MODIFIED INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT AND CONTRACT

WHEREAS, by written contract, dated the 11th day of July, 1974, supported by the separate Orders of each Commissioners Courts of the following thirteen (13) counties: Angelina, Hardin, Houston, Jasper, Nacogdoches, Newton, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, Shelby, San Jacinto, Trinity and Tyler, did establish and begin to operate a Community Center for the providing of Mental Health and Mental Retardation services for the thirteen (13) county region, which Community Center was originally named "Deep East Texas Regional Mental Health and Mental Retardation Services";

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of August 1996, by unanimous vote of the Board of Trustees of the Deep East Texas Regional Mental Health and Mental Retardation Services, the name of the Community Center, was formally legally changed to "The Burke Center" in honor of founding Board President and long time Trustee, Ward R. Burke of Lufkin, Texas, which name change took effect on the 27th day of August 1994.

WHEREAS, effective on the 1st day of September, 2000, Hardin County will cease to be a part of the Interlocal Agreement for the establishment and operation of the Burke Center, thereby creating the necessity for a modified Interlocal Agreement Cooperation Act Agreement by and for the remaining twelve (12) counties which sponsor

the Burke Center; under the authority of Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code; and

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WHEREAS, each of the Commissioners Courts of the twelve (12) counties have adopted written Orders which expressly authorize, adopt and approve the terms contained in this Modified Interlocal Agreement and Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, know all men by these presents that the Counties of Angelina, Houston, Jasper, Nacogdoches, Newton, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, Shelby, San Jacinto, Trinity and Tyler desire to continue the operation of a community center for mental health and mental retardation services under the laws of this state, which operation is authorized by the provisions of Chapter 534 of the Health and Safety Code; and the above named counties, acting by and through their duly authorized Commissioners Courts do hereby covenant and agree as follows:

Ι.

<u>Section 1.1 - Name</u>. The name of the community center shall be the Burke Center.

Section 1.2 - Principle Office. The principle office of the Burke Center shall be located in the City of Lufkin, Angelina County, Texas at such location in the City of Lufkin as the Board of Trustees shall determine. The center shall have such other offices as the Board

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of Trustees may determine or as the affairs of the center may require from time to time.

Section 1.3 - Registered Agent and Office. The registered agent for the center shall be the Chief Executive Officer and the registered office shall be 4101 South Medford Drive, Lufkin, Angelina County, Texas 75901.

II.

MEMBERSHIP and STRUCTURE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 2.1 - Representation. The member county governments agree to each appoint the respective member of the Board of Trustees for the Burke Center as set forth in this Agreement. The Board of Trustees for the Burke Center shall consist of nine (9) members to be appointed from the qualified voters of the region to be served, with each county authorized to appoint the representative as set forth below. The following county representation scheme is agreed upon as fair and equitable to all counties and will be implemented and used:

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Angelina County Houston County Newton by shared Jasper and Counties Nacogdoches County shared by Polk and San Jacinto Counties shared by Sabine and San Augustine County Shelby County Trinity County Tyler County

Section 2.02 - Terms of Office. The terms of office of these representatives and members of the Board of Trustees shall continue to be staggered as they have been since 1974 on the same schedule that has heretofore been employed. All appointment of Trustees hereafter shall be for a two (2) year period, or until their successors are appointed and qualified to serve. Appointments made to fill unexpired terms shall be for the period of the unexpired term, or until a successor is appointed and qualified.

III.

MISSION

<u>Section 3.01 - Mission.</u> The mission of the Burke Center is to reach each person who is in need of care due to mental health, mental retardation or substance abuse problems. This requires a geographically disbursed and affordable ray of quality of services specifically designed to meet the individual needs of the person served.

