

Judge Melton called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

AGENDA ITEM #1-Proposed Tax Rate


Martha Stone gave a statement on the proposed tax rate. No one from the public was present in Court. The Court waited 10 minutes before closing the Public Hearing.

The Commissioners Court may announce that it will go into executive session on any item listed on this agenda if the subject matter is permitted for a closed session by provisions of Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
