A county's election to receive a payment and to allocate the State payment must be transmitted by the Governor's office or other appropriate executive office of the State, such as State Treasurer, on behalf of the Governor. The Forest Service will not accept an election directly from a county or from any non-governmental organization acting on behalf of a county.

#### **Election to Receive Payment**

The State must transmit, for each county in which a national forest is situated, the county's election to receive a share of the Secure Rural Schools Act State payment or a share of the State's 25-percent payment. The State may use this form to transmit county elections to the Forest Service. If the State fails to transmit a county's election by the deadline of September 30, 2012 (midnight, mountain time), the county will be considered to have elected to receive a share of the State payment.

To assist States and counties in making informed decisions, the Projected State Payments (see <u>Projected FY2012 Payments</u>) and Estimated 25-percent payments (see <u>Estimated 25-percent payments</u>, FY2008-FY2011) for each affected county is published on the Forest Service Secure Rural Schools Act website at

The Projected FY2012 State Payments are calculated using the formula described in the Act and the currently available data for historic payments, acreage, per capita personal income and assumes all affected counties will elect to receive a share of the State payment. The actual county shares of the State payment will be calculated only for counties that elect to receive a share of the State payment or the county payment (for BLM lands in western Oregon) and will be calculated using acreage amounts for updated for FY2012.

The payments shown in "Estimated 25-percent payments, FY2008-FY2011" are based on the 7-year rolling average annual receipts. The actual county share of the State's 25-percent payment will be based on the 7-year average annual receipts for FY2006 through FY2012.

#### **Election to Allocate the State Payment**

Each county that elects to receive a share of the State payment must make an additional election to allocate the State payment. The guidelines for making the allocation vary depending on the amount of the county share of the State payment.

• \$100,000 or less. An eligible county that elects to receive a share of the State payment that is \$100,000 or less (a minor distribution) may elect to use 100-percent of its share for public roads and schools under title I. In contrast to previous years, a county that elects to receive a minor distribution must make an affirmative election to use the 100-percent of its share for title I purposes. In the alternative, the

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county may opt to allocate 15-percent to 20-percent of its share to title II, title III, or a combination of both, except that the allocation for title III projects may not exceed 7-percent. The total percentage allocated to title II and title III combined must be no less than 15-percent and no greater than 20-percent. The county also may opt to return its allocation, in whole or part, to the Federal Government.

- \$100,001 to \$349,999. If the county share of the State payment is more than \$100,000 but less than \$350,000, the county must allocate 15-percent to 20-percent of its share to title II, title III, or a combination of both. The total percentage allocated to title II and/or title III must be no less than 15-percent and no greater than 20-percent. The county also may opt to return its allocation, in whole or part, to the Federal Government.
- \$350,000 or greater. If the county share of the State payment is \$350,000 or greater, the county must allocate 15-percent to 20-percent of its share to title II, title III, or a combination of both, except that the allocation for title III projects may not exceed 7-percent. The total percentage allocated to title II and title III combined must be no less than 15-percent and no greater than 20-percent. The county also may opt to return its allocation, in whole or part, to the Federal Government.

Projects funded under title II must be initiated (reviewed and recommended by a resource advisory committee) by September 30, 2012 and title II funds must be obligated by September 30, 2013. Projects funded under title III must be initiated by September 30, 2012 and title III funds must be obligated by September 30, 2013.

An eligible county that fails to elect to allocate its payment shall be considered to have elected to expend 80-percent of its share of the State payment for public schools and roads. The remaining 20-percent will be available to the Forest Service to carry out projects in the eligible county to further the purposes of title II.

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# INTER-GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF SABINE AND GM WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION

#### STATE OF TEXAS

#### COUNTY OF SABINE

This Agreement between the COUNTY OF SABINE, TEXAS, whose address is, P.O. Box 716, Hemphill, Texas 75948 hereinafter referred to as "County" and the GM WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION whose address is P.O.Box 727, Hemphill, Texas 75948 hereinafter referred to as "GM", is as follows:

WHEREAS, the County will apply for a 2008 Supplemental Disaster Recovery Fund: Hurricane Dolly and Ike Non Housing Activities Grant from the Texas General Land Office in the amount of \$4,582,727.00 of which \$1,287,321.00 (Construction) is being applied on behalf of GM.

