Sabine County Tax Assessor, Martha Stone stated the proposed tax increase on ad valorem taxes is three cents per one hundred dollars. This increase would help to balance the county budget. After the increase, the short fall to the budget would still be around \$35,000.00. Property rates went up two years ago because of the oil and gas activity which lowered the effective tax rate. Now they have dropped in value due to losing \$21 million in oil and gas funds, therefore raising the effective tax rate. The three cents will only raise the tax rate one cent above what it was two years ago.
