The Deep East Texas Council of Governments (DETCOG) hereby issues a request for applications for Solid Waste Implementation projects for FY 2016/FY 2017 Grant Funding. DETCOG anticipates awarding grants totaling \$102,941.14 in FY 2016 and \$63,058.86 in FY 2017 for a combined total funding amount of \$160,000.00.

All Cities, Counties, Public Schools and School Districts, General and Special Law Districts with the authority and responsibility for water quality protection or municipal solid waste management, to include river authorities within Angelina, Houston, Jasper, Nacogdoches, Newton, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Shelby, Trinity and Tyler counties are eligible to apply for Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) funding through DETCOG.

Applications for projects in the following categories will be accepted: Local Enforcement, Litter and Illegal Dumping Cleanup and Community Collection Events, Source Reduction and Recycling, Local Solid Waste Management Plans, Citizens' Collection Stations and "Small" Registered Transfer Stations, Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Management, Technical Studies, Educational and Training Projects, and other projects not included in these categories which meet TCEQ criteria.

Included for consideration during the funding will be a minimum of ten (10) individual grants, not to exceed \$16,000.00. Each application will be judged by the Regional Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC) in accordance with the SWAC Project Review and Scoring Guidelines and DETCOG's Regional Solid Waste Management Plan.

Detailed application packets are available beginning **January 31, 2017**. Project applications are due to DETCOG by close of business on **March 6, 2017**. Projects will begin approximately May 1, 2017 and end no later than July 31, 2017.
