

Interlocal Agreement

Sabine County Pct. 2 & 3 and West Sabine ISD

This agreement is entered into by and between the County of Sabine, with authorization of the governing body, hereinafter referred to as "Sabine County", a political subdivision of the state of Texas with the authorization of its governing body and West Sabine ISD, hereinafter referred to as "West Sabine", located in Sabine County, Texas.


WHEREAS, Sabine County and West Sabine are authorized to enter into this Interlocal Agreement pursuant to Texas Government code Annotated, Section 791.001 et seq. Also known as the Interlocal Cooperation Act; and


WHEREAS, Sabine County and West Sabine may each provide governmental services for the public health, welfare and safety of the citizens; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recital and mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties agree as follow:


- 1) Sabine County and West Sabine agree that Pct. 2 and Pct. 3 County Commissioners may assist West Sabine in providing labor and services.
- 2) Sabine County and West Sabine agree that any and all assistance provided shall be established prior to commencement.
- 3) West Sabine agrees to indemnify and hold Sabine County harmless from any loss, damage and expense caused by the assertion of any claims, demands or actions arising in connection with the County's actions as referenced herein.
- 4) This agreement may be terminated by Sabine County or West Sabine with or without cause by the terminating party providing ten days written notice of termination to the other party.


