Friday, May 24, 2002, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in regular session. The following members of Court were present:

Judge Leath called the meeting to order and Bro. Clarence Howell led the Court in prayer.

Agenda item #1-General Business

Commissioner Clark moved to approve the minutes as written for the May 13th regular session of Court. Commissioner Nethery seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #3-Line Item Transfers

Judge Leath moved to approve the line item transfer for the Treasurer. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copy.

Agenda item #4-Discuss Sabine Tourist Commission- Possibly Take Action on Appointment

Commissioner Nethery moved to table this item. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #5-Consideration to Possibly Take Action on Resolution to Texas Department of Transportation for Reduction of Speed on Hwy. 21

Commissioner Nethery said he has been asked that the Court pass a Resolution to TXDOT requesting that the speed limit be reduced from 70 to 55mph on highway 21 from FM 3121 to the Pendleton bridge. The road is curvy and there are several subdivisions with roads that come into highway 21 along this strip.

Commissioner Nethery moved to adopt the resolution. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copy of resolution.

Agenda item #6-Discuss and Possibly Take Action on Membership with National Forest Counties and School Coalition



Judge Leath said we joined this back when we were trying to get the guaranteed funds from the Forest Service and they are asking that we rejoin so they can continue their efforts to extend this guaranteed payment past the 5 years that it was originally passed to do. They think that if we don't stay on top of this with the conflict in the world today, other items might cause this money to be directed in another way. It cost us .0033 percent of the money we received from the Forest Service. He asked the Treasurer to figure what this would amount to using only the money the County receives.

Tricia Jacks said it amounts to approximately \$12.55.

Commissioner Dickerson moved to table this item for the Judge to investigate it farther. Commissioner Smith seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #7-Consider with Possibly Take Action on 911 Funding to the City of Pineland, Tx.

Judge Leath said the City of Pineland is asking for \$300.00 for their software vendor to design a program to extract data from their system that will be compatible with DETCOG to assist them with 911 addressing.

Robert Gilcrease said the City of Pineland has an older software program that maintains the data base for them. Their data base has the main phone number and the 911 physical addresses they have assigned. They have assigned numbers to residences but not businesses. He said what they want to do is to take the City of Pineland's information and compare it with information from the phone company to make a match. This would enable them to enter the information electronically and not have to go door to door.

Judge Leath said this is not an unreasonable request. He said we do collect the money on the phone bills. He asked Robert Gilcrease about the City of Hemphill.

Robert said the City of Hemphill is not as far along as the City of Pineland as he understands it. They do not have an electronic data base yet.

Commissioner Smith moved to approve the request. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #8-Discuss and Possibly Take Action –Collection of Private Pay for EMS

Judge Leath said this item was taken care of at an earlier meeting. This item is deleted.

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Agenda item #9-Consider With Possible Take Action on Funding for Bond Election for Fresh Water District

Judge Leath said the cost of the election to form the District and for the funding cost approximately \$2,300.00. The County paid for that election. The District did pass but the funding did not. It was a very close vote, but the Board of Directors do not have any funds to hold an election with the County paying for it.

Phil Yocom said the Board of Directors of the Sabine County Fresh Water Supply District #1 is going to call for a bond election at their next meeting. They are asking the County to fund the election with the understanding that the County will be reimbursed if it passes.

Commissioner Nethery moved to support the Water District one more time and agreed to fund the bond election. Commissioner Clark seconded.

Commissioner Smith said he does not disagree with what has been said but he said he has repeatedly told everyone that it is a one time deal. He said he will have to vote against it but will support it if it gets on the ballot. He asked if G-M can fund the election.

Phil said they are checking into this right now but does not have an answer yet. He said he can not say that G-M would agree to fund the election if they could.

Commissioners Clark, Dickerson and Nethery voted for the motion. Commissioner Smith voted against. Motion carried.

Agenda item #10-Discuss and Possibly Take Action on Child Welfare Board Contract / Non-Financial Contract

Judge Leath said this does not involve any money from the County in this contract.

Judge Leath moved to approve the contract. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #11-Consider and Possibly Take Action on Request for Unclaimed Money from Comptroller

Judge Leath moved to make the request to the State Comptroller for unclaimed money. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried. See attached copy.

Agenda item #12-Consider and Possibly Take Action on Resolution for Sales Tax on Fuel for County Road Maintenance Funding

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Judge Leath said this resolution is requesting the County receive more money from fuel tax. The State of Texas generated 2.7 billion dollars in fuel tax in the fiscal year September 1, 2000 to August 31, 2001. The funds were allocated as follows: Texas Department of Transportation-\$2,021,800,000.00; Available School Fund-\$676,400,000.00; State Comptroller-\$50,000,000.00; County Road Fund-\$7,300,000.00. The percentage that the County Road Fund receives is the same as it was around 1957. We have attempted in the past to get this changed. In the State of Texas there are 3,233 miles of interstate highway, there are 12,109 miles of US highway, 16,154 miles of State highway, 40,984 miles of FM road, 6,481 miles of frontage road, 335 miles of Park road for a total of 79,297 miles that TXDOT maintains. Texas Counties maintain 142,368 miles of road. We are getting 7 million dollars in comparison to 2 billion dollars that TXDOT is getting. We all agree that it cost more to maintain paved roads than to maintain County roads.

Commissioner Smith said they are cutting out most of the Farm to Market roads and when they do one, it is in the urban areas. TXDOT will not install a culvert on a State right-of-way right now.

Commissioner Smith moved to approve this resolution. Commissioner Nethery seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #2-Reports

Commissioner Nethery moved to accept the reports from the Treasurer and from the Tax Office. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Agenda item #13-Pay Accounts and Salaries

Commissioner Nethery moved to pay the accounts and salaries except for 1 bill from the Sheriff's department for auto repair. Judge Leath will check it out before it is paid. Commissioner Clark seconded. All voted for. Motion carried.

Commissioner Nethery moved to adjourn. Commissioner Dickerson seconded. Meeting adjourned.

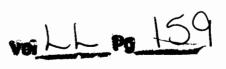

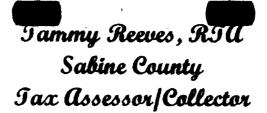
