AGENDA ITEM #1-Discuss with possible action: Low Income Housing Tax Credit for "Whitetail Ridge"

This concerns "Ike" funds for a 36 units of affordable housing for elderly tenants.

Judge Watson said last year we had a hearing on "Whitetail Ridge" low income senior housing project. At that time they were looking for tax credits. At that time they needed \$175,000.00 to be eligible. The project fell through. They are now applying again and they only need \$36,000 to be eligible. He said he has written a letter stating that this \$36,000.00 is contingent upon release of those funds to Sabine County.

This letter is in reference to your request for funding of \$36,000 to be applied to the development of 36 units of affordable housing for elderly tenants. The development known as Whitetail Ridge is to be located at 355 FM 83 in Hemphill, Texas.
