Judge Watson called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Randy Blanks with David Waxman & Associates is present in Court.

Agenda item #1-Regarding Submission of an Application to the Office of Rural Community Affairs

Judge Watson introduced Randy Blanks to the public present in the Courtroom.

Mr. Blanks explained to everyone that this is concerning the recent flooding that affected Commissioner precincts 1, 3 and 4. Commissioner Warner, precinct #4, was greatly impacted. He said we did not qualify for FEMA but the County can apply for up to 350 thousand dollars from the office of Rural Community Affairs. This is only available for Cities and Counties. Individuals will have to apply through other revenues. He said with preliminary expenses and estimating cost of getting roads and bridges back to standard condition we are looking at a total well above the 350 thousand dollars. The County will have to absorb the extra expenses.

A board member of G-M Water asked how they might get help with their losses.

Mr. Blanks said the County could apply on their behalf but it would have to come out of the 350 thousand dollars.

This meeting was a required public hearing with no action taken.

Commissioner Dickerson moved to adjourn. Commissioner Warner seconded. All voted for. Meeting adjourned.
