AGENDA ITEM #1-Discussion with Possible Action-Demonstration
Zipper, Inc. Asphalt

Barry with Zipper, Inc. Asphalt met with the Court to give a brief statement with corresponding video about the Company and the success of the Zipper. He said the company was started in 1994. The machine should last about 20 years. You can cover about a half mile of road a day. The roads will last approximately 10 to 15 years.

The machine comes in different sizes. The one being demonstrated today has a 30 inch cut. The cost is around \$94,000.00 with the water system attachment to water the teeth for longer life. The machine weighs about 6,000 pounds. If financed through Zipper Inc., the interest rate is 4 percent. Payments would be 18 to 20 thousand dollars a year. Payments can be pushed up to start August 2011.

Court recessed at 9:15 a.m. to reconvene on the Pleasure Bend road in precinct 2. Judge Watson and Commissioner Warner left the meeting for prior commitments.

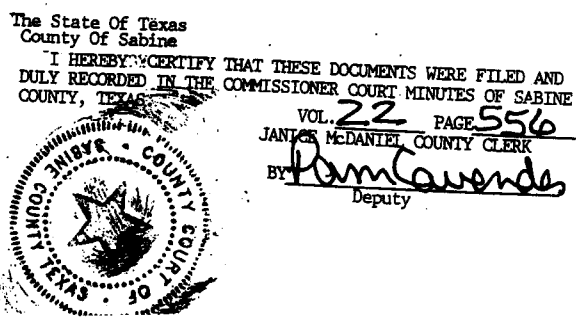
