Commissioner Lowe moved to pay accounts and salaries. Commissioner McDaniel seconded. All in favor. Motion carries. See Attached.






AGENDA ITEM #15- Public Comments

Judge Melton stated they were still getting lots of phone calls and working on documentation of damage from Hurricane Laura and the Winter Storm.


The second shots of Covid Vaccine administered through the National Guard should happen April 8 & 9.
