ATTACHMENT A

Scope of Services

- LOCAL GOVERNMENT RESPONSIBILITIES. The Local Government agrees that during the term of this Agreement it will:
- A. The Amateur Radio Station equipment being provided for the Local Government facility shall be limited for use only by the Local Government.
- B. There shall be no equipment or access points located at the TxDOT Hemphill Facility or the Local Government facility, which allows or could allow the sale of broadband Internet service by the broadband Internet service provider to customers which are not a party to this Interlocal agreement.
- C. The Local Government agrees that if the Amateur Radio Station equipment causes any interference or operational losses to TxDOT communications equipment or facilities, the Local Government will immediately cease operation of the Amateur Radio Station equipment until the source and cause of the interference can be determined and repaired. If the interference cannot be eliminated, the Local Government agrees to remove the Amateur Radio Station equipment at the Local Government's expense and repair any damage to TxDOT Hemphill Facility with no liability to TxDOT.
- 2. TxDOT RESPONSIBILITIES. TxDOT agrees that during the term of this Agreement, TxDOT will:
- A. Allow escorted access to the site during normal published business hours for work related to the Amateur Radio Station equipment. Emergency and non-business hour access to the site will be at the discretion of the TxDOT Hemphill Facility section supervisor.
- B. Permit installation services, equipment and maintenance related to the Amateur Radio Station equipment that serves the Local Government facility to be installed at the TxDOT Hemphill Facility.
- C. Coordinate with the Local Government and the Amateur Radio Station equipment provider for the installation and operation of the Amateur Radio Station equipment system at the TxDOT Hemphill Facility. TxDOT TRF Radio shall have final determination on installation methods and location of the Amateur Radio Station equipment
- D. Provide electrical power for the equipment related to the Amateur Radio Station equipment serving the Local Government at no cost to the Local Government.
- 3. COVERAGE. It is expressly understood and agreed that one hundred percent (100%) coverage of any area at all times is improbable. There may be adverse transmission conditions such as short term, unpredictable meteorological effects and sky wave interference from distant stations that can interrupt the Amateur Radio Station equipment. Causes beyond reasonable control of TxDOT, include but are not limited to, motor ignition and other electrical noise that may be minimized by corrective devices at Local Governments expense. Any surveys, studies, research or other measures taken to ensure the adequacy of coverage provided to the Local Government under this Agreement are the sole responsibility and expense of the Local Government.
- 4. INDUSTRY COMPLIANCE. It is also expressly understood and agreed that the Local Government's system has passed FCC and Good Amateur Engineering Practice standards as well as directions by TxDOT Radio Operations concerning the installation and operation of the Amateur Radio Station equipment.

ATTACHMENT B

GeneralTerms and Conditions

Article 1. Amendments

This contract may only be amended by written agreement executed by both parties before the contract is terminated.

Article 2. Conflicts Between Agreements

If the terms of this contract conflict with the terms of any other contract between the parties, the most recent contract shall prevail.

Article 3. Disputes

Local Government shall be responsible for the settlement of all contractual and administrative issues arising out of operation or procurements entered in support of contract services.

Article 4. Ownership of Equipment

Except to the extent that a specific provision of this contract states to the contrary, all equipment purchased by TxDOT under this contract shall be owned by TxDOT and, all equipment purchased by Local Government for use in this amateur radio repeater system shall be owned by Local Government.

Article 5. Termination

This contract terminates at the onset of either of the following, whichever occurs first:

- · at the end of the contract term.
- · when all services and obligations contained in this contract have been satisfactorily completed,
- · by mutual written agreement,
- 30 days after either party gives notice to the other party,
- immediately if all, or substantially all, of the authorizations held by the Local Government or TxDOT are revoked by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) or its successor agency, or
- immediately for breach of this agreement as determined by TxDOT.

TxDOT may, at its option, require the Local Government to remove the equipment off TxDOT's tower within 30 days after termination of this agreement. The Local Government shall repair any damage caused by the removal of the equipment.

Article 6. Gratuities

Any person who is doing business with or who reasonably speaking may do business with TxDOT under this contract may not make any offer of benefits, gifts, or favors to employees of TxDOT. The only exceptions allowed are ordinary business lunches and items that have received the advanced written approval of the Executive Director of the Texas Department of Transportation.

Article 7. Responsibilities of the Parties

Each party acknowledges that it is not an agent, servant, or employee of the other party. Each party is responsible for its own acts and deeds and for those of its agents, servants, or employees.

Article 8. Compliance with Laws

The parties shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws, statutes, ordinances, rules, and regulations and with the orders and decrees of any courts or administrative bodies or tribunals in any manner affecting the performance of this agreement.

Article 9. State Auditor's Provision

The state auditor may conduct an audit or investigation of any entity receiving funds from TxDOT directly under the contract or indirectly through a subcontract under the contract. Acceptance of funds directly under the contract or indirectly through a subcontract under this contract acts as acceptance of the authority of the state

auditor, under the direction of the legislative audit committee, to conduct an audit or investigation in connection with those funds. An entity that is the subject of an audit or investigation must provide the state auditor with access to any information the state auditor considers relevant to the investigation or audit.

Article 10. Hold Harmless

The Local Government shall indemnify and save harmless TxDOT and its officers and employees from all claims and liability due to its materials or activities of itself, its agents, or employees, performed under this agreement and that are caused by or result from error, omission, or negligent act of the Local Government or of any person employed by the Local Government. The Local Government shall also indemnify and save harmless TxDOT from any and all expense, including but not limited to attorney fees that may be incurred by TxDOT in litigation or otherwise resisting the claim or liabilities that may be imposed on TxDOT as a result of such activities by the Local Government, its agents, or employees. The Local Government's indemnification of TxDOT shall extend for a period of three (3) years beyond the date of termination of this agreement.

Article 11. Signatory Warranty

Each signatory warrants that the signatory has necessary authority to execute this agreement on behalf of the entity represented.


