### Sabine County Economic Development Progress Report January, February, March 2022 Prepared by Charlie Dromgoole

- I made a trip to Sabine County on January 6 &7 to meet with the City of Pineland, Judge Melton and a prospective travel center developer. I participated in the Texas Forest Country Partnership Board meeting by Zoom on January 11. I also attended the Texas Economic Development Council meeting in Sugar Land on February 17.
- We had a site visit on January 6 from a prospective travel center developer that we have been working with for several years. They have selected a site in Pineland, have gotten the property under contract, and are in the process of doing their due diligence on the site as well as a truck traffic study. We continue to follow-up with developers regularly to see what help they need to keep the project moving forward. They are hopeful to begin development in 2022.
- I have been in coordinating the finalization of the Kayaking/Paddling Trail on Toledo Bend with the Texas Parks and Wildlife. We have installed the frame and information panel that was developed by TPW at Holly Park Marina. We expect to have a formal announcement of the Patroon Bayou Paddling Trail as soon as TPW completes the website which will be in Q2 of 2002. We have also ordered and received 3 additional frames since we will be filing the application for additional paddling trails in 2022.
- We also anticipate the arrival of the fiberglass fish and the fiberglass lures in Q2 2022. The contractor got behind because of the pandemic and since our project has been delayed, he is going to provide an extra fiberglass fish. Currently, the fish are being painted and we will receive our first shipment on April 2022 with the remaining fish and lures by June 2002 We will be working with SRA, City of Hemphill, City of Pineland, Hemphill ISD, and private landowners on establishing the locations and making this photo-op available for our visitors to Sabine County.
- We will be exploring with the Sabine County Tourism Committee the possibility of hiring a company to research and provide information on short-term rentals that are not collecting the 6% hotel tax that is collected by Sabine County. The firm will provide us with a letter to send the owners of short-term rentals that are not collecting the hotel tax informing them of their obligation to submit the tax. Tricia Jacks and I have both viewed the presentation on the program and feel that it would be a great help in collecting the hotel tax.
- The Sabine County Tourism Comm8ittee will be looking at various ways to promote tourism in Sabine County through billboards and other marketing tools available.
- I have sent the hotel study to 2 prospective hotels to inform them of the opportunity in Sabine County.
- I have also received new ESRI demographic reports for both Hemphill and Pineland within a 15, 30, and 45 radius. These will be used to show the potential population that is within driving distance for recruiting businesss.

- I have built a database that contains all the information requests from Go-Travel Sites, the online tourism marketing firm that markets Sabine County. We began the marketing program in December 2019 and through December 13, 2021, we have received 2,880 inquiries. 650 of those inquiries have come in since January 1, 2022. All of those requests for tourism information were sent an email from Go Travel Sites that provided them a link to the Sabine County Tourism website and the Sabine County Magazine.
- We were contacted by the Site Selection Group (SSG) through the Texas Forest Country Partnership about Project Stuart, a wood treatment facility looking in East Texas and Western Louisiana for a 20-30-acre site to construct an \$8.5 million plant that will eventually employ 50 people. We submitted two sites that met their criteria and initial data requested by SSG. We were then asked to provide more detailed information on our sites, utility rates and extension costs, transportation, taxes, infrastructure adequacy. That information has been received by SSG and is being reviewed by the company. I have stayed in touch with the SSG but the company has not made any decisions at this time.
- We continue to make improvements in the Sabine County tourism website. Pennie Ferguson and Matthew King continue to provide new content and reformatting to where the website is very informative and easy to use., While the website is greatly enhanced with the new information, it will be a continual process to promote the assets of Sabine County in a manner that will entice tourists to the area.
