The policy will not require a negative test to return to work. A copy of the policy will be given to all employees. Tricia mentioned that Covid tests will now require a co-pay, and that vaccines are covered 100%. Commissioner Lowe moved to extend the FFRCA for 90-days, not requiring a negative test to return to work, and make it retroactive, effective beginning January 1,2021. Commissioner Jacks seconds. All in favor. Motion carries.
