



DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

Extended -30 days

WHEREAS, beginning in December 2019, a novel coronavirus, now designated as COVID-19, was detected in mainland China, and has since spread throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a worldwide pandemic on March 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, President Trump signed a Proclamation declaring a National Emergency Concerning the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-10) outbreak on March 13, 2020,


WHEREAS, Texas Governor Abbott declared State of Disaster in Texas due to COVID-19 on March 13, 2020,

WHEREAS, extraordinary measures must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout Sabine County, Texas; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for Sabine County, Texas, pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners' Court of the County of Sabine, Texas
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.

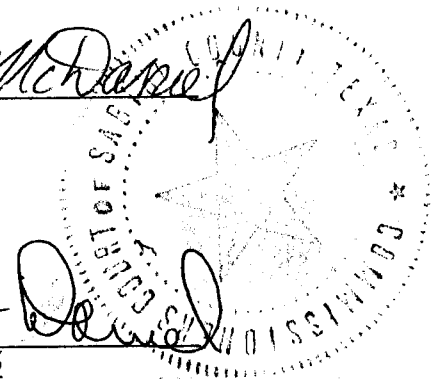

As an update, in response to internal direction following Governor Abbot's executive order we'll be doing the following to recreation areas within Sabine County:

- **Willow Oak** – The site will be closed to camping, but the boat ramp will remain open.
- **Lakeview** – The site will be closed to camping, but the boat ramp will remain open.
- **Indian Mounds** – The site will be closed to camping, but the boat ramps will remain open.
- **Red Hills Lake** – Site is currently still in its seasonal closure status. We'll still be working toward having it ready to open on May 1st per Forest Supervisor
