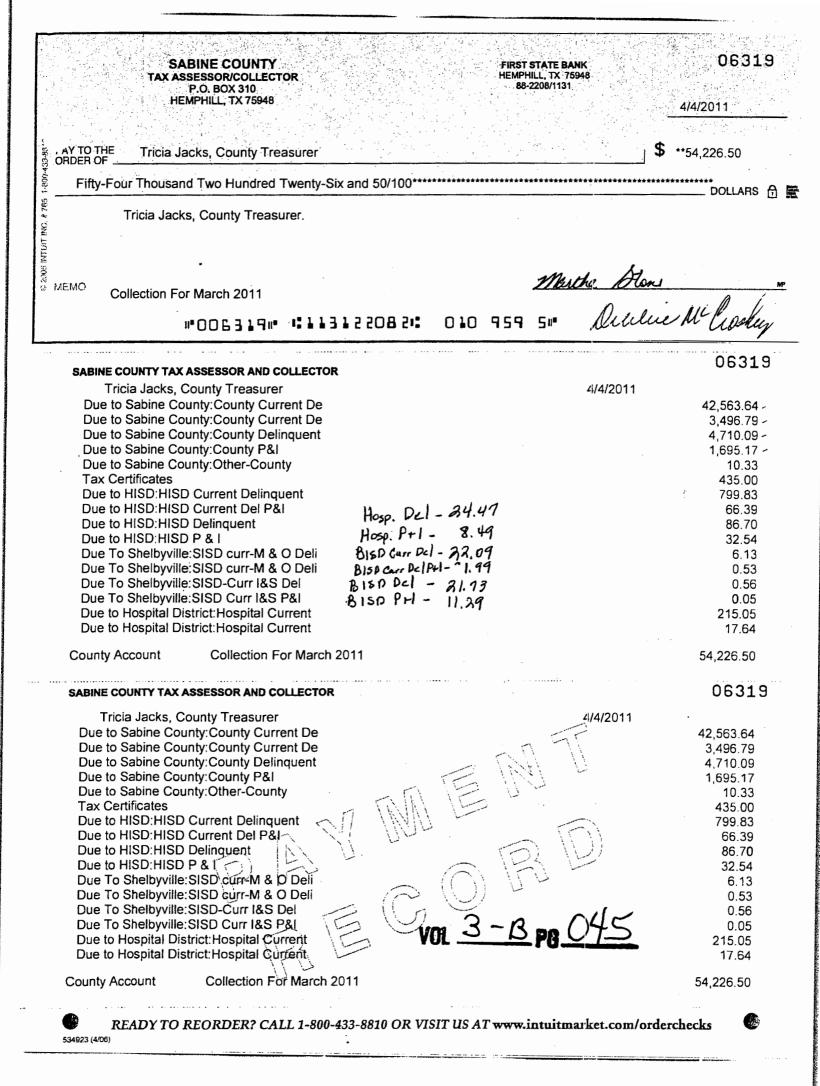

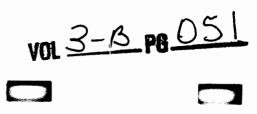

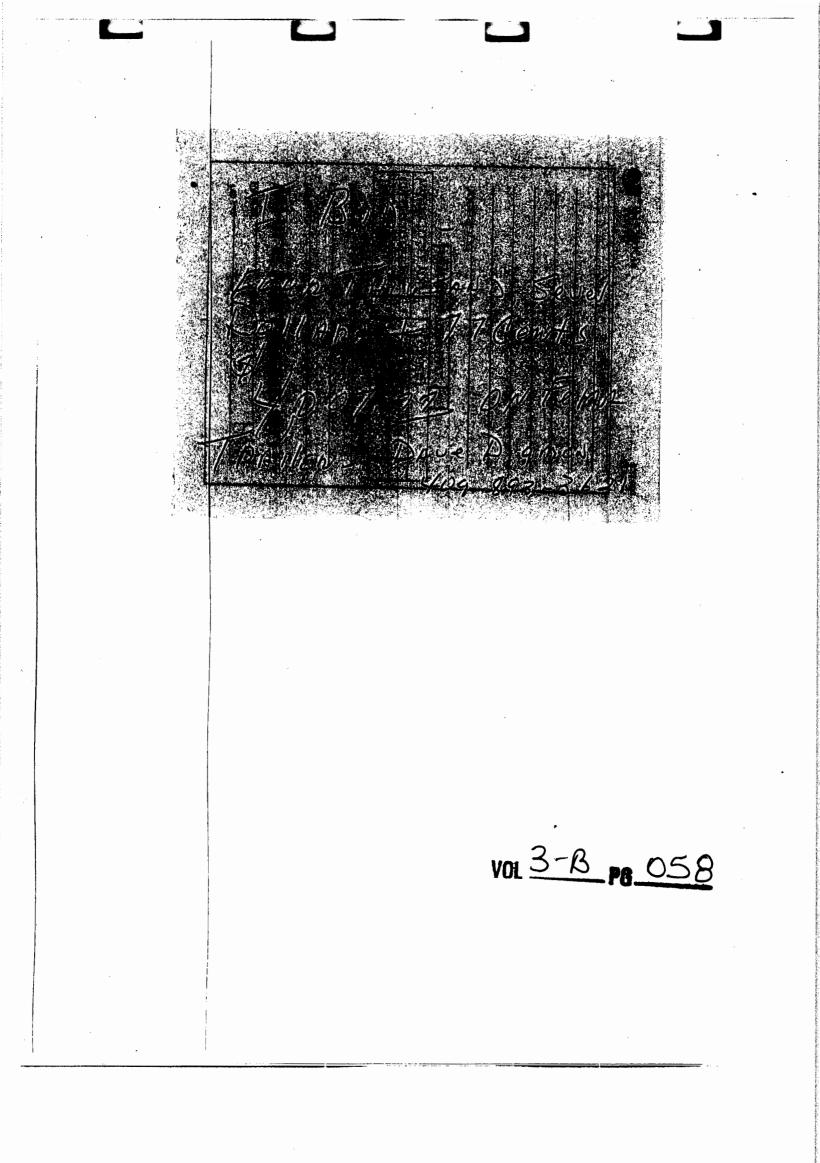

Telephone/Cell Phone Use

- County telephones shall be for conducting the business of Sabine County. Excessive personal use of county telephones/cell phones may make an employee subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.
- 2. The use of any cell phone or texting is banned while operating any vehicle and equipment. Federal law prohibits any CDL driver operating any vehicle over 10,000 GWR from texting with fines and penalties, up to and including loss of CDL.
- 3. Each department shall adopt additional rules and regulations regarding personal cell phone usage while at work.

Sabine County Personnel Policy

Vacations

- 1. All full-time employees of Sabine County shall be eligible for paid vacation leave.
- 2. The amount of vacation is based on the employee's time of service as shown below:
 - a. 0-1 year: no vacation
 - b. 1-2 years: one week vacation
 - c. 2+ years: two weeks vacation
 - d. 10+ years: three weeks vacation

All Departments that work a 35 hours week, vacation is specified as 35 hours for 1 week.

All Departments that work a 40 hours week, vacation is specified as 40 hours for 1 week.

- 3. The maximum amount of vacation that an employee shall be allowed to have at any one time is three weeks. However, it is strongly recommended that all employees take their vacation in a timely manner and do not allow vacation time to accrue. Reasons for accrual in excess of the limit are:
 - a. The employee is not able to take vacation because of the needs of Sabine County.
 - b. The department head requests in writing to the committee that the employee be allowed vacation above the established limit and explains the reasons for such accrual.
