County Clerk, Janice McDaniel, requested that the following voting locations be consolidated for the November 6, 2007 election.

Pts. 4 and 9 with Pct. 3
Pct. 6 with Pct. 7
The Clerk also recommended closing voting precinct 6, Geneva and precinct 9, Bethel Chapel. This will save about $\$ 400.00$ per precinct per election. She gave the Court information on how much the cost of elections have gone up in the last 2 years and we are expecting about a 15 percent increase next year. It is getting harder to find election workers. The election judge for Geneva resigned and the building that had been used to hold previous elections is not in use anymore. The cost for the November general election went from \$7,628 dollars in 2004 (before HAVA) to $\$ 10,469$ in 2006 . I received notice from ES\&S that there will be a cost increase in 2008. Also with minimum wage going up, election worker pay will also be increasing.

Yes, the State paid for the now equipment but they are not paying for the increase cost in using this equipment. This is mother one of those con and effect that started with the Federal Government to the Stree and of course paced on down to the Counties.

At least we are not facing another expense of having the touch screen voting machines. There is a lot of controversy over the touch screen voting machines. The Counties that purchased thee will probably have to purchase extra equipment that will attach to the machine to give a paper trail. The County Clerks from Shelby and Sen Augustine Counties and I studied long and hard before we made a decision on which machine would be the best for our Counties. We felt we knew our people well enough that they would

still want that paper ballot, so that is what we ween with. If we never make another right decision, I feel we did on that one.

Ms. Click has resigned as Precinct Judge for Geneva and her alternate, Faye Arthur has told me that she does not went to do it. The Church where we used to hold voting is closed and I don't know that we can continue to find a location to have voting in Geneva.

We have carly voting for 2 weeks before the election and anyone 65 or older or disabled can apply for a ballot by mail. We also have a Saturday voting for elections that have offices on the ballot. Mont everyone will come into Hemphill within that 2 week period.

The only way I see to cut cont is to climinme some of our smaller voting precincts. This is not a decision that was made easily, but it is just firing frets.

I am anking that we close voting precinct 6, Geneva, and precinct 9, Bethel Chapel effective December 1, 2007.