Section 3.02 - Purpose. The purpose of the Burke Center shall be to foster the development of a comprehensive and coordinated service delivery system which makes available a full range of mental health, mental retardation, and substance abuse services to citizens living within the service region. These services will include assisting

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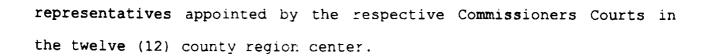
individuals to secure and maintain maximum independence and dignity, while remaining in their home environments. Efforts will be made to provide training, treatment, therapy, and counseling to individuals in order to help them achieve their maximum potential. Special emphasis will be placed on public education and consultation concerning mental health, mental retardation and substance abuse, with the long-range goal of prevention being paramount.

<u>Section 3.03 - Definition.</u> The Burke Center is a public entity, a governmental unit, a unit of local government, an agency of the state, and a political subdivision as defined:

- A. an agency of the state, a governmental unit, and a unit of local government, as defined and specified by Chapters 101 and 102. <u>Civil Practice and Remedies Code;</u>
- B. a local government, as defined by \$791.003. Government Code;
- C. a local government for the purposes of Chapter 1084, Acts of the 70th Legislature, Regular Session 1987. <u>Article 715c</u>, <u>Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes</u>; and
- D. a political subdivision for the purposes of Chapter 172. Local Government Code.

Further, the Burke Center shall be governed as an independent local unit of government by a nine (9) member Board of Trustees with

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All power and authority to govern, operate and manage the activities of the community center are vested in the Board of Trustees selected by the Commissioners Courts of the twelve (12) participating counties. The Board of Trustees shall have all power and duty authorized by the constitution and laws of the State of Texas for the operation of a community center.

The Board of Trustees of the community center shall operate in accordance with the revised Constitution and By-Laws of the Burke Center and in accordance with such policies and procedures duly adopted by the Board of Trustees.

IV.

PAYMENT

Participating Commissioners Courts in this Interlocal Agreement shall provide for payment for the performance of the governmental functions and services provided by the Burke Center by its annual funding and maintenance for the operations of the Burke Center, and each county shall make payments therefore from current revenues annually to the Burke Center Board of Trustees.

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This Interlocal Agreement is authorized by the governing bodies of the twelve (12) County Commissioners Courts as evidenced by the true and correct copies of the Resolutions of each of the Commissioners Courts which are incorporated herein for all purposes as if recited herein verbatim and as evidenced by the signatures of the County Judge of each of the counties below.

Resolution regarding the County's Support of HR 3294 and S1706

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has finalized Phase II Storm Water Discharge Regulations and the finalized regulations have been published in the Federal Register; and

WHEREAS, the final regulations, will have enormous economic consequences for many counties and require local governments to comply with this federal regulatory program; and

WHEREAS, EPA has made population the basis for the Phase II regulatory scheme, which means that "urbanized" areas (as defined by the census) will be covered by the rule whether or not they present any water quality concerns; and

WHEREAS, the 51 counties automatically designated in the final rules will be required to obtain permits for storm water discharges from "small municipal storm sewer systems", also known as MS4's; and

WHEREAS, in these 51 counties a drainage ditch in the county right-of-way will be considered an MS4 and therefore the county will be required to develop and enforce the storm water management program; and

WHEREAS, every county in the State of Texas which engages in construction activities of at least one acre will be required to obtain permits for discharges from such sites; and

WHEREAS, the cost of complying with the Phase II program will be borne by the local tax payer; and

WHEREAS, following a year and a half of exhaustive negotiations with the EPA, legislation is the only viable alternative in dealing with the broad-brush approach EPA has taken in its regulatory efforts; and

WHEREAS, Senator Kay Bailey Hutchison has introduced S. 1706 in the Senate and Congressman Spencer Bachus from Alabama has introduced H.R. 3294 in the House and both bills are currently pending in the United States Congress.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that <u>Sabine</u>...County supports the efforts of Senator Hutchison and Congressman Bachus and believes that this legislation will curtail the impact of the program on counties. S. 1706 and H.R. 3294 contain five provisions, three of which were adopted in the final rule, which takes a logical approach at correcting the broad-brush approach taken by EPA; and

East Texas Water Planning Group Meeting Notes for May 23,2000

There was a meeting of all of the Region planning group leaders held in Austin on May 16th. Its primary purpose was for the individuals to get to know one another. The TNRCC, TP&W were there as well as Senator Brown and Ron Lewis.