- 4. An employee shall not be permitted to receive pay in lieu of vacation time.
- 5. At the beginning of each year, each department head, with the input of his employees, shall prepare a vacation schedule for his/her department. This schedule will take into consideration:
 - a. The employee's request
 - b. The employee's seniority
 - c. The operating needs of the department

- 6. This schedule may be changed at any time by the department head approving the employee's request for variance from the original schedule.

- 7. The minimum amount of vacation time allowed is four hours.
- 8. Employees shall not be allowed to borrow vacation against possible future vacation earnings.
- 9. If a holiday falls during the period an employee is on vacation, the holiday will not count as vacation time. However, the employee shall inform his/her department head as to the days he/she will be absent from work both on vacation and on holiday status.
- 10. Full-time employees who have worked for less than one year shall not receive pay for accrued vacation upon termination.
- 11. Full-time employees who have worked for more than one year shall be paid for all unused vacation upon termination.
- 12. An employee who is rehired by the County on a full-time basis within 365 days of his/her termination or voluntary resignation shall have prior service with Sabine County counted toward years of service for calculating vacation time.
- 13. Each department head shall maintain and update on a monthly basis a vacation record for each employee. This record shall show:
 - a. The vacation balance at the start of the month
 - b. The hours of vacation earned during the month
 - c. The hours of vacation used during the month

