Sabine County Economic Development Progress Report
January, February & March 2021
Prepared by Charlie Dromgoole

- There were no in-person SCEDAC meetings in January, February, and March 2021 because of COVID-19 and Shelter-In-Place restrictions. However, I did make a visit to Sabine County to meet with Judge Melton in February.
- In January, I drafted a new contract for economic development services and Sabine County Tax Abatement Policy which was adopted by Commissioner's Court in January. In March, I drafted a funding request letter to the Sabine County Tourism Committee for the Sabine County Chamber of Commerce for assistance in funding the Fishers of Men National Tournament Trail will host the South Central Region – District 7 Championship Tournament on Toledo Bend Reservoir on September 28 – October 2, 2021. This 5-day event will have 150 participating anglers and will bring \$205,000 in new money to Sabine County and have an economic impact of \$614,000.
- The bobbers have arrived. The Tourism Committee funded 10 bobbers for the initial order of 26 and the Sabine County Chamber has received 26 more. The bobbers are being stored at Ritter Lumber company and Pearson Cemetery Service and will be painted on site at Pearson's for those who have ordered them, and we are hopeful to have these items around Sabine County during Q2 2021. Bobbers are still for sale at the Sabine County Chamber
- We also anticipate the arrival of the fiberglass fish and the fiberglass lures in Q2 2021. Judge Melton and I drove around Sabine County to determine potential sites for the fiberglass fish and lures. We will be working with TxDOT, SRA, city of Hemphill, and City of Pineland on establishing the locations and making this photo-op available for our visitors to Sabine County.
- I have been in touch with Shelley Plante with Texas Parks and Wildlife concerning the Sabine County application for the Kayaking/Paddling Trail on Toledo Bend. Due to COVID-19 they have not been able to travel overnight but are going to plan for someone from their department in the Sabine County area to come and ride the proposed trail so that we can get this back on track. Sabine County has provided all their required documentation and are awaiting a site visit for approval.
- We are also doing research on establishing a "barn quilt" program in Sabine County as a tourist attraction. This would involve the high school art departments painting quilt patterns 4'X4" sheets of plywood and placing them on barns and business locations around the county. We would then provide a map for the barn quilt trail.
- We continue to have monthly meetings by phone with Pennie Ferguson, Matthew King, and me about changes and updates that need to be made to the Tourism website. Matt reformatted our website on a Word Press platform that makes it more mobile friendly and easier to maintain. While the website is greatly enhanced with the new information, it will be a continual process to promote the assets of Sabine County in a manner that will entice tourists to the area. Please take a look at the Sabine County Tourism website at www.visitsabinecounty.com.

- I have been selected to be one of the Sabine County representatives on the Texas Forest Country Board of Directors starting in 2021. I attended Zoom meetings for board orientation in January, the first board meeting of the year in February, and a meeting on broadband for East Texas in February. I will be serving on the Legislative Committee representing Sabine County.
- I have built a database that contains all the information requests from Go-Travel Sites, the online tourism marketing firm that markets Sabine County. We began the marketing program in December 2019 and through March 14, 2021, we have received 1,131 inquiries. All of those requests for tourism information were sent an email from Go Travel Sites that provided them a link to the Sabine County Tourism website and the Sabine County Magazine.
- I have met with Nancy Windham with the Texas Forest Country Partnership in participating with the TFCP regional partners in a lead generation program for economic development prospects for the region. We will continue to evaluate this program and the participation of Sabine County
- I continue to work with Nancy Windham to identify the major industrial sites for Sabine County and provide her with data necessary for us to participate in the lead generation project.
- I continue to make phone calls and send emails to restaurant and hotel contacts to encourage them to continue to keep Sabine County on their radar when looking for new opportunities for restaurants and hotels. I have been assured that they are looking continually for operators that would be interested in rural areas. We are hopeful to gain more interest due to COVID-19 as a new market since there will not be a lot of hotel construction in what prior to the pandemic were the more proven hotel markets. The announcement of the SRA park will give us a major event to promote as well as providing the positive sales tax data on Sabine County during the pandemic.