Region C (Dallas) is planning to take water from Lake Fork and Lake Palestine. The SRA has proposed 8 reservoirs for this region. They are planning 5 public meetings to present the plan.

Region D has proposed Nichols I north east of MT Pleasant. Also Prairie Creek near Gladewater.

Region H (Houston) has identified their supply. Most of their water is at the north end of the region and the problem is to determine how to get it to the needed areas. Allen Creek on the Brazos is the most probable reservoir they will propose. This would be a reservoir filled with flood waters. Their major strategy is water conservation and the controversial issue of waste water re use. They are also concerned with any waste water re-use planned by Dallas since 90% of the water in the Trinity is waste water from Dallas. They plan interbasin transfers between the Trinity and the San Jacinto rivers.

A key point was made by the TWDB representative. If a strategy does not get into the plan then the opportunity for local water companies to get state funding can be impacted.

The imput for the economic impact task has been submitted to the TWDB. This is the task were they will determine the impact of the water shortages on the communities.

The representative from Cherokee county indicated that there is a power company coming to their area and they will be taking 35000 gallons of water per hour to cool the generators. This water will then be put into the surface system. They also have found that the prisons in the area had not been included in the water requirements. Most of the prisons have their own wells.

The next portion of the meeting was devoted to the River Authorities presenting their proposed unique reservoir sites. The determination of unique was blurry at best This classification was supposedly added to Senate bill 1 in response to the special stream segments portion. No one seemed to know exactly what designating sites as unique would do. They were sure it would not prevent the land owners from doing things to their land.

The Angelina Neches River Authority (ANRA) presented lake Eastex as their primary reservoir to construct. Lake Eastex is on the Angelina River and is near Jacksonville. The attached charts and letter define the details of the lake and the participants.¹ It is a permitted lake and has cleared most of the hurdles required for construction. Approval by the Corps of Engineers is then next requirement before implementation.

The Lower Neches Valley Authority presented their plan for the Rockland Reservoir. The Rockland Reservoir is on the Neches River. The information is attached They would like to see the project reauthorized by law and bypass many of the problems and analyses typically required. They have done many studies in the past. They feel the COE has an obligation to build this reservoir because of the past laws. They intend to push this issue. If the reservoir were to be constructed the COE would furnish 50 to 75% of the cost. Champion and Temple own most of the timber land that would be needed.

The SRA proposed 9 sites for the Region I area. They were Carthage, Kilgore, Rabbit Creek, Highway 322 Stage I, Highway 322 Stage II, Socagee, Stateline, Big Cow Creek, and Bon Weir. Any reservoir upstream of Toledo Bend has precedence for the water. This was a part of the original documentation and agreements

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associated with Toledo Bend Reservoir construction approval. An advantage of some of the smaller sites is that they would relieve requirements on lake Fork. For example the Kilgore site would provide water to the region and release the requirement for water for Kilgore for Lake fork. The cost of construction, yield and some of the issues such as mining impacts, water quality and unique environmental impacts are presented in the attached material. Several of the sites recommended by the SRA are below Toledo Bend and since the water needs are to the north of the region they felt there was little value in developing these. These sites included Bon Weir and Big Cow Creek. State Line which is just north of Toledo Bend is also questionable since there is so much water in Toledo Bend which has not been sold.

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The Upper Neches representative talked about Lake Palestine and the possibility of using ground water as a means of providing additional water for the lake. This water would be taken from the Carrizo Wilcox Aquifer. He also recommended Ponte and Weches which are near lake Eastex.

The Water planning group voted to designate all of the sites presented as unique. The chose not to designate unique stream segments until they had more information. These are areas of the region where hardwoods, archeological sites endangered species and special environmental conditions have been designated by the TPW. At this point no trade offs have been made between water needs and the stream segments. The have planned to have more information presented at a future meeting.
