To All Members of the Sabine County Hotel / Motel Tax Fund Committee:

As part of the El Camino de los Tejas Caddo Region Trail Partners' effort to establish and publicize a spring yard sale, festival, travel event the first Friday and Saturday of May each, I am requesting that you consider allocating some of the funds over which you have jurisdiction.

The amount decired for this year is \$1200, to aid in advertising and promoting Sabine County's portion of the trail. The majority of the money would be spent on newspaper and radio advertising and signage within Sabine County. A portion may be given to the overseeing organization to advertise the Trail as a whole with Sabine County included. This may include website, print, radio, television, and signage.

The El Camino Real Trail Partners is a non-profit 501C-4 group of six counties and parishes in both Texas and Louisiana which have formed in support for historical preservation, education, tourism, and economic development. The counties and parishes include Natchitoches, Sabine Parish, Sabine County, San Augustine, Nacogdoches, and Houston Counties. Each year, we distribute brochures, maps, flyers, etc. to various tourism bureaus and chambers across the two states to encourage travel and interest in our area.

Approximately 7 years ago, I was approved by the Sabine County Commissioner's Court to be an official representative from our county at the bi-monthly meetings of the Trail Partners. This was to assure that Sabine County is not overlooked from lack of presence. I am strictly a volunteer and have no budget. The annual dues of \$500, are now being paid by the Commissioner's Court as an item included in the Sabine County Operating Budget.

In 2008, the Trail Partners began "The Sale on the Trail" to promote interest and awareness of the El Camino Real and to cause people to physically travel through our area to see the beauty along with recreational and historical value presented here. Because we are teaming with Texas and Louisiana, this causes travel across the three mile expanse of Pendleton Bridge which is an impressive asset that can serve us in attracting tourism revenue not only this particular weekend, but perhaps encouraging follow-up visits throughout the year. Perhaps, we are even attracting future home-owners who may wish to re-locate and live in Sabine County because of their visits.

The Trali Partners will be spending between \$3500. to \$5000. to advertise the whole event while each county is expected to do additional promotion locally. The whole advertising area covers from Dallas, TX to Lake Charles and Shreveport, LA.

This is a two-day event and in the past we have had numerous inquiries from travelers concerning lodging, restaurants, etc. They are also asking what else is in the area worth seeing. We are trying to determine ways to publicize a list of specific Sabine County attractions to be placed on a website and published in a flyer printed and distributed along major stope on the trail.

It is difficult to determine the number of travelers, but there are hundreds of tourists / shoppers passing through on this weekend. Some need overnight and food accommodations. Also, by showing Sabine County in a positive light, we generate interest in return visits from those people new to our area. The possibilities seem endless.

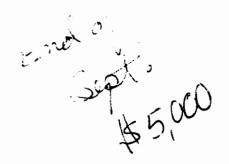

TABC is a 501 (C) (3)



The Texas Association of Bass Clubs (TABC) was organized in April of 1971 as a non-profit organization to work for the Texas anglers. The organization was and ever shall be dedicated to the preservation of our sport, the conservation of our resources and involvement with our Texas youth for the future of our State and the promotion of our sport.

The main goals of our organization is to promote the sport of bass fishing through restocking programs, sensible aquatic vegetation control and proper management of our State's resources. Other includes interest in our sport and to become immersed in our Texas youth who are the future of all we do. TABC sits on the board of the Texas Outdoor Partnership, a group of conservation organizations throughout the state providing communications between anglers, hunters and various outdoor enthusiasts, legislators, media and the Texas Parks and Wildlife Agency.

Some of the accomplishments of TABC are Handicap piers at Nacogdoches Lake and Lake Buchanan. TABC challenged the US Army Corps of Engineers and won to keep Choke Canyon Reservoir from becoming a slick bottomed lake. Challenged TPW on many occasions regarding aquatic vegetation in multiple lakes, and have given thousands in scholarships and grants to Boys and Girls organizations across the State.

