SABINE CO. SHERIFF'S OFFICE has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the SABINE CO. SHERIFF'S OFFICE from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the SABINE CO. SHERIFF'S OFFICE if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the SABINE CO. SHERIFF'S OFFICE has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the SABINE CO. SHERIFF'S OFFICE who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the SABINE CO. SHERIFF'S OFFICE policy;
- 6) requires collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a warning or citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - a. the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - b. whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search;
  - c. whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual;
  - d. whether the peace officer used physical force that resulted in bodily injury during the stop;
  - e. the location of the stop;
  - f. the reason for the stop.
- 7) requires the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:
  - a. the Commission on Law Enforcement; and
  - b. the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

The SABINE CO. SHERIFF'S OFFICE has satisfied the statutory data audit requirements as prescribed in Article



2.133(c), Code of Criminal Procedure during the reporting period.

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In 2019 Sabine County Texas had a population of 10,542 people in the county. (This is the most recent numbers using the census data). The source of the date we used is census.gov. Based on this data, the largest groups in Sabine County Texas are as follows, White (Non-Hispanic) 85.6%, White (Hispanic) 4.9%, Black or African American 6.9%, American Indian and Alaska Native 1%, Asian and Pacific Islander .5%, Two or More Races 1.7%.

The number of people were computed to provide an explanation of the percentages reflected in the report. This supplement Report to the Racial Profiling Report of Sabine County Texas, is to compare the Racial Profiling Report to the racial makeup of our county. There are also two major lakes that are in our county.

Second: Sam Rayburn Reservoir, runs along the south west border of our county. This lake also has sever camp houses along the lake area that has an influx of people.