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Disaster Recovery Funds Contract will purchase and install water treatment plant equipment, including membrane filtration equipment, clarifier equipment, disinfection equipment, raw water intake pumps, ground storage tanks, yard piping, electrical controls, and other associated appurtenances in order to provide the county residents with a reliable source of potable water.

WHEREAS, the County and GM are desirous of reciting in writing certain duties and obligations between the parties hereto:

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual benefits flowing to GM as well as the County as a result of the application by the County and the receipt of a contract award under the 2008 Supplemental Disaster Recovery Fund Program and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or other good and valuable considerations the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. In the event the County should incur any costs at the request or under the direction of/or approved by GM which is determined by the Texas General Land Office to exceed actual or reasonable costs for performances rendered under said Texas Community Development Program Contract, GM will be responsible and pay for any such costs on or before thirty (30) days from the date of notice and demand for payment of same with the County providing a copy of the paid receipt or invoice in question.
- 2. The Project Engineer shall coordinate with the County and GM all plans and specifications.
- 3. Prior to the bidding process, the Project Engineer shall submit specifications to the County, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and GM for approval.
- 4. The County shall fully and satisfactorily perform all of the conditions and obligations of the County as contractor under the terms of the TxCDBG Contract.

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- 5. GM will fully and satisfactorily perform all of its obligations under the terms of this contract.
- 6. The County shall submit such reports as are required under the TxCDBG Contract. GM shall provide the County with all information and documents in the possession of GM necessary for such required reports of the County. Should GM fail to timely furnish any such information or documents in the possession of GM following timely request for same, should the County incur any expenses or damages whatsoever as a result of GM failing to timely furnish such information necessary to comply with the reporting requirements of said TxCDBG Disaster Contract then GM shall be required to repay such expenses to the County and otherwise indemnify the County for any loss or damages sustained as a result thereof.
- 7. GM hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County against any and all claims, demands, causes of action of every kind or character which may be asserted by the Texas General Land Office, an agency of the State of Texas, occurring or in any way incident to, arising out of, or in connection with the services to be performed by GM under this Contract.
- 8. In the event of the termination of the TxCDBG 2008 SUPPLEMENTAL DISASTER RECOVERY CONTRACT for any grounds other than the negligence or intentional violation of the TxCDBG CONTRACT by the County resulting in said termination, GM shall indemnify and hold harmless the County for any and all claims, demands, damages, or other causes of action asserted by any subcontractors or suppliers or others, as a result of any contract entered into by and between the County and any said subcontractors or others as a result of the award of said TxCDBG CONTRACT to the County.
- 9. The County and/or GM may terminate this Contract in whole or in part at either of the following times: (1) Upon notification by the Department of the termination of said TxCDBG CONTRACT, or (2) upon a violation of the terms of the Contract by other party.
- 10. The parties expressly agree that the County requested and obtained the partial amount allocated for this proposed TxCDBG Supplemental Disaster Recovery Grant at the request of GM for the benefit of the citizens in the project area. Therefore, it is expressly agreed that any expenses or damages suffered by the County as a result of said project under the TxCDBG Contract or grant, other than such damages or unreasonable expenses which are incurred as a result of the intentional conduct of the County, shall be paid by GM. All said additional expenses not covered by the allocated grant funds shall be paid for by GM.
- 11. The parties further agree that all land purchases and improvements placed thereon, and all facility improvements acquired by funds from said TxCDBG CONTRACT and/or purchased or provided by GM shall be conveyed in fee simple to GM by the County upon completion of the grant contract. In consideration therefore, GM agrees

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and will assume all legal responsibilities and obligations connected with the improvements and operation of said facilities.

12. This is a good faith effort between the County and GM to accommodate and assist the citizens of the County by providing improved water facilities to the project target area and each of the entities here do pledge their best efforts to fulfill the obligation set forth herein as well as the obligations and requirements set forth in said TxCDBG 2008 Supplementary Disaster Recovery Contract if awarded by the Texas General Land Office, the same being incorporated herein by reference the same as if fully set forth in this Contract.

