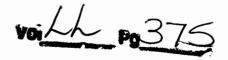

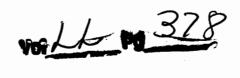

Getting the tank cleaned and replacing the valves will bring us into compliance in this area with the TNRCC.

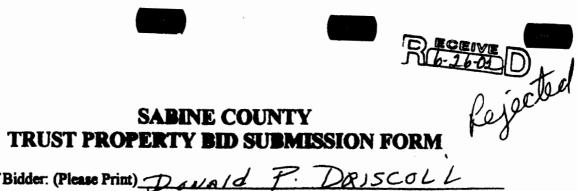

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#### **Current National Transportation Issues**

Texas ranks 46<sup>th</sup> out of 50 States in the percentage return of federal gas taxes! Texas' population is booming, trade with Mexico is exploding, and our highways are carrying an ever-increasing freight load for other states. We *must* receive a fairer return of the federal gas tax, both for the sake of Texas and to continue to improve trade routes for the rest of the nation. TEX-21 is also working to increase the total amount of funding available for transportation and to streamline the process for roadwork approval. The TEX-21 Congressional Causes, newly formed in January 2002 and Co-Chaired by Congress Members John Culberson, Charles Gonzalez, Eddie Bernice Johnson and Pete Sessions, is quickly becoming a key organization for us to implement these needed changes.

## **Accomplishments of TEX-21**

Please see the enclosed Executive Summary for a review of *TEX-21's* successes during the last Texas legislative session, and *TEX-21's* successful efforts to pass Constitutional Amendment Proposition 15 regarding the Mobility Fund and Toll Equity.

Texans also faced a challenge to our historical methods of economic development when the Texas Transportation Commission issued an unforessen policy to limit use of frontage roads. TEX-21 disseminated information and helped interested parties prepare comments for public hearings held across the state. The widespread negative outcry resulted in the frontage road minimization policy being completely pulled back and the new Access Management policy being developed in its place. TEX-21 met with Governor Rick Perry to discuss the frontage road/access management issue and the Governor's proposed Trans Texas Corridor plan. TEX-21 was invited to meet regularly with the Governor and/or his staff to assure clear communications.

In part as a result of that meeting, TEX-21 was given a new opportunity to comment on a working draft of the new Access Management rules while they were still being refined by TxDOT. The draft Access Management Manual was not offered for preliminary review. Even so, allowing "outsiders" to comment on the rules during that period of policy drafting is an unusual step for TxDOT and the TTC and is indicative that they are becoming more willing to work cooperatively with TEX-21 because we represent a large and interested percentage of the population of the state. As their biggest supporters, we encourage the opportunities to be able to contribute at an early stage and thereby optimize the chances for implementing policies that will succeed.

# EXCERPT: TEX-21 BYLAWS Revised Retriery 8, 2002

2.2 <u>Membership Dues</u>. All members shall be required to pay annual membership dues to TEX-21 in such amounts as established from time to time by the Executive Committee. The membership dues owed and payable shall be due within 30 days of the beginning of TEX-21's fiscal year or in the case of a new member immediately as a condition of becoming a member.

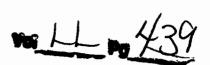
## **Proposal Benefits**

### Procedures For Acceptance In The FSPP

- 1. Commissioners Court approve permanent VFD funding at the rate of \$1.00 per year.
- 2. County Judge completes eligibility letter and issue such letter to each VFD.
- 3. Each VFD complete and submit FSPP application to the Texas Building and Procurement Commission.



### CONTRACT FOR SABINE COUNTY DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE

Whereas, Sabine County, desires to enter into a contract with a party to act as the Sabine County Designated Representative:

Whereas, Robert Gilcrease, is an employee at will of the county and is desirous to attain the contract as the Sabine County Designated Representative;

#### **AGREEMENT**

- 1. Sabine County shall designate Robert Gilcrease as the Sabine County Designated Representative in connection with the on-site sewage facility program.
- 2. Sabine County shall pay for the necessary training and education expenses required for the Sabine County Designated Representative by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission.
  - 3. The Designed Representative shall:

- (1)possess a current license from the executive director;
- (2)be employed, appointed, or contract by an authorized agent;
- (3)enforce the rules and regulations of the Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 366, of the Texas Water Code, and the permitting authority;
- (4) assist the authorized agent in amending the authorized agent's order, ordinance, or resolution when necessary;
  - (5) conduct subdivision reviews in conformance with this chapter's;
- (6) review variance requests to ensure compliance with the requirements of the permitting authority;
- (7)approve only planning materials that conform with the requirements of this chapter and the requirements of the permitting authority;

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- (8) issue the authorization to construct;
- (9) verify, before the initial inspection, that the installer possesses a current license and has the correct classification for constructing the permitted or planned OSSF;
- (10) conduct construction inspections as required under § 285.3(d) of this title (relating to General Requirements);
- (11) approve only construction that conforms with this chapter, the authorized agent's approved order, ordinance, or resolution, and the notice of approval's;
  - (12) issue the notice of approval;
  - (13) ensure collection of all OSSF related fees;
- (14) ensure maintenance of accurate records of permitting, fees, inspections, maintenance reports, and complaints;
  - (15) investigate complaints and take appropriate and timely action;
- (16) record his license number on all plan reviews, complaint investigations, inspection reports, site evaluations, and any other correspondence prepared in performance of the duties of a Designated Representative under this chapter;
- (17) record the installer license number in any inspection reports relating to that installer;
- (18) receive compensation for OSSF related services within the authorized agent's area of jurisdiction, only from the authorized agent or according to a signed contract with the authorized agent;
- (19) while employed by, appointed to, or contracted by the authorized agent, refrain from performing any of the following activities within the authorized agent's area of jurisdiction:
  - (A) working as an apprentice to an OSSF installer;
  - (B) working an OSSF installer;
  - (C) working for an OSSF maintenance company; or

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(D) performing any other OSSF-related activities which fall under the authorized agent's regulatory jurisdiction, except those activities directly related to the individual's duties as a designated representative for the authorized agent;

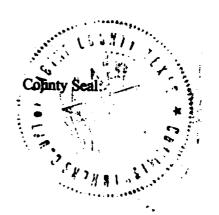
- (20) verify the existence of a maintenance contract between an owner and the maintenance company according to §285.7(c) of this title (relating to Maintenance Requirements); and
- (21) maintain a current address and phone number with the executive director and submit any change in address or phone number in writing within 30 days after the date of the change.
- 4. Robert Gilcrease represents and agrees that he is an employee-at-will of Sabine County and will perform all duties listed above without incurring overtime or working more than forty hours a week. At anytime in which he believes he is unable to fully perform his current job and this contract within forty hours he will notify the Sabine County Judge in writing and obtain written permission, if any, prior to incurring any overtime.
- 5. As additional compensation, over and above his salary, at his current position, Robert Gilcrease as the designated representative may assess and collect only those fees approved by the Sabine County Commissioner's Court. A copy of the current fee schedule is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference. The fees will be assessed against the individual or individuals within the County obtaining the service from the designated representative. For all other services, Robert Gilcrease performs as the designated representative, he shall receive no other compensation than his current salary and the fees set forth above.
- 6. This Agreement may be terminated with or without cause by either party to this Agreement by providing five (5) days written notice to the other party to the address provide below:
