RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SABINE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A CDBG DISASTER RECOVERY PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND REVITALIZATION (GLO-CDR) COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR) FOR GLO-MIT; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CDBG DISASTER RECOVERY PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's Court of the County of Sabine, Texas desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income, and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the County of Sabine, Texas to apply for funding under the Texas General Land Office CDBG Disaster Recovery Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SABINE, TEXAS:

- 1. **THAT** a CDBG Disaster Recovery Program Grant application for the CDBG-MIT Project is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County with the Texas General Land Office.
- 2. **THAT** the County's application be placed in competition for funding under the CDBG Disaster Recovery Program.
- 3. **THAT** the application be for \$11,180,882.62 of grant funds to provide for Drainage Improvements Project. The County is committing an amount not to exceed \$111,808.83 (1% of total grant award) from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the project.
- 4. **THAT** the Commissioner's Court directs and designates the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the application and the County's participation in the CDBG Disaster Recovery Program.
- THAT all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition and civil rights requirements.
