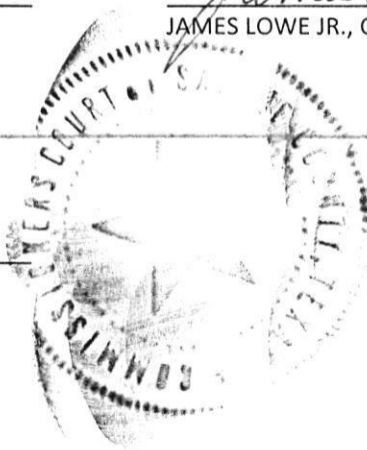

Sabine County Economic Development Progress Report
October, November & December 2020
Prepared by Charlie Dromgoole

- There were no in-person SCEDAC meetings in October, November, and December because of COVID-19 and Shelter-In-Place restrictions. However, a SCEDAC Zoom call was held on November 30.
- I continue to work with Pennie Ferguson and Matthew King about changes and updates that need to be made to the Tourism website. Matt reformatted our website on a Word Press platform that makes it more mobile friendly and easier to maintain. While the website is greatly enhanced with the new information, it will be a continual process to promote the assets of Sabine County in a manner that will entice tourists to the area. After the first version came out, we made numerous changes that made it more user friendly and easier to find information. This will be a work in progress, and we will continue to improve the website.
- I followed up on a letter I wrote on behalf of SCEDAC to the Sabine County Tourism Committee to request some additional funding for the bobber project. The Tourism Committee funded 10 bobbers for the initial order, which has arrived. The bobbers will be painted on site for those who have ordered them, and we are hopeful to have these items around Sabine County during Q1 2021.
- We also anticipate the arrival of the fiberglass fish and the fiberglass lures in early 2021. We will be working with TxDOT, SRA, city of Hemphill, and City of Pineland on establishing the locations and making this photo-op available for our visitors to Sabine County.
- I have built a database that contains all of the information requests from Go-Travel Sites, the online tourism marketing firm that markets Sabine County. We began the marketing program in December 2019 and through the month of December 2020, we have received 945 inquiries. All of those requests for tourism information were sent an email from Go Travel Sites that provided them a link to the Sabine County Tourism website and the Sabine County Magazine.
- I wrote an extensive article on economic development and tourism activities of SCEDAC for the 2021 Sabine County Magazine. A copy of this article is attached to this report.
- I have been selected to be one of the Sabine County representatives on the Texas Forest Country Board of Directors starting in 2021.
- I have met with Nancy Windham with the Texas Forest Country Partnership in participating with the TFCP regional partners in a lead generation program for economic development prospects for the region. We will continue to evaluate this program and the participation of Sabine County
- I have been working with Nancy Windham to identify the major industrial sites for Sabine County and provide her with data necessary for us to participate in the lead generation project.
- I have participated in several webinars and phone discussions that were focused on the future rural economic development in light of COVID-19. I participated in the TEDC virtual conference in October that had several sessions focused on rural economic development.

- I have made calls and sent emails to restaurant and hotel contacts to encourage them to continue to keep Sabine County on their radar when looking for new opportunities for restaurants and hotels. I have been assured that they are looking continually for operators that would be interested in rural areas. We are hopeful to gain more interest due to COVID-19 as a new market since there will not be a lot of hotel construction in what prior to the pandemic were the more proven hotel markets. The announcement of the SRA park will give us a major event to promote as well as providing the positive sales tax data on Sabine County during the pandemic.