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# INTER-GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF SABINE AND

#### BEECHWOOD WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION

#### STATE OF TEXAS

#### COUNTY OF SABINE

This Agreement between the COUNTY OF SABINE, TEXAS, whose address is, P.O. Box 716, Hemphill, Texas 75948 hereinafter referred to as "County" and the BEECHWOOD WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION whose address is 120 Eastwood Loop, Hemphill, Texas 75948 hereinafter referred to as "WSC", is as follows:

WHEREAS, the County will apply for a 2008 Supplemental Disaster Recovery Fund: Hurricane Dolly and Ike Non Housing Activities Grant from the Texas General Land Office in the amount of \$4,582,727.00 of which \$196,500.00 (Construction) is being allocated on behalf of WSC.

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Disaster Recovery Funds Contract shall purchase and install one (1) forty-five to sixty kilowatt (45 kW - 60 kW) generator at the Waste Water Treatment Plant with transfer switch, pad, and associated appurtenances, construct access drives for six (6) lift stations and upgrade, rehabilitate, or replace lift station shelter structures to each of the six lift stations, along with site work associated with construction.

WHEREAS, the County and WSC are desirous of reciting in writing certain duties and obligations between the parties hereto:

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual benefits flowing to the WSC as well as the County as a result of the application by the County and the receipt of a contract award under the 2008 Supplemental Disaster Recovery Fund Program and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or other good and valuable considerations the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. In the event the County should incur any costs at the request or under the direction of/or approved by the WSC which is determined by the Texas General Land Office to exceed actual or reasonable costs for performances rendered under said Texas Community Development Program Contract, the WSC will be responsible and pay for any such costs on or before thirty (30) days from the date of notice and demand for payment of same with the County providing a copy of the paid receipt or invoice in question.
- 2. The Project Engineer shall coordinate with the County and WSC on all plans and specifications.
- 3. Prior to the bidding process, the Project Engineer shall submit specifications to the County, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the WSC for approval.
- 4. The County shall fully and satisfactorily perform all of the conditions and obligations of the County as contractor under the terms of the TxCDBG Contract.

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- 5. The WSC will fully and satisfactorily perform all of its obligations under the terms of this contract.
- 6. The County shall submit WSC such reports as are required under Section 8 of the TxCDBG Contract. The WSC shall timely provide the County with all information and documents in the possession of the WSC necessary for such required reports of the County. Should the WSC fail to timely furnish any such information or documents in the possession of the WSC following timely request for same, should the County incur any expenses or damages whatsoever as a result of the WSC failing to timely furnish such information necessary to comply with the reporting requirements of said TxCDBG Disaster Contract then the District shall be required to repay such expenses to the WSC County and otherwise indemnify the WSC for any loss or damages sustained as a result thereof.
- 7. The WSC hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County against any and all claims, demands, causes of action of every kind or character which may be asserted by the Texas General Land Office, an agency of the State of Texas, occurring or in any way incident to, arising out of, or in connection with the services to be performed by the WSC under this Contract.
- 8. In the event of the termination of the TxCDBG 2008 SUPPLEMENTAL DISASTER RECOVERY CONTRACT for any grounds other than the negligence or intentional violation of the TxCDBG CONTRACT by the County resulting in said termination, the WSC shall indemnify and hold harmless the County for any and all claims, demands, damages, or other causes of action asserted by any subcontractors or suppliers or others, as a result of any contract entered into by and between the County and any said subcontractors or others as a result of the award of said TxCDBG CONTRACT to the County.

The parties further agree that all land purchases and improvements placed thereon, and all wastewater facility improvements acquired by funds from said TxCDBG CONTRACT and/or purchased or provided by the WSC shall be conveyed in fee simple to the WSC by the County upon completion of the grant contract. In

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consideration therefore, the WSC agrees and will assume all legal responsibilities and obligations connected with the improvements and operation of said water facilities.

This is a good faith effort between the County and the WSC to accommodate and assist the citizens of the area by providing improved wastewater service to the project target area and each of the entities here do pledge their best efforts to fulfill the obligation set forth herein as well as the obligations and requirements set forth in said TxCDBG 2008 Supplementary Disaster Recovery Contract if awarded by the Texas General Land Office the same being incorporated herein by reference the same as if fully set forth in this Contract.
