We have audited the financial statements of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of Sabine County, Texas (the County) for the year ended December 31, 2013, and have issued our report thereon dated July 25, 2014. Professional standards require that we provide you with the following information related to our audit.

#### Our Responsibilities under U.S. Generally Accepted Auditing Standards and OMB Circular A-133

As stated in our engagement letter dated April 30, 2013, our responsibility, as described by professional standards, is to express opinions about whether the financial statements prepared by management with your oversight are fairly presented, in all material respects, in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles. Our audit of the financial statements does not relieve you or management of your responsibilities.

In planning and performing our audit, we considered the County's internal control over financial reporting in order to determine our auditing procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinions on the financial statements and not to provide assurance on the internal control over financial reporting. We also considered internal control over compliance with requirements that could have a direct and material effect on a major federal program in order to determine our auditing procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on compliance and to test and report on internal control over compliance in accordance with OMB Circular A-133.

As part of obtaining reasonable assurance about whether the County's financial statements are free of material misstatement, we performed tests of its compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts, and grants, noncompliance with which could have a direct and material effect on the determination of financial statement amounts. However, providing an opinion on compliance with those provisions was not an objective of our audit. Also in accordance with OMB Circular A-133, we examined, on a test basis, evidence about the County's compliance with the types of compliance requirements described in the "U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-133 Compliance Supplement" applicable to each of its major federal programs for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the County's compliance with those requirements. While our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion, it does not provide a legal determination on the County's compliance with those requirements.

#### Planned Scope and Timing of the Audit

We performed the audit according to the planned scope and timing previously communicated to you in our engagement letter. Our audit included examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The audit involved our judgment about the number of transactions to be examined and the areas to be tested. We planned and performed the audit to obtain reasonable (rather than absolute assurance) about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement.

#### Qualitative Aspects of Accounting Practices

Management is responsible for the selection and use of appropriate accounting policies. The significant accounting policies used by the County are described in the notes to the financial statements. No new accounting policies were adopted and the application of existing policies was not changed during the year ended December 31, 2013. We noted no transactions during the year for which there is a lack of authoritative guidance or consensus. We found no significant transactions that have been recognized in the financial statements in a different period than when the transaction occurred.

Accounting estimates are an integral part of the financial statements prepared by management and are based on management's knowledge and experience about past and current events and assumptions about future events. Certain accounting estimates are particularly sensitive because of their significance to the financial statements and because of the possibility that future events affecting them may differ significantly from those expected. The most sensitive estimates affecting the financial statements are:

Management's estimate of depreciation expense is based on the estimated useful lives of the asset. We evaluated the key factors and assumptions used to develop the depreciation expense in determining that it is reasonable in relation to the financial statements taken as a whole.

Management's estimate of the allowance for uncollectible tax receivables is based on historical experience with collecting property taxes. We evaluated the key factors and assumptions used to develop the reserve for uncollectible property taxes in determining that it is reasonable in relation to the financial statements as a whole.

#### Difficulties Encountered in Performing the Audit

We encountered no significant difficulties in dealing with management in performing and completing our audit.

#### Corrected and Uncorrected Misstatements

Professional standards require us to accumulate all known and likely misstatements identified during the audit, other than those that are trivial, and communicate them to the appropriate level of management. During our engagement we have proposed several adjustments that management is aware of and agrees to post.

The most significant fiscal year 2013 audit adjustments pertained to recording depreciation, accrued compensation, property taxes receivable, and grant expenditures/receivables. Management has informed us that all proposed adjustments will be posted to the County accounting ledger.

#### Disagreements with Management

For purposes of this letter, professional standards define a disagreement with management as a financial accounting, reporting, or auditing matter, whether or not resolved to our satisfaction, that could be significant to the financial statements or the auditor's report. We are pleased to report that no such disagreements arose during the course of our audit.

#### Management Representations

We have requested certain representations from management that are included in the management representation letter dated July 25, 2014.

#### Management Consultations with Other Independent Accountants

In some cases, management may decide to consult with other accountants about auditing and accounting matters, similar to obtaining a "second opinion" on certain situations. If a consultation involves application of an accounting principle to the governmental unit's financial statements or a determination of the type of auditor's opinion that may be expressed on those statements, our professional standards require the consulting accountant to check with us to determine that the consultant has all the relevant facts. To our knowledge, there were no such consultations with other accountants.

#### Other Audit Findings or Issues

We generally discuss a variety of matters, including the application of accounting principles and auditing standards, with management each year prior to retention as the governmental unit's auditors. However, these discussions occurred in the normal course of our professional relationship and our responses were not a condition to our retention.

#### Grants Administrator / Coordinator

In the prior year, the county auditor was responsible for the oversight of all the County's grants. Due to personnel changes, grant administration has not been officially reassigned. A grant coordinator will help facilitate proper identification of all federal awards and ensure the compliance requirements associated with each grant, as well as reporting on an annual basis with the federal agencies. We recommend that a person knowledgeable of all County activities be the individual charged with grant administration.

#### Controls over Disbursements

In the prior year, it was requested by the County Auditor that all elected officials follow the prescribed control procedures and transfer bank accounts to the Treasurer's office to ensure compliance with state laws and strengthen internal controls. By early 2013, all bank accounts, except ones that are specifically identified by state statutes, had been closed out and balances transferred to the Treasurer's Fee Account. This fund receives and disburses funds according to the respective fee office monthly report or per instruction from the elected official.

#### Compliance with State Laws

In the prior year the Tax-Assessor's bond payable to the County for property tax collections did not conform to official bond requirements, per Texas Tax Code. The bond has been increased and is now in compliance.

#### **Budgetary Process**

Upon review of the individual fund comparisons, we noted that several capital outlay accounts were significantly over-budgeted. Upon further examination, we were unable to determine where the budgeted amounts came from. We recommend that during the budgetary process, each layer of the process (fee office, treasurer's office, auditor's office, and commissioner's court) should review the budgeted items for reasonableness and accuracy. Also, before year end, the remaining budgets should be reviewed and amended as needed.