TABC is composed of a President and Vice-president and Secretary who are elected by board members. There are eight (8) board members elected by the general membership which runs in the hundreds (approximately 500) from across the State of Texas.

Each year TABC puts on one (1) State Championship Club Tournament for its entire existing clubs. Clubs from across the State converge on a predetermined location and fish for the bragging rights as #1 Bass Club in the State. Most years there are 200 to 250 fishermen representing their respective clubs. The tournament is moved from one side of the state to the other with lakes chosen from East Texas and South and West Texas. Our State tournament lasts two days and the entire group is given many items donated from clubs and vendors from around the State. On Saturday night, a huge meal is enjoyed by all and the tournament ends on Sunday. Due to the fact that we have no off limits for the tournament it is not out of the ordinary for fishermen to spend several days in preparation for the big event.

Our State Tournament starts with registration on Friday evening from 4 to 7 pm with each club registering and receiving their bags full of goodies. At 7:30pm there is a captain's meeting to ensure each person in the tournament understands the rules of the tournament. It is at this meeting that all Safety matters are discussed and reinforced.

On the first morning of the tournament, boats are launched, and when everyone is launched, a prayer is given and the National Anthem is played. The tournament is a numbered draw and clubs leave by their numbers. Weigh in is at 3:00pm. A full meal is cooked and enjoyed by all of the fishermen and honored guests that evening and problems (if any) are discussed and resolved. On the second morning the takeoff is reversed with last on Saturday being first on Sunday. Weigh in is at 1:30pm. An award ceremony follows after weights are figured and a random polygraph is administered.

The Texas Association of Bass Clubs is asking for the following:

- 1. Either a full meal for approximately 250 provided on Saturday night or the funds to purchase product to cook for that full meal (approximately \$850.00) Martin Chevrolet out of Cleveland Texas has a Bar B Q team that will cook whatever we provide to eat.
 - 2. \$15.00 per head for each person registered in the tournament to help defray cost of tournament.
 - 3. Complementary housing for the TABC volunteer staff. (2 rooms on Thursday night) (6 rooms on Friday and Saturday nights and 1 room on Sunday night)
 - 4. Complementary meal for volunteer staff on Friday night after Captain's meeting (approximately 20 people)
 - 5. \$250.00 to share to cost of polygraph or voice recognition expert.
 - 6. If temperatures are exceedingly hot when the tournament is held, approximately 500 lbs of ice for hospital tanks to help ensure fish are released healthy.

- 7. Publicity from the Tourism Group to local merchants before and during tournament
- 1+ 8. A proper place for weigh in, captain's meetings, and meal to be served on Saturday
 - 9. A proper place for registration and captain's meeting on Friday night
 - 10. Reasonable prices for our fishermen who identify themselves as being TABC members.\
 - 11. Volunteers: Boy and Girls Clubs, HS Bass Clubs etc. TABC will make a 300.00 donation to such groups.
 - 12. Any permits that might be required to hold such an event.

TABC is asking for a total of cash and amenities in the amount of 5000.00 to properly hold the event. We believe that our event will generate for the tournament and surrounding areas in the neighborhood of \$200,000.00. This does not include pre-fishing which will occur during the entire year once we announce the tournament location. Looking at our last year's tournament on Sam Rayburn, TABC rented every available motel room within 15 to 20 miles of the tournament headquarters for a minimum of 5 days before the tournament.

TABC will receive no funds from this tournament except what we get from the hosting lake which is spent as much as possible in the local area. All monies (entry fees etc) are returned to the fishermen 100% plus added monies from TABC. We will have clubs travel from as far away as San Angelo, Texas and Lubbock Texas.

Our event is advertised through our web site TABConline.org which provides links to any and all businesses and vendors involved with us.

We are excited at the prospect of coming to Toledo Bend and putting this event on the lake at least once every four years. If there are questions, please do not hesitate to call
