendation of Sheriff Blan Greer and a metion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and all voting "AYE", Robert G. McDaniel was appointed Deputy Sheriff effective August 15, 1973, at a salary of \$323.00 per month, expenses of \$250.00 per month, and the usual benefits gigen other deputy sheriffs. It was agreed between Mayor C. C. Rice of the City of Hemphill and the Court that the salary and expenses and usual benefits would be shared equally between both the City of Hemphill and Sabine County.

W. N. Wood appeared before the Court concerning The Sam Rayburn Estates Subdivision and a sked assistance on adjusting delinquent taxes on the estates. No action was taken by the Court.

The Court canvassed the election returns of an election ordered by the Court for the City of Browson to elect a mayor and councilmen. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., the Court unanimously approved the election returns and ordered them filed in Volume 1, Record of Election Returns, Sabine County, Texas

Motion by Commissioner 6. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Wilburn, with all voting "AYE" the Court directed the County Treasurer to designate the Federal Revenue Sharing check in the amount of \$21, 189.00 as follows:

\$1,487.92 - for pay and allowance of Deputy Sheriff Robert G. McDaniel for 42 months.

\$2,009.50 - for pay and allowances of Deputy Pound Master T. A. Seales

for 5 months. \$17,691.58-divided equally between General Fund and the four commissioner precincts.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.

conclusion that County governments must play an important role in the Senate Bill 1 planning process.

The Group is <u>not</u> asking the Counties to contribute all of the cash contributions needed to fulfill the local funding requirement. The Group is asking the Counties to spearhead the effort in each county to identify the users from which the funding for each county will come. The individual county's decision on an appropriate county contribution may depend on the local conditions and the predominate use of water within the county. Attachment 1 illustrates the various water users within your county according to Texas Water Development Board data.