Sick Leave

- 1. All full-time employees shall be eligible for sick leave.
- 2. Employees shall accrue four hours of sick leave each month. Any unused sick leave at the end of the calendar year shall be carried over to the next calendar year. The maximum accrual that can be carried into a new calendar year is forty hours.
- 3. The minimum amount of sick leave that may be used at any one time is two hours.
- 4. Eligible employees may use sick leave for absence from work for the following reasons:
 - a. Personal illness or physical or mental incapacity;
 - b. Extended medical, dental or optical examinations or treatment;
 - c. Medical quarantine resulting from exposure to a contagious disease;
 - d. Illness of a member of the employee's household who requires the employee's personal care and attention.
- 5. An employee shall be responsible for notifying his/her department head as early as possible on the first day of sick leave.
- 6. If more than one day of sick leave is needed, the employee shall be responsible for notifying his/her department head of the anticipated length of absence on the first day of sick leave or shall be responsible for timely communication with his department head as to the date of his/her expected return to work.

The department head shall have the right to require a physician's statement of injury or illness for either the employee's own illness or the illness of an immediate family member.

- 7. An employee shall be required to notify his/her department head prior to the use of sick leave for any non-emergency medical, dental or optical appointments, treatments or procedures.
- 8. If an employee is on sick leave during an official county holiday, then that day shall not be counted against an employee's sick leave.
- 9. Employees shall not be allowed to borrow sick leave based on future employment time.
- 10. An employee shall receive no pay for any unused sick leave at the time of termination.
- 11. An employee may donate sick leave to a fellow employee who is in need because of an extended illness.

An extended illness or injury is defined as:

A terminal, life-threatening, and/or severe condition or combination of conditions affecting the mental or physical health of the employee that requires the services of a Sabine County Personnel Policy 30 licensed health practitioner for a prolonged period of time (at least 14 calendar days or longer) and forces the employee to exhaust all accrued leave time (sick leave, vacation, and compensatory time (if applicable)) and to lose compensation with the County.

12. The donating employee must get the donation authorization form from his/her Department Head. Upon review and approval, the Department Head will submit a copy of the donation form to the recipient employee's Department Head.

Civil Leave

- 1. All full-time employees shall receive their normal pay for the period they are called for jury duty. This includes the jury selection process, and if selected, the time actually spent on jury service.
- 2. All employees subpoenaed or ordered to attend court to appear as a witness or to testify in some official capacity on behalf of the county shall be entitled to leave with pay for such period as his/her court appearance may require.
- 3. Any fee paid for such services may be retained by the employee.
- 4. If an employee is absent from work to appear in private litigation in which he/she is a principal party, the time off shall be charged to vacation leave, comp time or leave without pay. The employee shall provide prior notice of any such court appearance to his/her department head.

Military Leave

- 1. Regular full-time employees who are members of the National Guard or active reserve components of the United States Armed Forces shall be allowed up to 15 days per year with pay to attend authorized training sessions and exercises.
- 2. The 15 days paid military leave shall apply to the Federal fiscal year (10/1 9/30). Any unused balance at the end of the year shall not be carried forward into the next year.
- 3. Pay for attendance at Reserve or National Guard training sessions or exercises shall be authorized only for periods which fall within the employee's normal work schedule.
- 4. An employee may use annual vacation leave, comp time, or leave without pay if he/she must attend Reserve or National Guard training sessions or exercises in excess of the 15 days paid maximum.
- 5. An employee going on military leave shall provide his/her department head with a set of orders within three days after receiving them.
- 6. Sabine County employees who leave their positions as a result of being called to active military service or who voluntarily enter the Armed Forces of the United States shall be eligible for re-employment in accordance with the state and federal regulations in effect at the time of their release from active duty.

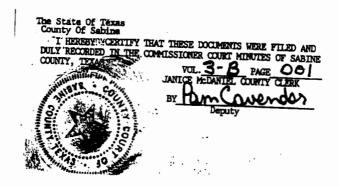

Sabine County Personnel Policy

Compensation

- 1. This policy shall apply to all Sabine County employees.
- 2. Compensation for law enforcement employees shall be handled in accordance with the policies established in the Sheriff's Department as directed by the Commissioners' Court.
- 3. Employees will be paid on a salary basis except for part-time employees and Commissioner Precinct employees.
- 4. Deputies and jailers are paid by a salary and the work period shall compensate the employee for all hours worked in a work period up to 171 hours in a 28 day period depending upon the work load. Hours worked over 171 are considered as overtime, and are credited as comp time at a rate of one and one-half times the number of overtime hours worked.
- 5. Temporary employees shall be paid hourly and at least at the minimum wage established by the Fair Labor Standards Act, as amended.
