We are pleased to inform you that your VCSO, Thomas L. Warren, completed our training during calendar year 2016 and will be provided a Certificate of Completion.





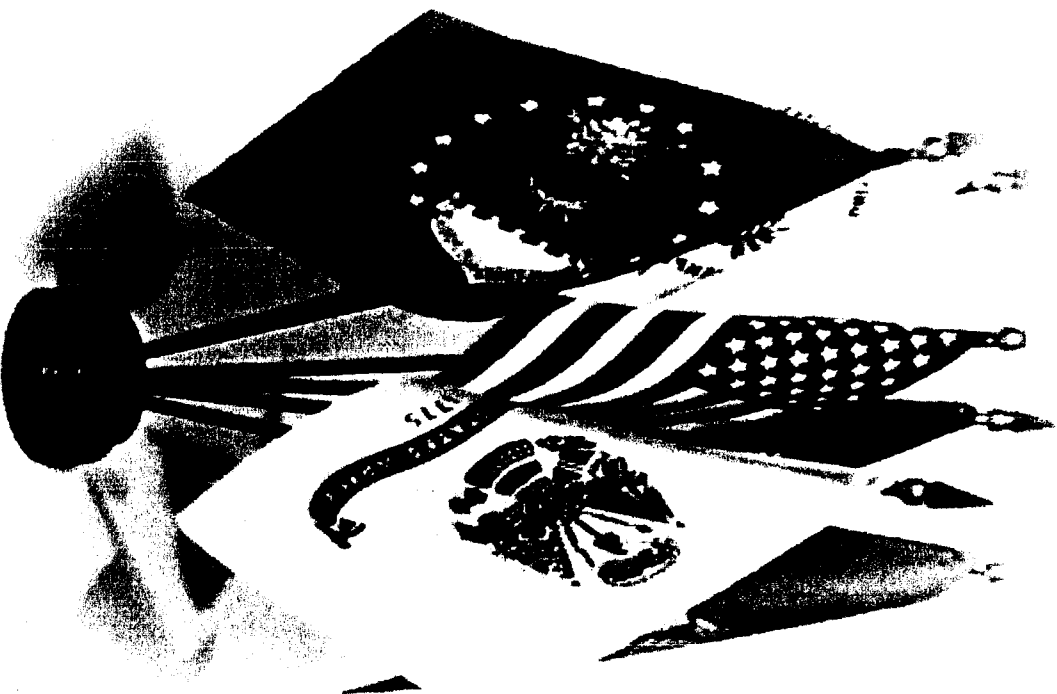
