Judge Leath called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and Bro. Clarence Howell led the Court in prayer.

Special visitors in Court today are the government classes from Brookeland ISD and West Sabine ISD and their teachers.

Agenda item #1-General Business

Commissioner Nethery moved to approve the minutes as written for the February 14<sup>th</sup> regular session of Court. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #3-Take Action on Draft of Up-date/On-site Sewage Facility
Order for Sabine County

Judge Leath said this is not ready for Court approval. Before final approval by the Court, he wants to be sure it is in compliance with the State.

Commissioner Nethery moved to table this item. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #4-Take Action on Proclamation for Poison Prevention Week Judge Leath said the University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston, on behalf of the Southeast Texas Poison Center, is requesting we proclaim the week of March 19-25, 2000 as "Poison Prevention Week" in Sabine County. He read the proclamation. (See attached copy)

Commissioner Clark moved to adopt this proclamation. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #5-Take Action on County's Automobile Liability Coverage Commissioner Nethery moved to table this item. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.



Agenda item #6-Discuss & Possible Take Action on Transfer of Anticipation Note Fund

Judge Leath said we are paying about \$75,000.00 a year on the anticipation note. There is about \$24,000.00 left in the fund. He wants to reimburse the anticipation fund the money that was used to install the new elevator with the door opening into the room on the third floor from the Courthouse Security fund. He is proposing that both be applied to the principle. He said he does not have the exact amount that would be. It will leave us owing less than \$40,000.00 on the anticipation note. When it is paid off, that will free up 2 ½ to 3 cents in tax revenue for the next few years. It will also do away with all debt owed by the general fund with the exception of the computer systems in the JPs' offices and the Sheriff's department.

Commissioner Dickerson moved to make these transactions. Commissioner Nethery seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #7-Discuss Opening Road into I. L. Clark Property

Commissioner Smith said Mr. I. L. Clark has a tract of land that he needs access to. He believes that the old road was once a public road. He said he has done some investigating and found that this old road comes close, but does not actually touch Mr. Clark's property. It appears that Susan Dunmire owns the land on both sides of this road. She does not want it opened. He said he is open for suggestions.

Judge Leath explained to our visitors that this old road is in the South end of the County. Years ago this area was known as Black Jack Community.

Mr. I. L. Clark said he needs access to this property. There was a road that intersected with this old road that went to this tract of land. There was an old house on the property.

Debra Hudgins said she wants to buy this property from Mr. Clark, but can not if there isn't a road to it. The road did go all the way through there and there was a house on the property. There was a driveway off of this road to the property. Everybody is entitled to access to his or her property. Mr. Clark will never be able to sell this property if there isn't access to it. The old road starts in Jasper County and goes all the way through Sabine County. She said she has a map showing the old road.

Commissioner Smith said he agrees that everyone should have access to his or her property. He said he would like to have a public hearing so that people that knew about the Community before can give testimony to the facts.

Commissioner Smith said he would like to refer to the road as Black Jack for the historical value.

Commissioner Smith moved for the Court to Order a Public Hearing concerning the reopening of the road referred to as "Black Jack Road" for April 10<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #2-Reports

Commissioner Nethery moved to accept the reports from the County Clerk,
Treasurer and Tax Assessor. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for.
Motion carried.

Judge Leath said this is for information only. The bill that our U. S. Representative, Jim Turner, introduced has passed the House of Representatives and is currently before the Senate. This bill gives Sabine County, as well as other Counties in Texas with National Forest Service land, money in lieu of timber harvest. Our portion will be about one-half million a year. A representative from Senator Hutcheson's office told Judge Leath that it will take at least 6 weeks for the bill to come out of committee and probably that long or longer before it will be voted on by the Senate. If it is passed in its present form by a slim majority, the President will probably veto it because he is not in favor of the bill.

Judge Leath said he has written letters to Craig D. Pederson, Executive Administrator of the Texas Water Development Board, and to Jeffrey A. Saitas, Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission. These letters are in regard to Sabine County attempting to instigate the formation of a Regional Water Supply District. He read the letters to the Court. (See attached copies) He asked approval from the Court to mail these letters.

Commissioner Nethery moved for Court approval to mail the letters. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Court recessed at 9:20 a.m.

Court reconvened at 9:45 a.m.

Agenda item #5 is reopened.

John Payne and Gene Schaffer, TAC representatives, are present in Court. The County's insurance was discussed with no action taken.

Agenda item #7-Discuss & Possible Take Action on Vehicle for Sheriff's Dept.

Sheriff Philips said section 574 of the Mental Health Code is causing us some problems. This law deals with transporting people to a MHMR facility for evaluation. They are to be transported in an unmarked car with an officer in street clothes. If it is a female person, there has to be a female along unless a relative is available. They are not to be restrained unless deemed necessary. He said they try not to get on the MHMR merry-go-round because you never know just where you may be end up. What he is proposing is to borrow back the Commissioners' car that has the 911 stickers on it.

Commissioner Dickerson said it sounds like a good idea to him.

Commissioner Clark asked the Sheriff if he did not have an extra car.

Sheriff Philips said because of the shortage of deputies right now, he has an extra car. He said he is driving the K-9 unit because he has the dog.

Commissioner Clark said you have 7 deputies and 8 cars. The signs could be taken off the extra car. If you have 7 deputies, then 7 cars is all you need. You are paid an expense allowance of \$4,800.00 a year for your own car and you are driving a deputy car. You are coming out ahead.

Sheriff Philips was asked about using his own vehicle for the transportation and he said he has put 3 transmissions in it in 3 years and it has 130 thousand miles on it. He said he doesn't know how reliable it would be. He said he has not had much luck at buying a vehicle for \$4,800.00 a year.



On behalf of the citizens of Sabine County, I want to thank you and your staff of the Texas Water Development Board for the assistance extended to us during our meeting last Tuesday. February 23, 2000. The benefits of allowing time to incorporate the regional planning effort are many. A few of these include:


