AGENDA ITEM # 8 – Public Comments.






Program Coordinator, Kerwin Lloyd, provided update from recent schools attended, relocation of office and FEMA damage assessment.

Thomas Warren, Veterans' Officer, training underway and attending upcoming school. Mr. Bo Mayo's last day in the office will be on April 27, 2016.


Sheriff Tom Maddox stated that the inmates were working on trash pickup and Keep Sabine County Clean Project is underway.
